#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won four of their last five games as they continue a six-game, seven-day homestand tonight against the New York Yankees.
- RHP Reynaldo López is scheduled to start for the White Sox, who have won 13 of their last 21 home games vs. the Yankees.
- The Sox opened the homestand last night with a 7-0 loss to the Yankees.
- Following this three-game series and a day off on Thursday, the Sox conclude the homestand this weekend with three games vs. Cleveland (8/10-12).
- The White Sox went 3-0 on their last trip to Tampa Bay from 8/3-5 and 2-4 on their last homestand vs. Toronto (1-2) and Kansas City (1-2) from 7/27-8/2.

#### TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- Reynaldo López is 0-4 with a 7.22 ERA (23 ER/28.2 IP) over his last five starts and has received five runs of support during that span (1.57 RSA).
- The Sox are 8-9 in the second half (33-62 before the break).
- White Sox starting pitchers own a 2.51 ERA (9 ER/32.1 IP) over the last five games, allowing 22 hits.
- The Sox bullpen owns a 6.86 ERA (92 ER/120.2 IP) over the last 41 games (since 6/19).
- Chicago is hitting .280/.341/.475 (96-343) with 13 home runs and 50 runs scored over its last 10 home games (5.0 R/G).
- José Abreu is hitting .382/.443/.800 (21-55) with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI and 15 runs scored over his last 14 games.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Lance Lynn combined with A.J. Cole on a three-hitter as the Yankees won the series opener, 7-0, over the White Sox.
- Dylan Covey suffered the loss, allowing four runs on seven hits over 6.1 IP ... Covey fell to 1-7 with an 8.24 ERA (40 ER/43.2 IP) over his last nine starts.
- The White Sox put runners on first and third with two outs in the first inning before Avisail García struck out to end the threat.
- The Sox went 1-7 with RISP as they were shut out for the 10th time this season and seventh at home.
- Matt Davidson threw a scoreless ninth inning in his third pitching appearance of the season (see note below).

#### DOUBLE DUTY DAVIDSON

- Matt Davidson made his third pitching appearance of the season last night, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with a strikeout of Giancarlo Stanton to extend his scoreless streak to 3.0 IP.
- Davidson is one of 12 position players since 1974 (not including Shohei Ohtani) to make three or more pitching appearances in one season ... Milwaukee's Erik Kratz and Hernan Perez also have accomplished the feat in 2018 (STATS).
- Since 1973, only Doug Dasenczo (5.0), John Cangelosi (4.0), Jim Morrison (3.2) and Davidson have started their pitching careers with 3.0-plus scoreless IP as position players (STATS).

#### REVIVING BASEBALL

- The Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) World Series began on Monday in Minneapolis, with the White Sox Junior team defeating Detroit, 12-6.
- Noah Smith, Steven Sanderson and Donovan Noble each tripled in the fourth inning for Chicago ... Smith added an inside-the-park home run in the fifth to give Chicago a 4-2 lead.
- The White Sox Senior team lost to Austin, 5-4 ... leadoff hitter Michael Bolton recorded two hits, a stolen base and two runs scored, ending day one with a .571 average and five runs scored.

#### ON THE FARM

- Class A Winston-Salem C Yermín Mercedes has been named Carolina League Player of the Week from the period of 7/30-8/5.
- Mercedes went 6-11 (.545) with a double, two home runs and four RBI in four games during the week ... he ranks among the CL leaders in on-base percentage (3rd, .383), slugging percentage (3rd, .498) and average (5th, .300).
- Mercedes is the fourth member of the Dash this season to earn a CL weekly honor, following Micker Adolfo (4/5-15), Jimmy Lambert (4/23-29) and Dylan Cease (4/30-5/6).

#### HOMER HAPPY

- The White Sox have hit 40 home runs in 28 games since 7/3, tied with Texas and Toronto for the second-highest total in the major leagues behind Oakland (41).
- The Sox have homered in 14 of their last 16 games (24 total), including a season-high tying eight games in a row from 7/28-8/5.
- José Abreu has hit six home runs in his last 14 games, Avisail García has hit 12 in his last 29, and Daniel Palka has 10 in his last 25.

