### CARDINALS NOTES

**ADAM WAINWRIGHT** made his sixth start of the season, first against the Dodgers in 2018 and 13th career start (16th app.) vs. the Dodgers (6-5)... earned his first win since April 17 at Wrigley Field vs. CHI...has allowed just one run in his last three starts (20.0 IP) vs. the Dodgers (dating back to 6/26/14) and ran his scoreless streak vs. LAD to 12.0 innings...became the first pitcher to hurl 1,000 career innings at Busch Stadium III with his 5th out of the game...struck out a season-high nine batters, his most since fanning nine (4/21/17 at MIL) and last at home since getting nine vs. PIT (7/7/16)...last game pitching over 100 pitches was 7/22/17 at CHI (107)...last Cardinals starting pitcher to strike out nine or more batters in a game was **JACK FLAHERTY** at LAD (8/22) with 10 and the 12th instance by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season...has pitched 6.0 or more innings in 12 straight starts against the Dodgers dating back to August 10, 2007, currently T-3rd longest active streak vs. LAD trailing only **CURT SCHILLING** (19) and **DAVID CONE** (16), both retired.

**MARCELL OZUNA** tallied his 29th go-ahead RBI of the season, leading the National League...has recorded 150 or more hits in three seasons (2014, 2017 & 2018)...recorded his 11th game with three or more hits

**YAIRO MUÑOZ** has scored 10 runs in the month of September, tying July for his highest run output in a month.

**JEDD GYORKO** has hit safely in his last nine games started (14-34, .412), collecting an RBI single in the 4th inning...21st multi-hit game of the season.

**YADIER MOLINA** collected his first hit since missing six games (9/6-12) and his first RBI since a grand slam on 9/4 at WSH.

**JORDAN HICKS** made his first appearance in seven days (9/9 at DET)...pitched 2.0 or more innings for the 7th time this season and first since 7/4 at ARI; all seven have been scoreless.

**CARLOS MARTÍNEZ** made his 200th career appearance tonight...induced his 14th double play of the season.

*Bud Norris was removed from the game in the 7th inning with a right middle finger blister.*

**THE CARDINALS** clinched their 11th straight winning season...won the season series over the Dodgers 4-3...snapped a four-game losing streak, their longest of the season...pitched their 8th shutout of the season and first since 8/30 vs. PIT...the last time the Cardinals shutout the Dodgers was 6/1/17 at Busch Stadium, which was also a start by **ADAM WAINWRIGHT**.

### DODGERS NOTES

**ROSS STRIPLING** made his 19th start (31st app.) of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and second career start (5th app.) vs. the Cardinals (1-2)...has pitched only 3.1 innings in each of his last two starts.

**PAT VENDITTE** has pitched eight straight scoreless appearances (7.2 IP)...retired a batter both as a left-handed pitcher and right-handed pitcher in two-thirds of an inning pitched.

**SCOTT ALEXANDER** recorded a double play on only one pitch in his appearance, the 7th pitcher in MLB to accomplish that feat this season and the first Dodgers pitcher since **JOE BLANTON** vs. COL (4/24/16).

**JUSTIN TURNER** has collected 100 or more hits for the 4th straight season and 5th overall...hit safely in his last five games (9-18, .500).

**RYAN MADSON** struck out the side facing only three batters in an appearance for the 8th time in his career and first with the Dodgers.

**THE DODGERS** had their 23-game home run streak snapped, one game short of the club record held by the 1953 Brooklyn team...were shutout for the 8th time this season and first since 8/4 vs. HOU...finished their 10-game road trip 6-4.
