SunTrust Park Quick Facts

Ballpark

Size

- 1,114,400 square feet

Capacity

- Approximately 41,000 seats
- 4,000 premium seats with various levels of amenities
- 19,000 seats will be \$20 and under; 7,000 of those seats will be \$10 or less

Field dimensions/orientation

- Dimensions: LF Corner 335'; Left Center 375'; Center Field 400'; Right Center 375'; RF Corner 325'; Wall height varies from 6' in LF to 16' in RF. From home plate to center field, STP faces southeast.

BravesVision

- Installed by Panasonic, the new BravesVision scoreboard is 64 feet tall and 121 feet wide, utilizing 16 mm resolution SMD (Surface Mount Display) LED display - the latest technology in LED displays.
- The BravesVision control room is located in SunTrust Park and acts as the nerve center for all video content displays throughout the ballpark and The Battery. The control room is operated by a staff of 30 every game day.

Cameras

- The team added five Grass Valley LDX 86 hard cameras, four positioned under the videoboard and facing out at the crowd; the fifth LDX hard camera will be positioned at high home. Rather than position the cameras in traditional broadcast locations, the Braves plan to rely on the home broadcast feed for game coverage and use their own cameras to capture fan reaction, crowd shots, and more. Two additional wireless cameras will roam the stadium and provide extra coverage as needed.

LED boards

- SunTrust Park has more than 30 LED boards, with resolutions ranging from the 16-mm BravesVision display to a 6-mm display in the stadium's Xfinity Rooftop in right field.

- Rounding out the LED signage at SunTrust Park will be two closed-captioning displays, sponsorship signage (including an LED sign in place of the iconic Chick-Fil-A cow's sandwich board), highway marquees, and Plaza displays. The Plaza will also feature a giant baseball wrapped in a spherical Nano Lumens LED display.

Out-of-town scoreboard

- A 90- by 30-ft. out-of-town scoreboard will be installed in left center field.

Bullpen LEDs

- Two LED displays — each measuring 90 by 6 ft. — will be installed above each bullpen in right center field.

Lights

- SunTrust Park will utilize LED Sports lights (as compared to incandescent lights at Turner Field) that can be programmed for situational scenarios to flash, chase or pulsate.

Canopy

- A canopy triple the size of those in other ballparks will encircle a majority of the seating bowl, providing more coverage to more seats than ever before.

Cantilever design

- The configuration of SunTrust Park maximizes sightlines and elevations, placing a higher percentage of seats closer to the field than any ballpark in Major League Baseball. This is made possible by a three-tiered, cantilevered seating bowl, which brings even the seats farthest from home plate closer to the action.

Sound system

- Utilizing the newest technology, the new sound system will give the team the ability to play with stereo effects, chase effects, and more.

Field installation

The layering of the field went in this order:

1. Geothermal pipe
2. Stone
3. Some drain pipe
4. Membrane
5. More drain pipe
6. Irrigation pipe
7. More stone(smaller)
8. Trench drain
9. Sand
10. Sod

Amounts of each field material:

- Drainage Pipe 20,600 LF- Linear feet

- Stone Backfill 14,300 CY-Cubic Yards
- Trench Drain 1,180 LF
- Membrane 115,000 SF-Square feet
- Irrigation pipe 4,100 LF

- Sod 109,000 SF

Ballpark Build

The project's 30-month timeline was made possible by the hybrid design of concrete and steel. This option was chosen for many reasons:

- Careful planning and execution to maximize resources – as many as 10 cranes were on site at one time, up to 14 but including the cranes on the office and plaza.
- The use of Structural precast to make up the stadium and some of the outfield structure was faster to install and less costly to the project than cast-in-place stadia, yet still provided the same level of quality. The building design with the architectural precast not only provided a stunning façade, but also allowed for the designers to introduce elements like brick and stone.
- Focused VDC efforts utilized technology to eliminate collisions that cost time and money, as well as accurate logistics planning and 4D scheduling
- QA/QC (such as laser scanning) that help avoid time critical issues and prevent any rework
- A concerted effort toward safety – OSHA partnership as an example – safety and efficiency go hand-in-hand.
- Mockups – including virtual reality and more than a dozen physical mockups – exposed minor details to some of the more complex systems as well as suites and clubs allowing construction to move forward as decisions could be made in advance. Mocked up the suites and we also did first in place mock-ups for Populous and Braves to ensure they were getting exactly what they wanted.

