#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won four of their last six games as they continue a seven-game, six-day trip this afternoon with the finale in Minnesota.
- RHP James Shields, who owns a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.1 IP) over his last four starts, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox have won two of the first three games of this series, rallying last night for a 5-2 victory after splitting a doubleheader on Monday.
- Following today's game, the White Sox conclude the trip with three games at Boston (6/8-10) before returning home for seven games vs. Cleveland (6/11-14) and Detroit (6/15-17).
- The Sox went 2-1 on their last homestand vs. Milwaukee from 6/1-3 and 1-5 on the last trip to Detroit (1-2) and Cleveland (0-3) from 5/25-30.

#### TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are looking to win their first series at Target Field since a three-game sweep from 4/11-14/16.
- Sox starting pitchers own a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) over the last five games ... the bullpen owns a 2.83 ERA (24 ER/76.1 IP) over the last 23.
- James Shields has thrown at least 6.0 IP in eight starts, including 7.0-plus IP in his last four ... Shields has made four quality starts in a row, his longest streak since 6/29-7/26/16 (six).
- José Abreu has 33 RBI in 40 career games at Target Field.
- Daniel Palka is hitting .333 (10-30) with three home runs and six RBI over his last nine games.

#### ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to today's game, the White Sox purchased the contract of LHP Xavier Cedeño from Class AAA Charlotte.
- Cedeño, 31, takes the roster spot of LHP Aaron Bummer, who was optioned to Charlotte following last night's win over the Twins ... he will wear uniform No. 52.
- Chicago's 40-man roster increases to 40.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Tim Anderson's two-run single highlighted a four-run, sixth-inning rally as the White Sox recorded a 5-2 victory at Minnesota.
- Trailing, 2-1, entering the sixth, the Sox loaded the bases on singles by Yolmer Sánchez, José Abreu and Kevan Smith ... after a wild pitch scored Sánchez with the tying run, Anderson followed with his game-winning single off Ryan Pressly.
- Héctor Santiago (2 ER/5.0 IP) earned the victory, while Bruce Rondón (1.1 IP), Jace Fry (0.2), Nate Jones (1.0) and Joakim Soria (1.0) combined for 4.0 scoreless IP in relief ... Soria posted his sixth save of the season and second in as many games.

#### BIG GAME JAMES

- RHP James Shields owns a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.1 IP) over his last four starts and a 3.45 ERA (18 ER/47.0 IP) over his last six.
- Shields is allowing 0.83 home runs per 9.0 IP in 2018, down from 2.08 in 2017, and has lowered his opponents average from .252 to .229.
- He reached the 40,000-pitch milestone on 5/27 at Detroit (postseason included) and needs 12.1 IP for 2,500 in his career ... Shields ranks 69th all-time with 2,131 strikeouts.

#### SOX DRAFT RECAP

- The White Sox selected 20 pitchers (12 RHP and eight LHP), five catchers, 10 infielders and five outfielders in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft ... the Sox drafted 29 collegiate players and 11 from high school.
- The White Sox opened the draft on Monday by taking Oregon State INF Nick Madrigal in the first round (fourth overall) and Oklahoma OF Steele Walker in the second round (46th overall).

#### LONG BALL

- José Abreu hit his 134th career home run in Tuesday's nightcap, a two-run shot off Zack Littell, to tie Jim Thome for 13th in White Sox history ... Minnie Miñoso is 12th in Sox history with 135 home runs, José Valentín is 11th with 136 and Ron Kittle is 10th with 140.
- Yoán Moncada hit his third leadoff homer of the season in Tuesday's opener, already tied for the 11th-highest, single-season total in franchise history ... Ray Durham holds the Sox record with six in 2001.

#### STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the major leagues with 53 stolen bases this season and rank second with an 82.8 (53-64) success rate.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 146 bases this season, which would be two less than their combined total of 148 from 2016-17 ... they have not led the majors in steals since 1966 (153).

#### WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- The Twins lead the season series, 5-3, going 2-2 at Target Field (three PPD) and 3-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The Sox are batting .228/.273/.384 (61-268) with a 4.24 ERA (33 ER/70.0 IP) and have been outscored, 37-30.
- Chicago is 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups (2001-17).
- The White Sox trail the all-time series, 428-478 ... they are 231-221 at home (117-102 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 197-257 on the road (38-42 at Target Field).

#### SOX-TWINS CONNECTIONS

- HOF Jim Thome played for both the White Sox (2006-09) and Twins (2010-11) and hit a game-winning homer in Chicago's 1-0 victory vs. Minnesota in Game 163 of the 2008 season.
- White Sox pitching coach Don Cooper (1981-82) and bullpen catcher Mark Salas (1985-87) both played for the Twins.
- Sox OF Daniel Palka played in the Twins organization in 2017.
- Twins LHP Zach Duke (2015-16), INF Eduardo Escobar (2011-12) and RHP Addison Reed (2011-13) played for the Sox.

#### LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 9-15 against the American League Central in 2018, going 1-6 at home and 8-9 on the road.
- Chicago has lost 15 of its last 22 games vs. the AL Central, and is 17-30 in its last 47 road games against the division.
- The Sox are 300-392 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

#### NO REST FOR THE WEARY

- The White Sox are in the beginning of a stretch from 6/5-24 where they play 21 games in 20 days from 6/5-24 (2-1 so far) ... they also are in the middle of a stretch from 5/25-6/10 where they play 13 of 16 games on the road.

#### QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,339 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,336) and 44 more than Oakland (1,295), the next-closest American League team.

#### SOUTHERN STARS

- OF Eloy Jiménez, SS Danny Mendick, RHP Ian Hamilton, and C's Zack Collins and Seby Zavala will represent Class AA Birmingham in the 2018 Southern League All-Star Game.
- Those five will play for the North Division All-Stars on 6/19 at Birmingham's Regions Field.

#### SOUTH ATLANTIC STARS

- Class A Kannapolis will send seven players plus manager Justin Jirschele to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.
- RHPs Blake Battenfield, Jake Elliott and Tyler Johnson, OFs Craig Dedelow and Luis González and INFs Tate Blackman and Laz Rivera will represent the Intimidators at the All-Star Game on 6/19 in Greensboro, S.C.

#### 30/30 THREAT

- SS Tim Anderson (11 HR/13 SB) is one of three players in the major leagues this season with at least 10 home runs and 10 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts (17/13) and the Angels Mike Trout (19/13).
- Anderson is on pace to record career highs with 30 homers and 36 stolen bases ... the 30 home runs would be the most by a shortstop in Sox history, and the 36 steals would be the most since Ozzie Guillén in 1989 (36).

#### TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank fourth in the majors this season with 18 triples ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their highest total since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez is tied for the major-league lead with six triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

#### NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 13th in the American League and 26th in the majors with a .229 (105-456) average with RISP in 2018.
- The Sox are hitting .190 (22-116) with RISP in their last 16 road games (since 5/1).

#### ON DECK: BOSTON RED SOX

- The White Sox conclude the trip this weekend with three games at Fenway Park ... RHP Dylan Covey (1-1, 2.82) is scheduled to start the series opener.
- The White Sox went 1-6 against the Red Sox in 2017, winning the opener before dropping the final six ... Boston's four-game sweep on 8/3-6/17 was its first against the White Sox at Fenway Park since 7/21-24/88.

