TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals continue a four-game series tonight with the 15th meeting between the teams this season...This set marks the Braves' final trip to Washington this season; they will play host to the Nationals for the final three games between the teams, September 14-16.

A The teams split a doubleheader yesterday, with the Braves taking the night game, 3-1...The Braves can finish the season with a winning record at National Parks with a win today and tomorrow...After going 6-4 here last season, it would mark the first time since the park opened in 2008 that the Braves had consecutive winning seasons in Washington...They went 1-19 at Nationals Park from 2015-2016.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his fifth start against Washington this season...The righty tossed a two-hitter against the Nationals on June 1 in a 4-0 win at SunTrust Park, but has failed to complete 6.0 innings in his other three starts against the division rival...Overall, he is 4-4 with a 4.26 ERA (27 ER/57.0 IP) in 10 career starts against Washington.

A LHP Tommy Milone is set for his first career start against Atlanta...The lefty faced them twice last year in relief, tossing 2.2 innings and allowing four runs, earned...He went 7.0 innings and allowed one run, earned, against the Mets to win his only home start this season.

NEVER QUIT WITH SNIT: The Braves scored two runs in the ninth inning to take the lead and beat the Nationals in the second game of yesterday's doubleheader after they went ahead in the 10th inning on Sunday in a 5-4 victory over the Mets...The Braves now have 13 last at-bat wins this season, tied for the third most in the National League and two off the lead of the San Francisco Giants.

A Since Brian Snitker was named interim manager on May 17, 2016, the Braves have a National League-most 50 last at-bat wins.

A The Braves finished with a league-high 20 final at-bats wins last season after leading the N.L. with 19 such victories in 2016.

A The Braves have scored 184 of their 522 runs (35.2%) this season in the seventh inning or later... Their 184 late-inning runs are the sixth most in baseball.

INCIARTE HITS: OF Ender Inciarte's two-run, ninth-inning triple broke a 1-1 tie last night and helped the Braves split yesterday's doubleheader.

A Since the All-Star break, Inciarte is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with four doubles, one triple, one home run and eight RBI.

A Inciarte is a career .319 hitter after the All-Star break...He hit .241 (88-for-365) prior to the game this season.

FREEMAN STREAKING: 1B Freddie Freeman ran his hitting streak to nine games after collecting a single in each end of yesterday's doubleheader...Freeman is batting .343 (12-for-35) with a .395 on-base percentage during his run that dates to July 29.

A With a hit tonight, Freeman will fashion his third double-digit hitting streak of the season...He went 16 games from May 19 to June 3 and then another 10 games from June 5 to June 16.

A The only major leaguer with three double-digit hit streaks this season is Houston's Yuli Gurriel...He had a 13-gamer, a 12-gamer and a 11-gamer.

A The last Braves player with three double-digit hitting streaks in a single season was Martin Prado in 2011.

MARKAKIS AND FREEMAN HITS: OF Nick Markakis leads the major leagues with 139 hits, while teammate 1B Freddie Freeman is tied for second with 135.

A The pair are second and third in batting average, with Markakis' .323 mark percentage points behind Christian Yelich's average...Freeman is at .315.

A Markakis is on pace for 205 hits, while Freeman is on pace for 199...No pair of Braves teammates have ever reached 200 hits in the same season...The last major league team with multiple players reaching 200 hits in a season was the 2016 Boston Red Sox (Mookie Betts and Dustin Pedroia)...The last National League team to have two players reach that milestone was the 1998 Colorado Rockies (Dante Bichette and Vinny Castilla).

MINTER SAVES: LHP A.J. Minter collected his ninth save of the season last night, tossing a scoreless ninth inning to preserve a 3-1 lead.

A Minter is the first rookie left-hander to reach nine saves since Houston's Billy Wagner also had nine in 1996...Since the save became an official stat in 1969, only 10 left-handed rookies reached double-digit saves, with the last being Houston's Al Osuna in 1991...The record is 20 by Houston's Frank DiPino in 1983.

STOPPER: LHP Sean Newcomb tossed 6.0 innings yesterday, allowing one run, earned, with six strikeouts and just five hits against, and left the game with the score tied at one...Newcomb's start came after the Braves dropped game one of yesterday's doubleheader, 8-3.

A Yesterday's start was Newcomb's 13th turn this season following a Braves loss...The lefty is 8-1 with a 1.82 ERA (16 ER/79.1 IP) and a .188 batting average against in these starts.

A His 1.82 ERA is the second best among pitchers with at least 10 such starts this season...Only New York's Jacob deGrom has a better mark with a 1.76 ERA.