Premium and Suites

SunTrust Club

A premium level option at SunTrust Park, the SunTrust Club features 160 seats that are closer to home plate than the pitcher's mound, making it the most exclusive seating environment in SunTrust Park. This all-inclusive club features fully padded 23 inch seats, valet parking and a variety of premium food options.

- Square Feet: 5,719
- Capacity: 160 Seats

Delta SKY360 Club

Atlanta's hometown airline welcomes fans to seats in the Delta SKY360 Club, which features state-of-the-art technology layered with rich natural materials. The club will offer an exceptional dining experience utilizing two active display kitchens, a 30-foot long bar with marble slab top and a more casual sports bar that will be home to two seven-foot by 20-foot LED video boards.

INFINITI Club

Located on the Terrace Level, the INFINITI Club features premium food and drinks, as well as one-of-a-kind Braves memorabilia and exclusive artwork. It has a private entrance and exclusive area for Braves fans to eat, drink and mingle. INFINITI, the official luxury vehicle of Braves, has several of its vehicles on display outside the club.

Party Suites

SunTrust Park offers six party suites overlooking right field corner, adjacent to the Konica Minolta Conference Center. These suites feature glass windows as well as outdoor seating and 65 inch TVs, and include several F&B options.

Champions Suites

Champions Suites are the second closest suites to home plate in all of Major League Baseball, and feature a large interior lounge space along with outdoor seating. The suites are decorated with exposed wood beams and sliding glass doors and 23-inch fully padded seats, and include several F&B options.

- Special Features: Fully padded seats; private concourse, six valet parking

INFINITI Suites

INFINITI Suite holders will have several menu options to choose from that are included in their overall package, and additional amenities such as in-suite branding, access to private events and more. INFINITI Suites feature sliding glass doors, outdoor seating and 23-inch fully padded seats.

Group Spaces

Xfinity Rooftop

The Xfinity Rooftop is a private group space in right field offering panoramic views of the field and The Battery Atlanta. The Xfinity Rooftop is composed of three different areas, two of which can be rented individually. At the back of the Xfinity Rooftop, there will be a large enclosed bar space open to the public called the Xfinity Lounge.

- Capacity: 300 if rented as a whole

Xfinity Patio

The Xfinity Patio is an open-air space overlooking right field, with an array of food options nearby including Waffle House, and a drink service from a Flying Cloud Airstream trailer. Ticket holders also have access to the Xfinity Lounge.

Xfinity Cabanas

Located on the Xfinity Rooftop, cabanas give fans the perfect spot to relax in their own personal space. Each cabana has an LED video screen for fans to take in the Braves game, with unique food and drink options and outdoor games located nearby.

Terrace Gardens

Located behind the Hank Aaron Terrace, this private hospitality space offers a refreshing partially open-air spot for up to 150 people. Packages include three unique food and beverage options, as well as seating conveniently located in Terrace Reserved.

Hank Aaron Terrace

The Hank Aaron Terrace is a semi-private group space at SunTrust Park featuring an inside bar, outdoor seating and a display of Aaron's 715th home run bat and ball.

The Home Depot Clubhouse

A 40-person hospitality suite set in left centerfield, The Home Depot Clubhouse will showcase featured products from the company. The suite is available for purchase on a game-by-game basis with its patrons able to place Ks on the clubhouse's facade to track every Braves strikeout. Guests of The Home Depot Clubhouse will also get a visit from the famous Home Depot Tools during every game.

Coca-Cola Corner

Coca-Cola Corner is a seating section in left field that will be beneath a large sign bearing the iconic Coca-Cola script logo. Each fan sitting in this section will receive a complimentary 20-ounce Coca-Cola beverage with their ticket.