#### WHITE SOX VS. NEW YORK-AL

- The Yankees lead the season series, 1-0, and are 10-1-3 in the last 14 season matchups vs. the White Sox (2004-17), including a 4-3 edge in 2017.
- The White Sox are 13-8 in their last 21 home games vs. the Yankees dating back to 2012.
- The Sox trail the all-time series, 820-1,064 ... they are 450-495 at home (55-59 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 370-569 on the road (8-22 at new Yankee Stadium).

#### LOOKING FOR AN EDGE VS. THE EAST

- The White Sox are 189-229 vs. the American League East since 2007, with their only winning record during that span coming in 2016 (19-14).
- The Sox are 10-10 vs. the AL East this season (4-7 at home) and have won nine of their last 17 games after a 1-4 start.

#### PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka ranks among the American League rookie leaders this season in home runs (2nd, 17), slugging percentage (2nd, .500), RBI (3rd, 44) and total bases (T4th, 129).
- Palka's three pinch-hit homers this season are tied with Oscar Gamble (1977), John Romano (1959) and Ron Northey (1956) for the White Sox franchise record, and his nine RBI are the most by a Sox pinch-hitter since Jerry Hairston in 1987 (10).

#### 20/20/20/20 VISION

- José Abreu is attempting to become the 18th player in major-league history to hit 20-plus home runs in each of his first five seasons ... Pete Incaviglia (1986-90), Eddie Murray (1977-81), Tony Conigliaro (1964-69), Ted Williams (1939-42, 1946) and Joe DiMaggio (1936-40) are the only players to accomplish the feat exclusively in the American League (source: Baseball Reference).
- Abreu already is the first player in White Sox history to hit 20-plus home runs in each of his first four seasons.

#### DOUBLE TROUBLE

- José Abreu has joined Magglio Ordóñez (1999-2003) as the only players in White Sox history to hit 30-plus doubles in five straight seasons ... he and Matt Carpenter are the only players to hit 30-plus doubles in each of the last five seasons (2014-18).
- Abreu also has joined Frank Thomas (nine), Paul Konerko (eight), Ordóñez (five), Ray Durham (five), Willie Kamm (five) and Bibb Falk (five) as the only players in Sox history with five-plus seasons of 30-plus doubles.

#### STOLEN BASE ... STOLEN BASE!

- The White Sox rank fifth in the major-leagues this season with 79 stolen bases and are the only team to feature five players with 10 or more steals.
- The last time five or more Sox players recorded 10-plus stolen bases was 2005 (Jermaine Dye, Willie Harris, Tadahito Iguchi, Pablo Ozuna, Scott Podsednik and Aaron Rowand).

#### POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (14 HR/22 SB) is one of seven players in the major leagues this season with at least 14 home runs and 20 stolen bases, joining Andrew Benintendi, Mookie Betts, Starling Marte, José Ramírez, Mike Trout and Trea Turner.
- Anderson, who is on pace for 20 homers and 32 steals, is looking to join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in White Sox history to record 20-plus homers and 30-plus steals in one season.

#### QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,364 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,361) and 45 more than Oakland (1,319), the next-closest American League team.

#### PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox farm system is ranked No. 3 in baseball according to MLB Pipeline's updated rankings, and includes seven of the Top 100 prospects.
- OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 3), RHP Michael Kopech (13), OF Luis Robert (25), INF Nick Madrigal (32), RHP Dylan Cease (44), RHP Dane Dunning (64) and OF Blake Rutherford (88) all are ranked in MLB Pipeline's Top 100.

#### ON THE AIR

- Matt Vasgerian will work approximately three innings with Hawk Harrelson in the Sox TV booth this Sunday vs. Cleveland.
- Tom Paciorek will fill in for Steve Stone alongside Jason Benetti for the White Sox series at Detroit from 8/13-15.

## LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 23rd start of the season, 11th at home and first career against the New York Yankees.
- Is 0-4 with a 7.22 ERA (23 ER/28.2 IP), 17 strikeouts and a .283 (32-113) opponents average over his last five starts ... the Sox have scored a total of five runs of support during that span.
- Is 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA (29 ER/65.1 IP) in 10 home starts this season ... has allowed 10 home runs over his last five starts at home.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

## LAST START

- Received his ninth no decision on 8/2 vs. Kansas City ... allowed two runs on five hits with four strikeouts over 7.0 IP ... held the Royals scoreless over the first seven innings ... retired 11 of the first 12 batters he faced ...
- Received two or less runs of support for the 13th time this season and in each of his last five starts.
- Departed with the White Sox trailing, 3-2, after throwing 94 pitches (60 strikes) ... the Sox went on to win, 6-4, after scoring four runs in the eighth, José Abreu recorded a solo home run and Daniel Palka connected on a three-run shot.

## GOING, GOING, GONE!

- Has allowed 19 home runs this season, tied for the second-most among White Sox pitchers (James Shields, 21) ... has allowed 12 over his last nine starts after surrendering seven in his first 13 starts.
- Allowed a career-high five home runs on 7/27 vs. Toronto, becoming just the second White Sox pitcher in franchise history to allow five-plus homers (also Eddie Lopat on 4/23/47 at Detroit).
- Prior to the 2018 season allowed only 11 home runs over 91.2 IP from 2016-2017.
- Is averaging 1.33 home runs per 9.0 IP this season, the 13th-highest mark in the American League.

## HOME NOT SO SWEET HOME

- Is making his 16th career start at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has gone 3-5 with a 3.86 ERA (41 ER/95.2 IP), 64 strikeouts and a .227 (82-362) opponents average in 15 career starts.
- Is 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA (29 ER/65.1 IP), 42 strikeouts and a .219 (53-242) opponents average in 10 starts this season ... has allowed 10 home runs over his last five starts at home.

## HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.42 run support average (49 RS/129.0 IP) in 2018, the fifth-lowest in the American League and the sixth-lowest in the majors.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 16 of his 22 starts, including five over his last five starts and zero runs seven times.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

## NO DECISION MADE

- Is tied for fifth in the American League and tied for 12th in the majors with nine no decisions this season ... owns a 2.62 ERA (17 ER/58.1 IP) in those starts.
- In his eight no decisions the Sox have scored a total of 27 runs, including one run once, two runs three times and three runs once ... the Sox are 3-6 when López receives a no decision.

## DAY AND NIGHT

- Is 3-5 with a 3.54 ERA (29 ER/73.2 IP), .215 (58-270) opponents average and .639 opponents OPS in 12 day starts (seven quality) this season ... compared to 1-4 with a 5.69 ERA (35 ER/55.1 IP), .287 (62-216) opponents average and .908 opponents OPS in 10 night starts (five quality).
- Has gone 4-5 with a 4.07 ERA (38 ER/84.0 IP), .224 (70-312) opponents average and .670 opponents OPS in 16 career appearances (13 starts, seven quality) during the day, compared to 8-10 with a 4.94 ERA (75 ER/136.2 IP), .272 (146-537) opponents average and .808 opponents OPS in 25 career games (23 starts) at night.

## MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

- Is scheduled to make his first career start against the New York Yankees.
- Has gone 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA (17 ER/ 25.1 IP), 24 strikeouts and .267 (27-101) opponents average in five career starts against the American League East.

## TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Lucas Giolito (7-8, 5.97 ERA) is scheduled to make his 23rd start of 2018, 12th at home and first career against the New York Yankees.
- Is 2-1 with a 3.19 ERA (11 ER/31.0 IP) and .198 (21-106) opponents average over his last five starts.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 8/3 at Tampa Bay, allowing one run on two hits over 7.0 IP ... has surrendered 15 home runs in his last 13 starts ... the Sox won, 3-2.
