RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their seven-game, eight-day homestand (4-PIT, 3-MIA) tonight against Miami...the Cardinals opened their homestand by taking three of four from the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates, and face the Marlins for two more games before traveling to Cincinnati for a three-game series...the Cardinals began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.5 games back of the 1st place Milwaukee Brewers...the Redbirds are 6-4 in their last 10 games and 10-10 over their previous 20.

HOME GROWN: Twenty current players on the Cardinals 40-man roster were selected by St. Louis in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft: **Yadier Molina** (2000 - 4th Rd.), **Tommy Pham** (2006 - 16th Rd.), **Luke Gregerson** (2006 - 28th Rd.), **Matt Carpenter** (2009 - 13th Rd.), **Sam Tuivailala** (2010 - 3rd Rd.), **Greg Garcia** (2010 - 7th Rd.), **Tyler Lyons** (2010 - 9th Rd.), **Kolten Wong** (2011 - 1st Rd.), **Ryan Sherriff** (2011 - 28th Rd.), **Carson Kelly** (2012 - 2nd Rd.), **Oscar Mercado** (2013 - 2nd Rd.), **Mike Mayers** (2013 - 3rd Rd.), **Michael Wacha** (2012 - 1st Rd.), **Luke Voit** (2013 - 22nd Rd.), **Luke Weaver** (2014 - 1st), **Jack Flaherty** (2014 - 1st Rd.), **Austin Gomber** (2014 - 3rd Rd.), **Harrison Bader** (2015 - 3rd Rd.), **Jordan Hicks** (2015 - 3rd Rd.) and **Paul DeJong** (2015 - 4th Rd.). Other notable draft picks in Cardinals history include **John Mabry** (1991 - 6th Rd.) and **Oliver Marmol** (2007 - 6th Rd.).

MENDOZA & WARNER TABBED AS TOP MINOR LEAGUERS DURING THE MONTH OF MAY: The Cardinals announced today their selections for Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for May, with third baseman **Evan Mendoza** (Palm Beach-A/Springfield-AA) and left-handed pitcher **Austin Warner** (Palm Beach-A) taking the honors. Mendoza, the Cardinals 11th round selection in the 2017 draft out of North Carolina State University, batted a combined .369 with a .895 OPS in 28 games played between Palm Beach (A) and Springfield (AA). Warner, 23, went 2-0 with a 0.91 ERA in four starts for Palm Beach last month, including a three-hit shutout on May 21 at Lakeland when he struck out 10. In his 29.2 innings of work, Warner fanned 35 and issued just one walk. The 5-11, 185-pound lefty, who hails from Louisville, KY, was signed by the Cardinals in June 2017 as a non-drafted free-agent out of Bellarmine (KY) University.

PEORIA CHIEFS LAND SIX ON ALL-STAR TEAM: The Midwest League announced the 2018 Mid-Season All-Star Teams and the Peoria Chiefs (A) will be represented by six players at the June 19 game in Lansing, Mich., the most by any Western Division team. First baseman **Yariel Gonzalez**, second baseman **Irving Lopez** and third baseman **Elehuris Montero** were voted in by league managers as starters. Catcher **Dennis Ortega** is a reserve while relievers **Bryan Dobzanski** and **Thomas St. Clair** were also selected.

START ME UP: The St. Louis starting rotation has surrendered a MLB-low 25 home runs and paces the league in ground ball pct. (47.9), ranks 2nd in the NL in ERA (2.95), H/9IP (7.43), WHIP (1.16), OPP AVG (.225), T3rd in wins (22), and 4th in quality starts (27).

POWER PLAY: The Cardinals have homered in 41 of their first 58 games, going 29-12 (.707 win pct.) in those games...they are 3-14 when they do not homer...among NL clubs, only Milwaukee (31-8; .794) & Atlanta (29-11; .731) have a better winning pct. when homering.

HOMERS AT HOME: The Cardinals are 16-4 (.800 win pct.) in games they homer in at Busch Stadium this season...only Milwaukee & Philadelphia (both 16-3; .842) have better marks among NL clubs when homering at home.

ARMS RACE: **Preston Guilmet** became the 22nd different pitcher (39th player) to appear in a Cardinals uniform this season, T5th-most in MLB this season (Tampa Bay leads with 24)...The club used 25 pitchers all of last season and a record 26 in 2002.

