TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland enters play tonight with a 4.5-game cushion in the A.L. Central, marking the largest current divisional lead in MLB...the Tribe's 30-25 record is one game ahead of the 102-win 2017 club through 55 games (29-26).

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** finished the month of May with homers in each of his last three games...his 18 homers are tied for the MLB lead, and are the second-most by an Indians player through May 31 (**Albert Belle** - 21 in 1996).

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** posted his second game this month with two homers and two doubles, making him the first player in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) to collect two such games in the same calendar month...just six other players have two career games with those criteria in the same span.

» The Indians have scored 52 runs over their current six-game winning streak (8.67 runs per game), batting .326 as a team with 16 homers and 17 doubles.

» **The Indians finished the month of May with an MLB-high 179 runs scored (6.39 runs per game), 287 hits, 68 doubles and .283 team batting average, while they ranked 2nd with 48 home runs (their most in a month since a club-record 51 in Sept/Oct 2005).**

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians jumped out to an early 8-0 lead, weathered a Twins comeback and held on to win 9-8 for their sixth consecutive victory...marks the club's longest win streak since their A.L.-record 22-game streak from August 24 - September 14, 2017, and moves them to a new high-water mark of five games above .500.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** led the Tribe's 12-hit attack, going 4-for-5 with two doubles and a pair of home runs...his solo shot in the top of the 8th inning broke an 8-8 tie and provided the final margin of victory...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** went 2-for-5 and homered for the third straight game with a solo shot in the top of the 4th...**JASON KIPNIS** was 2-for-4 with a double, while **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (0-3, two walks) saw his MLB-long hit streak come to an end at 19 games.

» **SHANE BIEBER** took a no-decision in his Major League debut, allowing four runs on eight hits over 5.2 innings of work...struck out six batters against just one walk, including a punchout of **Brian Dozier**, his first career batter faced.

SCORE TACTICS

» The Indians have scored 281 runs this season, good for 4th in the American League (5th in MLB)...the club's +33 run differential in May was 4th-best in MLB...the Tribe has scored seven-or-more runs in six consecutive games, marking their longest streak since a franchise-record 10-game run from April 27 - May 8, 2001.

» **Cleveland has also slugged 84 home runs this season, 2nd-most in MLB (New York-AL - 87)**...the club's 47 longballs at home rank 2nd in MLB (New York-AL - 49).

» The Indians are the only team in MLB boasting five players with 30-or-more RBI (**Ramírez** - 41, **Brantley** -36, **Lindor** -34, **Encarnación** - 34 & **Alonso** - 33)...they are also one of just two teams claiming four hitters with 10-plus homers (New York-AL also has four such batters).

TWIN BILLING

» The Indians and Twins are meeting this weekend in the second of six series between the divisional rivals...Cleveland currently holds a 2-1 mark against Minnesota this season.

» The Indians went 12-7 in their season series against Minnesota in 2017, including a mark of 9-1 at Target Field...since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013, Cleveland owns a record of 55-43 (.561) vs. the Twins.

» Cleveland has posted a mark of 14-5 against the A.L. Central this season, and they enter play tonight with a season-high 4.5-game cushion over second-place Detroit (26-30).

ZIMMER ADDED

» The Indians announced today that **BRADLEY ZIMMER** has been activated from the 10-day Disabled List...**SHANE BIEBER** has been optioned to Columbus following his start last night.

» Zimmer was placed on the DL with a left rib contusion on May 15, and he has batted .224 in 32 games with Cleveland this season.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH CANDIDATES

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** hit .336 (36-107) in the month of May with 11 homers, 12 doubles and 25 RBI...he finished the month on several MLB leaderboards, ranking T1st in extra-base hits (23), 2nd in home runs (11), 2nd in OPS (1.189), T2nd in runs scored (26), T3rd in doubles (12) and T4th in RBI (25).