Tonight's Game

- Ⓜ Set to make his 22nd start of the season and the 87th of his career...Is his 107th career appearance.
- Ⓜ Makes his 12th start against the N.L. East, and is 5-3 with a 1.97 ERA (14 ER/64.0 IP) in his first 11 turns.
- Ⓜ Among pitchers to make at least 10 intradivision starts, Foltyniewicz's ERA is fourth lowest in the majors...Only Justin Verlander (1.64 vs. A.L. West), Jacob deGrom (1.82 vs. N.L. East) and Trevor Bauer (1.97 vs. A.L. Central) have lower ERAs against their own divisions.
- Ⓜ Despite Foltyniewicz's success, Atlanta is just 6-5 in his 11 intradivision starts.
- Ⓜ Faces Washington for the 11th time in his career, and for the fifth time this season... Is 4-4 with a 4.26 ERA (27 ER/57.0 IP) and 49 strikeouts in his first 10 starts.
- Ⓜ Pitched against them in his first start out of the All-Star break, 7/22 at Nationals Park...Took the loss after allowing nine hits and four runs over 5.2 innings.
- Ⓜ Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. Washington at SunTrust Park, allowing two hits and fanning 11...Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on 5/2/01 at Turner Field.
- Ⓜ Has allowed multiple runs in each of his last five starts...Allowed multiple runs in just five of his first 16 starts to open the season.
- Ⓜ Is 2-3 with a 6.14 ERA (20 ER/29.1 IP) in his last five turns, dating to 7/6 at MIL...Went 6-4 with a 2.02 ERA (20 ER/89.0 IP) in his first 16 starts.

2018 Recap

- Ⓜ Stopped a two-game losing streak with a win in his last turn, 8/2 at NYM...Allowed five hits and two runs over 6.0 innings...Struck out five.
- Ⓜ The two-game skid was his first time losing consecutive starts since dropping each of his final seven starts of 2017.
- Ⓜ Was selected to his first major league All-Star Game after going 7-5 with a 2.66 ERA (30 ER/101.2 IP) over 18 games to open the season...Fanned 120 batters over 101.2 innings of work.
- Ⓜ Tossed a scoreless fourth inning in his All-Star Game debut, retiring José Ramírez, Manny Machado and José Abreu, while walking Aaron Judge.
- Ⓜ His 120 strikeouts before the All-Star break are tied for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...John Smoltz fanned 149 batters in 134.0 innings before the break in 1996 to set the Atlanta franchise mark.
- Ⓜ Held the Cardinals scoreless over 5.0 innings, 7/1 at STL...Allowed just one hit and fanned nine.
- Ⓜ The start was his 11th of the season allowing one run or fewer, and those 11 starts came in his first 17 turns on the season...The Atlanta franchise record for starts allowing no more than one run is 19, set by Greg Maddux over 34 starts in 2002.
- Ⓜ Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/25, and started vs. Cincinnati...Allowed one hit and one run over 5.0 innings...Missed seven games with right triceps tightness.
- Ⓜ Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, 6/12 vs. NYM, allowing just two hits while fanning six.
- Ⓜ Threw a season-low 73 pitches before exiting the game with right triceps tightness...Was placed on the 10-day disabled list, 6/16.
- Ⓜ Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. Washington...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
- Ⓜ Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- Ⓜ Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
- Ⓜ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th.
- Ⓜ Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI... Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
- Ⓜ Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career.
- Ⓜ Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park... Snapped a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
- Ⓜ Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.

- Ⓜ Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 1/2 Holds: 6 1st Batter/Retired: 38/28 Inherited Runners/Scored: 10/3

- Over his last 29 appearances, dating to 5/19, has a 1.87 ERA (7 ER/33.2 IP) with a .158 (18-for-114) opponents' average and six holds...Six of the 29 games have spanned at least 2.0 innings.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arody Vizcaíno, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Has gone more than 1.0 inning in 11 outings this season, compiling a 0.78 ERA (2 ER/23.0 IP) with 33 strikeouts...Two of his three wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 3-for-27 (.111) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-13 (.077) with two outs.
- Right-handed batters have just 13 hits in 94 at-bats (.138) against him...Lefties are hitting .258 with 16 hits (62 at-bats), however since 5/19, left-handed batters are hitting .188 (9-for-48).
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Saves/Opp: 11/13 Holds: 5 1st Batter/Retired: 45/30 Inherited Runners/Scored: 15/2

- Has tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with a pair of holds and four strikeouts in three games with Atlanta.
- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .273 (27-for-99) average, while lefties are hitting .321/.404/.429 in 90 plate appearances.
- Since 2015, ranked fourth in the American League with 242 appearances.
- The 32-year-old as an eight-year major league veteran, pitching to a career record of 30-21 with a 3.16 ERA (152 ER/432.1 IP) in 397 games prior to Atlanta acquiring him.

- Has fanned 32 batters in his 23.0 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 66 batters in 44.1 combined innings (13.4 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Has five outings of at least 2.0 innings this season, and has a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) with one save in those appearances...Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/ Gwinnett.
