### TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** won their second of four against Baltimore and improve to 37-48 on the season...are 22-20 at home and 7-11 against the AL East...are 4-1 against the Orioles this season and improve to 15-156 against the O's in Minnesota all-time...improve to 21-27 in night games, 28-33 against right handed starters and 22-19 when scoring first...when getting a quality start from the starting pitcher the Twins are 24-14.
- **LANCE LYNN** earned the win and improved to 6-7 on the season...went 6.0 innings and allowed one run on six hits, his seventh quality start of the season...walked two batters, struck out three and did not allow an extra-base-hit...recorded his first win against Baltimore since August 10, 2014.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (2-for-4) extended his hitting streak to four games, hitting .429 (6-for-14) during the streak...he recorded his second multi-hit game of the season and 54<sup>th</sup> of his career.
- **MAX KEPLER** (1-for-4) recorded his ninth home run of the season, fourth off of a right-handed pitcher, fifth of the season at Target Field and second on a 3-1 count...has now hit safely in 11 of 12 career games vs. Baltimore, hitting .391 (18-for-46) with six doubles, one triple, four home runs 15 RBI, and six walks.
- **JOE MAUER** (2-for-4) recorded an RBI single in the fourth inning, his 897<sup>th</sup> career RBI...is hitting .339 (98-for-289) against the Orioles in his career...recorded two hits today, marking his 15<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season and his 548<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of his career...ranks fourth in Twins history (since 1961) in multi-hit games.
- **MITCH GARVER** (2-for-2) recorded two singles, his 10<sup>th</sup> of the season...since June 6, he is hitting .358 (19-for-53).
- **EDDIE ROSARIO** (2-for-4) threw out Tim Beckham at home in the top of the seventh inning, his seventh outfield assist of the season...entering the game he was tied-fourth with Corey Dickerson among all MLB left fielders in outfield assists with 6, trailed Trey Mancini (7), Alex Gordon (7) and Kyle Schwarber (8)...marked his 33<sup>rd</sup> multi-hit game, leads the team.

### ORIOLES NOTES:

- **THE ORIOLES** lost the second of the four to the Twins, drop to 24-63 on the season and 0-4 on their current six game road trip...drop to 6-8 against the AL Central and 1-3 against the Twins this season...are now 12-34 on the road and 8-37 when the opponent scores first...are now 156-156 in Minnesota and 332-293 against the Twins all-time.
- **DYLAN BUNDY** suffered the loss, his eighth of the season, now 6-8 on the year...went 3.1 innings, his second shortest start of the season since failing to record an out on May 8 vs. KC...the two strikeouts are the second fewest of a start this season...allowed a two-run home run to Max Kepler in the fourth inning, his 19<sup>th</sup> home run allowed this season, most on the team...today's loss snapped his three game win streak.
- **MANNY MACHADO** (2-for-3) singled in the first inning and now has a hit in 66 of his 85 games this year...extended his hitting streak at Target Field to six games and has safely hit in 16 of 18 games in Minnesota, hitting .421 (32-for-76)...walked in the sixth inning, his 40<sup>th</sup> of the season, leading the team...recorded his 30<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season, leading the team.

- **JOHNATHAN SCHOOP** (1-for-4) extended his hit streak to four games, hitting .375 (6-for-16) during the streak.
- **MARK TRUMBO** (2-for-4) recorded two singles, marking his 14<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.
- **CALEB JOSEPH** (3-for-4) recorded his 13<sup>th</sup> three-hit game and first since July 2, 2017 vs. Tampa Bay.
