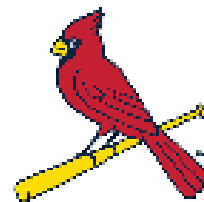

**ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals complete a nine-game/10-day road trip to Arizona, San Francisco and Chicago (AL) tonight with the second of two games against the Chicago White Sox. The Cardinals are currently 5-3 on the road trip and have won or tied all three of the series. Last night, the Cardinals scored a season-high 14 runs and tied a season-high with a seven-run inning (6th) in a 14-2 win over the White Sox on the South Side. **Dexter Fowler** hit his 4th career grand slam and **Kolten Wong** homered and tallied a game-high four hits. **Miles Mikolas** earned his 10th win, becoming the 65th instance a Cardinals pitcher won 10 games prior to the All-Star Break.

**"SWEET HOME, CHICAGO...":** The Cardinals, who play in Chicago three series each year against the rival Cubs, are making their second of four trips this season (Apr. 16-19 at CHI) to the Windy City. Tonight, the Cardinals look to sweep the four-game season series from the Pale Hose. Since taking over as manager in 2012, Mike Matheny's clubs are 7-3 vs. the White Sox and 3-0 in Chicago.

**DEX FLEX:** **Dexter Fowler** hit his 4th career grand slam last night, but his first batting right handed against a left-handed pitcher (**Hector Santiago**). The switch-hitting Fowler has hit two of his four career grand slams in the past two seasons as a member of the Cardinals. Ironically, his first career grand slam came off current teammate **Miles Mikolas**, who started last night's game and got the win.

**WONG GONE:** **Kolten Wong** was batting .105 in 34 road games entering this current road trip, but has been on fire batting .458 (11-24) with a home run, two doubles, a triple and two bunt singles on the eight games of this road trip. Wong leads all National League players with 10 hits since July 5 and has had four straight multi-hit games in which he has had at least two plate appearances. Wong tied his career-high with four hits last night, his first game with four knocks since Aug. 10, 2014 at Baltimore, and in the process hit his first home run off a left-handed pitcher this season.

**COOL GYORK':** **Jedd Gyorko** tied his career-high with three walks last night and has been putting together quite a July leading the National League in on-base percentage (.514) during the month and ranks 2nd in slugging (.767) behind **Wil Myers** (SD, 1.000). Gyorko has tallied four of his 12 multi-hit games on this current road trip in which he posted a 5 RBI game at San Francisco (July 5), starting by smoking a 3-0 pitch off **Johnny Cueto** for an opposite field three-run home run onto Levi's Landing.

**MIKOLAS SELECTED TO ALL-STAR GAME; CARPENTER ON FINAL VOTE:** The St. Louis Cardinals will be represented by right-handed pitcher **Miles Mikolas** at the Major League Baseball All-Star game as he was selected by MLB., his first All-Star selection. Infielder **Matt Carpenter** (#VoteCarp) was picked to be in MLB's Final Vote. Carpenter, a three-time All-Star, is going up against **Jesús Aguilar** (Brewers), **Brandon Belt** (Giants), **Max Muncy** (Dodgers) and **Trea Turner** (Nationals).

**SEND IN THE G.O.A.T.!:** Monday night, Major League Baseball announced that Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** will be an injury replacement for San Francisco's **Buster Posey** (right hip inflammation) in the All-Star Game. Molina, who will be making his 9th appearance at the All-Star Game (2009-15, 17), finished 4th among catchers in the fan voting and hit the game-tying home run for the National League in last season's All-Star Game in Miami. No other player in this year's game has more than seven All-Star selections.

**INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER:** **Matt Carpenter** enters tonight's Interleague matchup leading all active players with a career .623 slugging percentage in those contests while ranking T1st in batting (.332, **Mike Trout**, **Mookie Betts**) and on-base percentage (.416, **Mike Trout**).

**SMOKING HOT!:** Since May 16, **Matt Carpenter** has raised his batting average from .140 to .261 smacking a Major League-leading 34 extra base hits, 20 doubles and leads the National League with 43 runs. He's ranked among MLB leaders in home runs (14, T9th) and hits (64, T3rd) while batting .332 (T6th) and slugged .653 (5th) during that period.

#### CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Coach **Willie McGee** was originally selected by the White Sox in the 7th round of the 1976 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

First baseman **José "Cafecito" or "Cafe Jr." Martínez** originally signed with the White Sox as a non-drafted free agent (February 16, 2006)...spent seven seasons in the White Sox minor league organization before electing free agency...his father, **Carlos "Café" Martínez**...played for Chicago for three seasons (1988-90)...made MLB debut with the White Sox (Sept. 2, 1988 at Cleveland).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** managed Chicago for parts of eight seasons (1979-86)...began managerial career in 1978 in the White Sox minor league system with AA-Knoxville Sox of the Southern League...played two minor league seasons in the White Sox organization for the AAA-Denver Bears (1975) and AAA-Iowa Oaks (1976).