SHIELDS AT A GLANCE

- Is scheduled to make his 14th appearance (13th start), sixth (fifth) on the road and second vs. Minnesota ... is looking to record his first win since Opening Day (3/29) at Kansas City.
His 11-start winless stretch is tied for the longest of his career (also 7/4-9/4/17 with the White Sox).
Is 0-2 with a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.1 IP), 1.06 WHIP and .210 opponents average (21-100) in his last four starts, all quality ... has worked 7.0-plus IP in four straight starts for the first time since 8/30-9/15/14 (also four) ... his last time with five straight was 8/11-9/1/13 with the Royals.
Is tied for sixth in the American League with six no decisions in 2018.
Ranks 69th all-time in major-league history with 2,131 strikeouts, 18 behind Dennis Martínez (2,149) for 68th all-time (see chart at right).
Is 10-25 with a 5.62 ERA (192 ER/307.2 IP), 232 strikeouts, 65 home runs allowed and a 1.49 WHIP over 56 appearances (55 GS/24 QS) since being acquired by the White Sox from the Padres in a trade on 6/4/16.
Ranks among the active MLB leaders since 2007 in games started (2nd, 363), IP (2nd, 2,363.0), pitches thrown (2nd, 37,176), quality starts (T4th, 223), shutouts (5th, 9), opponents GIDP (5th, 194), complete games (T5th, 22), strikeouts (8th, 2,027) and wins (T10th, 133).

LAST START

- Suffered his sixth loss on 6/2 vs. Milwaukee after allowing three runs on eight hits, including three home runs, with one walk and six strikeouts over 7.0 IP ... had allowed four home runs all season entering the start.
Surrendered solo home runs to Erik Kratz in the third, Jonathan Villar in the seventh and Lorenzo Cain in the eighth ... held the Brewers scoreless in the fourth, fifth and sixth.
Left the game in the eighth after allowing the Cain homer ... threw 103 pitches (69 strikes) ... the White Sox were limited to five hits, including four singles, in their 5-0 loss.
Worked 7.0-plus IP for the fourth straight start ... received one run of support or less for fifth straight time.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

- Has been charged with a loss or no decision in his last 11 starts, with his only win this season coming on Opening Day (3/29) at Kansas City ... the 11-start winless stretch is tied for the longest of his career.
The winless stretch is tied with Minnesota's Kyle Gibson (active) for the second-longest among starters in MLB this season ... Miami's José Ureña is 0-7 in his first 12 outings this season.
Is 0-5 with a 4.26 ERA (33 ER/69.2 IP), .226 opponents average and 1.94 run support average (15 RS) over his last 11 starts.

WARMING UP WITH THE WEATHER

- Is 0-3 with a 3.45 ERA (18 ER/47.0 IP), .193 opponents average and 0.98 WHIP over his seven starts (six QS) since 5/1 ... has worked 7.0-plus IP four times and allowed three runs or less in six outings.
Ranked among the MLB May leaders in opponents SLG (5th, .252), opponents average (6th, .173), hits per 9.0 IP (6th, 5.40), opponents OPS (6th, .500), WHIP (T10th, 0.93) and opponents OBP (11th, .248).

HELP WANTED

- Has received one run or less of support in his last five starts (zero three times) and three or less in each of his last 10 (1.25 RSA; 9 RS/64.2 IP) since 4/11... the club scored 17 runs in his first two outings.
The 10-start stretch of three runs or less of support is his longest since 9/27/15-6/8/16 (13 consecutive starts; 1.90 RSA, 16 RS).
Received a 5.46 run support average (71 RS/117.0 IP) over his 21 starts last season, compared to a 3.22 mark (65 RS/181.2 IP) in 2016 ... his 4.60 career RSA is the ninth-lowest among active pitchers.
His 3.22 RSA in 2016 was the lowest in baseball and the lowest of his career.
Owns a 4.34 RSA (148 RS/307.0 IP) as a starter since joining the White Sox (55 starts), receiving the following run support marks: zero runs (15x), one (9x), two (9x), three (7x), four (4x), five (3x) and six-plus (8x) ... has received one run or less of support in 43.6 percent (24-55) of his outings with the Sox.

FEELING INDECISIVE

- Is tied for sixth in the American League and tied for 12th in the major leagues with six no decisions this season ... his 73 NDs since 2011 are tied with Cole Hamels for the most in the major leagues.
In his six no decisions this season, Chicago has scored a total of 10 runs, including two runs twice, one run once and zero runs four times ... the White Sox are 3-3 when Shields receives a ND.

NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Has surrendered seven home runs this season, including three in his last start (first multihomer outing) ... snapped his stretch of 14 consecutive appearances without allowing multiple homers, the second-longest of his career ... last allowed two-plus home runs on 9/14/17 at Detroit (three).
Has allowed 74 homers since 2016 and 107 since 2015 ... his 107 homers allowed since 2015 are the second-most in MLB behind Kansas City's Ian Kennedy (110).
Allowed 27 home runs last season, his fewest since 2014 (23) ... surrendered a major-league leading 40 home runs in 2016 after leading baseball with 33 in 2015 ... became the first pitcher to lead MLB in homers allowed in consecutive seasons since Tom Browning in 1988-89.
Has allowed 1.67 homers per 9.0 IP since 2015 (577.1 IP), the fourth-highest mark in the major leagues.

OPENING DAY HONORS

- His season debut marked his eighth career Opening Day start following four with Tampa Bay (2008-10, '12), two with Kansas City (2013-14) and one with San Diego (2015).
Is 2-2 with a 4.98 ERA (26 ER/47.0 IP) and 30 strikeouts in the eight OD outings.
Is tied with the Dodgers' Clayton Kershaw for the fourth-most Opening Day starts among active pitchers ... joined Edinson Vólquez as the only active pitchers to start season openers for four different teams (STATS).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Has made 20-plus starts in every MLB season, joining Cole Hamels and Justin Verlander as the only pitchers since 2006 to accomplish the feat ... recorded at least 10 victories, 200.0 IP and 160 strikeouts each season from 2007-15 ... was an AL All-Star with Tampa Bay in 2011.
Is 3-6 with a 5.46 ERA (36 ER/59.1 IP) and 45 strikeouts over 11 career postseason starts (four quality starts) ... pitched in the postseason with Tampa Bay (2008, 2010-11) and Kansas City (2014) ... made three World Series starts with the Rays (2008) and Royals (2014).

- Is 8-9 with a 4.30 ERA (73 ER/152.2 IP), 113 strikeouts, 1.43 WHIP, .266 opponents average and 15 quality starts over 25 career outings ... is 0-3 with a 5.73 mark (21 ER/33.0 IP), 28 strikeouts and a .198 opponents average in his last six starts since 2016.
Has not defeated the Twins since 6/29/16 in Chicago (1 ER/6.2 IP) ... last win in Minnesota was on 8/27/13 with Kansas City (1 ER/7.1 IP).
Has suffered the loss in four of his five career starts at Target Field, going 0-4 with a 5.63 ERA (15 ER/24.0 IP), .291 opponents average, 1.96 WHIP and 20 strikeouts.
Received a no decision in his last start on 5/6 at Guaranteed Rate Field, allowing three runs on just two hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.2 IP ... suffered the loss in his last outing at the Twins on 8/29/17, surrendering four runs on five hits in 5.0 IP.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER

- RHP Dylan Covey (1-1, 2.82 ERA) is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season, third on the road and first vs. Boston
His 2.82 ERA this season is down from a 7.67 mark (50 ER/58.2 IP) in 12 starts in 2017 ... is 1-8 with a 6.33 ERA (57 ER/81.0 IP), 1.59 WHIP and .287 opponents average over 16 career starts.
Received a no decision in his last start on 6/3 vs. Milwaukee, allowing just one unearned run on four hits with seven strikeouts in 5.0 IP.
Will make his first career appearance vs. Boston.

- White Sox relievers own a 3.16 ERA (47 ER/134.0 IP) with 129 strikeouts in 40 games since 4/24 ... the 3.16 mark is the fifth-lowest in the AL and ninth in MLB.
- Chicago relievers have made 22 scoreless appearances and allowed two runs or less 42 times in 2018 ... the group has tossed at least 4.0 IP 22 times.
- Relievers are 6-5 with a 3.48 ERA (44 ER/108.2 IP), 6-9 in saves, 115 strikeouts and a .248 opponents average at home, and 3-8 with 4.80 ERA (54 ER/101.1 IP), 7-14 in saves, 100 strikeouts and a .286 opp. average on the road.