MIAMI CONNECTIONS

Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** spent parts of five seasons in a Marlins uniform (2013-17) where he was a two-time National League All-Star (2016-17)...won the 2017 National League Silver Slugger and Rawlings Gold Glove award selection...originally signed with the Marlins as a non-drafted free agent (February 15, 2008)...became a Cardinal via trade with the Marlins this offseason, exchanged for pitchers **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Sandy Alcántara** and outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** (December 14, 2017).

Cardinals pitcher **Miles Mikolas** made his MLB debut vs. the Marlins in 2012 while with the San Diego Padres.

Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** and pitcher **Carlos Martinez** represented St. Louis in the 2017 MLB All-Star Game at Marlins Park...Molina became the 7th Cardinal (14th time) to homer in an All-Star game, while Martinez joined **Dizzy Dean** (1934) as the only two Cardinals with four strikeouts in an All-Star Game.

Cardinals Hitting Coach **John Mabry** appeared in 81 games for the Marlins during the 2001 season...traded by the Cardinals to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations (April 9, 2001).

Cardinals infielder **Luke Voit** hit his first Major League home run against Miami, a two-run shot off **Jarlin Garcia** (July 3, 2017).

Cardinals pitcher **John Brebbia** graduated from Wellington Community (Fla.) High School.

Marlins pitcher **Brad Ziegler** graduated from Odessa (Mo.) High School...pitched at Missouri State University (2000-03) in Springfield, Mo.

Marlins VP of Scouting **Stan Meek** was selected by the Cardinals in the 15th round of the 1974 MLB Draft...played four seasons (1974-77) in the Cardinals' minor league system.

Marlins broadcaster **Jeff Nelson** was invited to 2006 Major League Spring Training with St. Louis as a non-roster player, but was released at the end of Spring Training.

Marlins pitcher **Kyle Barraclough** was selected by the Cardinals in the 7th round of the 2012 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2012-15)...traded by St. Louis to the Marlins for pitcher **Steve Cishek** (July 24, 2015)

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter Fla. as their Spring Training site...RDGS is also the only stadium in the country to host four minor league teams: Jupiter Hammerheads and Palm Beach Cardinals of the High-A Florida State League, and the GCL Marlins and GCL Cardinals of the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League.

The Marlins played their first regular-season game at Marlins Park against St. Louis (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win in **Mike Matheny's** first game managed.

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

- Since May 20, has 22 strikeouts over his last three starts, T9th-most among NL pitchers (Max Scherzer and Jacob DeGrom lead with 29).
- His 56 strikeouts in his first 12 career games are the 4th-most among Cardinals in franchise history (Alan Benes leads with 65).

- Earned his first career Major League win with a 13-strikeout masterpiece to lead St. Louis to a 5-1 victory over the Phillies on 5/20 at Busch Stadium. Established single-game career highs in innings (7.2), strikeouts and pitches (120).
- Retired the first 10 batters and 12 of the final 13; his lone blemish being a first-pitch solo home run to Rhys Hoskins in the 4th inning.
- Became the 8th Cardinal to post 10 or more strikeouts in one of his first nine MLB starts and the most recent since Luke Weaver (8/31/2016 at MIL).
- His 13 strikeouts are the most by a Cardinals pitcher this season and most since Carlos Martínez fanned 13 Brewers (6.0 IP) on 8/29/2016.
- The 13 strikeouts tied a Cardinals record for most by a rookie, along with Shelby Miller (5/10/13 vs. COL), Dick Hughes (5/30/67 at CIN) and Scipio Spinks (6/25/72 at NYM).
- His 13 strikeouts in one of his first 10 career MLB games surpassed the previous Cardinals record of 11 (Alan Benes in 1996 & Harvey Haddix in 1952).
- Joined MIL's Freddy Peralta (5/13/18 vs. COL, 13) as the second MLB pitcher to strike out at least 13 batters while recording his first career MLB win in 2018.
- Was the 6th Cardinal in franchise history to allow 2 or fewer hits, 2 or fewer walks, and strike out 13 or more batters in a start, joining Ernie Broglio (7/15/60 vs. CHI), Bob Gibson (6/17/1970 at SD), Todd Stottlemire (5/11/98 vs. MIL), and Shelby Miller (5/10/13 vs. COL) and Jaime Garcia (4/14/16 vs. MIL).
