SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Joey Lucchesi** has pitched to a 1.96 ERA with a .164 opponent average despite posting a 1-2 record over his last four starts...this is just the fourth time in his 14 career starts that he's worked less than 5.0 innings.
- **Christian Villanueva's** 42 RBI this season are the most by a Padres rookie before the All-Star break in franchise history (was previously tied with Carmelo Martinez who had 41 in 1984).
 - His home run in the seventh inning had a launch angle of 16 degrees, tying him with Hunter Renfroe for the lowest launch angle on a Padres home run this season, according to Statcast...leads all Major League rookies with 18 home runs on the year.
 - Has hit .304 in his last seven games at home (7-for-23) with one double and two home runs.
- **Austin Hedges** recorded his fifth multi-hit game of the season...is batting .409 (9-for-22) in seven games in July with two doubles, two homers and five RBI.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- **Kenta Maeda** is 4-2 with a 1.97 ERA (11 ER, 50.1 IP) and a .179 opponent average in his last nine starts since May 17...has posted a 5-3 record with a 4.40 ERA in 11 career starts against the Padres, limiting batters to a .242 average over that span.
 - Has tallied exactly nine strikeouts in each of his last four starts.
- **Cody Bellinger** logged his 21st double of the season, surpassing Chris Taylor for the team lead...is 6-for-12 with four doubles this series.
- **Max Muncy** recorded his 15th multi-hit game of the year...went 2-for-4 tonight with a run scored and has reached base safely in 38 of his last 40 games since May 23.
- **Matt Kemp** has gone 19-for-45 (.422) with eight runs, four home runs and 14 RBI in 12 games against his former team this season.