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** won American League Player of the Week honors in each of the first two weeks of May, and overall batted .373 (44-118) for the month with 10 homers, 13 doubles and 23 RBI...he shared the MLB monthly lead in extra-base hits (23), while also ranking 1st in runs scored (27), 1st in hits (44), 2nd in doubles (13), T3rd in home runs (10), 4th in OPS (1.169) and T10th in RBI (23).

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** batted .333 (38-114) for the month with seven homers, seven doubles and 26 RBI...he hit safely in 23 of his 27 games, while reaching via hit or walk in 26 of 27 contests...his 19-game hit streak from May 9-30 was the longest by any batter in MLB this season...he ranked T2nd in MLB with 26 runs scored this month, also finishing 3rd with 26 RBI and T10th with 38 hits.

BATTERING RAM

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** homered for a third straight game last night, as he tied **Mike Trout**, **J.D. Martinez** and **Bryce Harper** for the MLB lead in home runs...matches his longest career streak with at least one home run (September 3-5, 2017), and ties for the longest streak by an Indians batter this season (**Yonder Alonso**, April 26-28)...the last longer streak by an Indians batter was a five-game run by **Mike Napoli** from July 30 - August 3, 2016.

» **Ramírez ranks second in franchise history with 18 homers through the end of May...Albert Belle** collected 21 homers entering June 1, 1996, en route to a 48-homer, 148-RBI campaign.

» **Ramírez enters play tonight among the American's League's Top 10 in several categories, including home runs (18, T1st), extra-base hits (35, 2nd), total bases (135, 3rd), RBI (41, T3rd), OPS (1.030, T3rd), slugging percentage (.637, 4th), plate appearances per strikeout (10.2, 5th), walks (31, T6th) and doubles (17, T8th).**

FRANKIE ON FULL BLAST

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** concluded his historic month with a two-homer, two-double game last night, his second of May (also May 12 vs. Kansas City).

» **He became the first player in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) to record two games with multiple homers and multiple doubles in a single calendar month...**only three other players (**Adrian Beltre** - 2007, **Jim Edmonds** - 2003 & **Rafael Palmeiro** - 1993) have recorded two such games in a single season...those four aforementioned players, plus **Babe Ruth**, **Hack Wilson** and **Brady Anderson**, are the only hitters in that time span with two career games matching those criteria.

» **Lindor and JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** each finished the month of May with an MLB-high 23 extra-base hits...the last Indians player with more in a calendar month was **Albert Belle**, who set a franchise record with 27 extra-base hits in both August and Sept/Oct 1995.

COOKIES AT TARGET

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** is set to make his 12th start of the 2018 campaign in tonight's contest.

» Last pitched on May 26 vs. Houston, where he picked up the win at Progressive Field after allowing five runs on seven hits over 5.2 innings (2BB, 8K) in the Tribe's 8-6 win over the Astros.

» **Carrasco posted a perfect 3-0 record with a 0.92 ERA (2ER/19.2IP) in three starts vs. Minnesota last season, going 2-0 here at Target Field...**earlier in 2018, he tossed 7.0 shutout innings in a no decision at MIN in Puerto Rico on April 18, and owns a 2-1 record with a 1.88 ERA (6ER/28.2IP) in four divisional starts.

» The right-hander currently ranks T1st in the American League with two complete games, while he is also 9th with a 2.70 ERA in night games and T9th with six wins.

KIP ON STREAKING

» **JASON KIPNIS** extended his on-base streak to 20 games with a 2-for-4 performance last night...marks the 4th-longest active streak in MLB, trailing Detroit's **Jeimer Candelario** (25 games), Atlanta's **Freddie Freeman** and **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (both 21 games).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1987: Hall of Famer **Phil Niekro** earns the win after allowing six runs (five earned) over 5.2 innings in the Tribe's 9-6 win over Detroit at Cleveland Municipal Stadium...gave Niekro 314 career wins which, when paired with his brother Joe's 216 wins at the time, surpassed former Indians **Gaylord (314)** and **Jim Perry (215)** for the most career wins by a pair of siblings in MLB history...the Niekros concluded their careers with 539 combined wins.