White Sox Pitching Consultant **Dave Duncan** served as St. Louis' pitching coach for 16 seasons (1996-2011)...under his watch, the Cardinals ranked third in the majors in overall ERA and third in starting-pitching ERA...coached **Chris Carpenter** to 2005 Cy Young Award and four Cardinals to 20 game-winning seasons (Carpenter, 2005; Adam Wainwright, 2010; Matt Morris, 2001; Darryl Kile, 2000)...awarded 2009 Meritorious Service Award by St. Louis BBWAA.

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** was born in and resides in nearby Park Ridge, Ill...graduated from Morton High School in Berwyn, Ill...played college baseball at St. Xavier University (Ill).

Pitcher **Jack Flaherty** was high school teammates with White Sox pitcher **Lucas Giolito** and Braves pitcher **Max Fried** while at Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, Calif.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) Community High School...played three seasons at Illinois State Univ. (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

Infielder **Greg Garcia's** brother, **Drew**, was selected by the White Sox in the 21st round of the 2008 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in the White Sox minor league organization (2008-13).

Catcher **Francisco Peña** made his MLB debut against the White Sox while with the Royals (May 20, 2014), his only game played that season...his father, **Tony**, played 31 games for the White Sox in 1997...later traded by the White Sox to Houston for pitcher **Julien Tucker** (August 15, 1997).

White Sox outfielder **Charlie Tilson** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 2nd round of the 2011 MLB Draft...later traded by the Cardinals to the White Sox for pitcher **Zach Duke** (July 31, 2016).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 52 games for the White Sox in 1988...originally traded by the Cardinals with outfielder Lance Johnson and cash to Chicago for pitcher Jose DeLeon.

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** spent 18 years (1998-2005) with the White Sox - one in TV followed by 17 seasons in the radio booth...Rooney worked with the World Champion team in back-to-back seasons, following the White Sox win in 2005.

Late Hall of Famer **Red Schoendienst** hit a game-winning solo home run off Detroit's Ted Gray in the top of the 14th inning to give the National League a 4-3 win in the 1950 All-Star Game at Comiskey Park at Chicago.

Hall of Famer **White Herzog** managed the National League in the 1983 All-Star Game at Comiskey Park in Chicago, a game that featured starting shortstop **Ozzie Smith** and reserve outfielders **Willie McGee** and **George Hendrick**.

White Sox Bench Coach **Joe McEwing** was selected by the Cardinals in the 28th round of the 1992 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1998-99)...made his Major League debut with the Cardinals on September 2, 1998 at Florida...later traded to the Mets for pitcher **Jesse Orosco** (March 18, 2000).

- Makes team-leading 19th start of the season and the 37th of his career (41st app.).
- All five of his wins this season have come on the road. Ranks T4th among National League pitchers in road wins, one behind Miles Mikolas for the team high.
- The Cardinals are 9-9 in his 18 starts: 2-6 at Busch Stadium & 7-3 on the road.
- Tonight marks his third career Interleague start and first at an American League stadium against a designated hitter.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Pitched career-high 8.0 innings in last Wednesday's 11-2 Cardinals win over the Giants at AT&T Park.
- Carried a perfect game 16 outs deep into the game.

**2018**

- Leads the Cardinals in strikeouts (89) and home runs allowed (13).
- Of his 55 runs allowed, 22 (40 pct.) have come in the 1st two innings (7-1st, 15-2nd).
- Is still seeking his first home win of the season. He's 0-4 with a 5.32 ERA in 8 starts at Busch and 5-3, 4.58 ERA in 10 starts on the road.
- Has thrown 100+ pitches three times, including season-high 104 on 6/24 at MIL.

**CAREER**

- Is 4-1 and Cardinals are 6-1 in starts which he does not issue a walk.
- Averaging 9.57 K/9 IP over his career 193.2 Major League innings.
- His 206 career strikeouts are 2nd behind only Rick Ankiel (233) for the highest total all-time among Cardinals through their first 40 career games.
- Has three double-digit strikeout games in his first 40 games, trailing only Rick Ankiel (6) and tied with Paul Derringer, Lance Lynn, & Alan Benes on the Cardinals all-time list.
- Won team-leading seven consecutive 2017 starts (8/2-9/20/17), was the 4th-longest in the National League and longest by a MLB rookie in 2017...he was the first Cardinals rookie to achieve the feat since Ted Wilks (1944) & Johnny Beazley (1942) (*Elias*).
- Became the fifth rookie pitcher in the last 70 years to allow two runs or fewer over seven consecutive winning starts, joining Fernando Valenzuela (eight straight in 1981), Cal Eldred (1992), Jered Weaver (2006) and Steven Matz (2016) (*Elias*).