Coors Light Below the Chop

Located along the warning track in right field, the Coors Light Below the Chop is just inches from the field. Below the Chop offers a ground level view from the right fielder's perspective. This private group space features décor that pays homage to some of the greatest outfielders to wear a Braves uniform - Dale Murphy, Hank Aaron, Andruw Jones - as well as a private bar and three unique food and beverage packages to choose from.

Coors Light Chop House Deck

This party deck can be reserved by groups, and overlooks right field, with easy access to the Top of the Chop bar as well as the Holeman & Finch burger stand.

Konica Minolta Conference Center

The Konica Minolta Conference Center is located on the Terrace Level of SunTrust Park, and is the perfect venue for meetings, receptions or seminars. This facility offers food and beverage options, high-definition TVs, Audio/Visual capabilities and discounted tickets located in the Terrace Reserved seating area.

Batter's Eye Deck

The social headquarters of SunTrust Park, Batter's Eye Deck is located in centerfield just below the BravesVision scoreboard. Accommodating up to 150 people, groups can take in all the pregame activities from this premier spot before enjoying the game from their Home Run Porch seats. Rentals of the Batter's Eye Deck also include F&B options.

Special Areas

Hope & Will's Sandlot

"Hope and Will's Sandlot," is a large, kid-friendly area hosted by Children's Healthcare of Atlanta that will have the first-ever zip line and climbing tower inside a professional sporting venue. Visitors will be able to use the new Braves app to reserve a timeslot to access both of these attractions. There also will be a batting cage and a variety of other interactive games in addition to kid-friendly food and merchandise.

- **Carnival Games:**
 - Hope and Will's Pop Up – Balloon racer game that fans fire a water pistol to a target that will fill up a balloon, 1st balloon to burst wins.
 - Hope and Will's Hydration Station – Water Guns are fired at a targets that when hit will raise a Braves Tomahawk, Tomahawk to reach its maximum height wins.
 - Hope and Will's Chop-A-Mole – This is a whack-a-mole game.
 - Hope and Will's Pick 'Em Off – Each Participant fires a gun that shoots out balls into targets. First Player to fill all six targets wins.
- **Video Simulators:**
 - Hope and Will's Strike Zone – Video Pitching Simulator where participant throws baseball at a screen in an attempt to strike out a batter at SunTrust Park. Also displays speed of pitch.
 - Hope and Will's Home Run Derby – Video Hitting Simulator where participant hits a ball off of a batting tee into a screen which then displays where the ball lands at SunTrust Park.

 - Hope and Will's Climbing Tower – 8 climbers try to reach the top
 - Hope and Will's First base Dash – Participant runs from Home to 1st racing a light board that simulates the speed of Braves Player
 - Hope and Will's Pop Flier – 2 Zip Lines

Coors Light Chop House

A three-story restaurant that spans 10,000 square feet, the Coors Light Chop House sits in right field, offering stellar views of the action on the field for patrons. The Coors Light Chop House also features decks if fans want to move festivities outside, while it also boasts areas that can be turned into group spaces for individual games.

Terrapin Taproom

The Terrapin Taproom features a rotating tap list with many of the signature beers that have elevated and defined the Athens-based brewer. Adjacent to the Terrapin Taproom is the ATL Brew Lab, a microbrewery where Terrapin will experiment with various types of brewing and craft special brews only available at SunTrust Park. The acclaimed Fox Bros. BBQ brings its award-winning BBQ along as the perfect pairing for a cold beer and great day at the ballpark.

Plaza

The Plaza is located outside of the Chop House Gate, and will be the main entry point for guests coming from The Battery Atlanta. The Plaza features two stages which will be used for pregame and postgame entertainment, as well as a water feature, a baseball-shaped LED sphere hanging above the Plaza that

can display a variety of content, and the Fox Sports South set that will be used for their pregame and postgame shows. Fans can also access the Braves Clubhouse Store and the Terrapin Taproom from the Plaza without needing to enter the ballpark gates.

Mizuno Glove Experience

A first-of-its-kind, the Mizuno Glove Experience will be located inside SunTrust Park and allow fans to check out Mizuno baseball gloves to catch foul balls and home runs during the game. Fans will be able to return the gloves at no cost or purchase them at the end of the game.

- Location: Located by Left Field Gate and Chop House Gate on the Terrace Level
