TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants look to bounce back after being shut out for the eighth time this season last night, as they face the Padres for game two of this three-game set...San Francisco has dropped 17 of their last 21 games, including each of their past five contests.

INSIDE THE SERIES: Despite last night's loss, the Giants have posted a 10-7 record against the Padres this season and have won six of their last eight contests.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Chris Stratton allowed five runs on six hits in 3.0 innings of work in his last start against San Diego last Wednesday...since Aug. 21, he's posted a 3.13 ERA (13er, 37.1ip) over six starts...he'll oppose LHP Robbie Erlin, who is 1-3 with a 5.64 ERA (19er, 30.1ip) in eight games (five starts) against the Giants.

BATTER-PITCHER MATCHUP: IF Brandon Crawford enters tonight 6-for-10 in his career against Erlin with a double, triple and one RBI.

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants have committed just three errors in their last 11 games...SF's eight errors are tied with the Washington Nationals for the third-fewest in the Majors since Sept. 1...the San Diego Padres and Houston Astros have each committed seven errors.

AGAINST LEFTIES: The Giants are slated to face a left-handed starter for the 62nd time this season, which ranks as the second among all Major League teams behind the Dodgers (63)...SF is 29-32 when facing left-handed starting pitchers this year.

IN THE BULLPEN: Giants' relievers have combined to allow 15 earned runs in 17.2 innings (7.64 ERA) while allowing a .261 (18-for-69) opponents' average against in the last five games.

RISP MANAGEMENT: San Francisco has just seven hits in their last 43 at-bats (.163) with runners in scoring position...dating back to Sept. 1, the Giants' .169 average with RISP ranks as the lowest figure in the Majors...the Padres have the second-lowest average with RISP during that stretch at .199.

IN THE DIVISION: The Giants are 37-34 against the National League West this season and will play their final five games within the division (San Diego: tonight-Wednesday and Los Angeles-NL: Friday-Sunday)...last season, SF posted a 29-47 record against the West.

SECOND HALF STRUGGLES: San Francisco's .222 batting average since the break is on pace to be the lowest second-half mark in franchise history, and would be the lowest post-All Star average by any team since the 1974 Padres (.212) (Stats, LLC).

SAVING RUNS: According to Baseball Info Solutions, the Giants have 38 defensive runs saved this season, which ranks 11th in the Majors...last season, SF ranked 26th in the Majors with -43 defensive runs saved.

GIANTS PITCHERS: Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.47 ERA, which ranks as the fourth-best figure in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.27), Houston (3.42) and Tampa Bay (3.44).

CLOSE CALLS: The Giants have played 107 games this season that have been decided by just three runs or fewer, the most such games of any MLB team this year...SF is 51-56 (.477) in such contests.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: San Francisco is 21-66 (.241) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 51-19 (.729) when plating four-or-more runs.

This Date in Giants History: September 25, 1965

At age 34, **Willie Mays** became the oldest player to slug 50 home runs in a season...the Giants center fielder was also the youngest to accomplish the feat, hitting 51 homers in 1955.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#34 RHP Chris Stratton
6-2, 211, 28 years old (August 22, 1990)
10-10 Record, 4.88 ERA

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 27th appearance (26th start) in what most-likely will be his final start of the season...has gone 10-10 with a 4.88 ERA in 26 games (25 starts), with the Giants going 13-12 in his starts this year.
- The Giants have lost eight of his last 10 trips to the hill.
- Was charged with five runs on six hits in just 3.0 innings of work in his last start at San Diego last Wednesday in an 8-4 Giants loss...drove in the Giants' first three runs with a bases-loaded double, his first career extra-base hit and career-high three RBI.
- Spun his first career shutout en route to picking up his team-high 10th win of the season in his outing Sept. 19 against Colorado, a 2-0 Giants victory...also set a career-high with 9.0 innings pitched (previous career best was 8.0 innings earlier this year on August 27 vs. Arizona).
- Is the first SF starter to reach double-digit wins this season and first to do so since 2016 when **Johnny Cueto** (18), **Madison Bumgarner** (15) and **Sarmadzija** (12) all reached at least 10 victories.
- In six starts since returning from the minors, Stratton is 2-3 with a 3.13 ERA (13er, 37.1ip).
- Was optioned to triple-A following his start Aug. 3 after he allowed six runs on 10 hits in 3.0 innings at Arizona.
- Former Giants All-Star **Ryan Vogelsong**, now a part-time roving instructor in the minors, worked with Stratton when he was sent back to triple-A...Stratton was rotating too much with his delivery, causing his fastball to flatten out and cut back over the heart of the plate.
- Is 2-3 with a 4.70 ERA (12er, 23.0ip) in five games (four starts) against San Diego...has fashioned a 0.92 ERA (7er, 22.2ip) in his four starting assignments.
- Went 3-0 with a 3.00 ERA (8er, 24.0ip) in four starts with triple-A Sacramento.
- Drafted by the Giants in the first round (20th overall) in the 2012 draft out of Mississippi State University... since making his MLB debut in 2016, the Giants have gone 18-13 (.581) in his starting assignments.

NOTES: 28-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his third Major League start for the Giants tonight and the 12th of his big league career... has made two starts for SF this season, going 0-1 with a 2.61 ERA (3er, 10.1ip) and a .340 opponents average against...his last start came on Aug. 22 at New York-NL...threw 6.0 innings, allowing four runs (two earned runs) on seven hits with four strikeouts...has made three outings as a reliever this year for the Giants, posting a 0-1 record with a 1.23 ERA (1er, 7.1ip) and a .200 opponents average...is 2-7 with a 5.87 ERA (35er, 53.2ip) in 11 career big league starts (eight starts with San Diego, one with Atlanta and two with San Francisco).
