FULLY RESTED IN SEATTLE: In 2 hours and 49 minutes, the Padres toppled their Northwest, maritime foe 2-1 in the first of the brief two-game set in Seattle...the victory marked the first time the Friars have won three-straight games against SEA since they won four in a row from June 12-22, 2012...starter **Bryan Mitchell** worked 6.0 innings, allowing four hits and just one run (earned)...**Craig Stammen** was credited with the win, and **Kirby Yates** earned his eighth save of the season...**Wil Myers** doubled home **Travis Jankowski** in the ninth inning for his ninth-career go-ahead RBI in the ninth inning or later (his second such RBI this season: July 8 @ ARI).

THAT'S A BAD, BAD STAMMEN: **Craig Stammen** has been awarded the victory in consecutive games for the second time in his career (also: April 12-13, 2012)...a win in his next appearance overall will mark a career high streak for the veteran righty, and it would tie the Padres reliever record for wins in consecutive appearances (done seven times, most recently by **Cla Meredith** from Sept. 3-6, 2006)...if he wins today vs. SEA, he'll be the first Padre reliever to ever be credited with a win in three consecutive games (not just appearances).

THE BIG 5-OH: With last night's win, the Padres have an all-time record of 50-55 against the Seattle Mariners...San Diego has not won a series @ Safeco Field since they swept the Mariners from June 12-14, 2012 in Seattle.

SPLITS V. SEATTLE: In '18, Padres batters have hit .295/.318/.508 vs. Mariner righties with 4 2b and 3 hr and .205/.244/.282 with 3 2b vs. Seattle southpaws.

HE'S KIND OF A BIG DEAL, THIS FRANMIL: In 19 games since Aug. 21, **Franmil Reyes'** 1.177 OPS leads the NL and is second in the ML behind HOU Alex Bregman's 1.278 OPS...among players who have had at least 200 at bats this season, his 13.33 homer rate (ab/hr) is the second-best in the National League (behind just LAD Max Muncy's 10.97 ab/hr).

THE YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS: Among all active rosters, the Padres are the youngest team in the majors by average age (26 years and 242 days old)...the Seattle Mariners, meanwhile, are the second-oldest team (on average) in the majors (30 years and 30 days), behind just the Cleveland Indians (30 years and 188 days).

CHECK OUT THE NEW WHIP: This season, the SD bullpen has featured a 1.19 WHIP, which is the best in the NL and tied for second-best in baseball with NYY (behind just HOU's 1.05).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD: Friar relievers haven't allowed a run in three straight games and in 12.0 innings...opposing bats have hit .135 against them in that time.

THE LIMIT DOES NOT EXIST: In the second half of the season, the SD bullpen has the best opponent clip in the NL (.222)...only OAK (.205) and HOU (.214) have better opponent averages in that time in the majors.

PADRES ON DECK *POSTSEASON ADDITION: Last night, Tulsa scored a 3-2, walk-off win in the bottom of the 10th to defeat San Antonio (AA) in the opening game of the best-of-five Texas League Championship Series...3B **Hudson Potts** went 2-for-4 with a HR, and LF **Josh Naylor** was 2-for-5 with a stolen base and a run scored...RHP **Michel Baez** allowed two runs on one hit in 5.2 innings, but he issued four walks and hit two batters with four wild pitches...tonight, RHP **Emmanuel Ramirez** will start for the Missions as the series continues in Tulsa before moving to San Antonio.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (7-8, 3.59)

IT'S JOEY TIME: 25-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make the 23rd start of his career and second in his last three outings against the Seattle Mariners.

BY LAND AND BY SEA: Earned his seventh win of the season in his first career matchup vs. Seattle on 8/29, tossing career highs in innings pitched (6.2) and pitches thrown (108) while tying a career high with nine strikeouts (3x) in SD's 8-3 victory.

LAST TIME OUT: Has now been saddled with the loss in each of his five career starts against Arizona...is 0-5 with a 6.85 ERA (18 ER, 23.2 IP) and a .286 opponent average, but hasn't received more than two runs of support in any of those five outings.

GET TO 6.0: He has reached the 6.0 inning mark on five occasions...in those starts, he is 4-0 with a 1.17 ERA (4 er, 30.2 ip)...the Padres are 4-1 in those starts.

OFF TO THE RACES: Is one of just 20 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in a single season in Padres franchise history...along with fellow rookie southpaw Eric Lauer, its the first time the Padres have had two rookies make 20-or-more starts since 1977...it's now been done so on five occasions (also: 1969, 1972 and 1974).

- The Padres have now had a rookie reach the 20 start mark in three consecutive seasons, with Dinelson Lamet making 21 in 2017 and Luis Perdomo's 20 in 2016...prior to 2016, the last Padre rookie to make 20 starts was Justin Germano in 2007.
- His 22 starts are sixth-most among rookies this season.

NO WALKS FOR YOU: Lucchesi's 38 walks allowed this year are the sixth-fewest of any NL hurler who has made at least 22 starts.

AWAY FROM HOME: Is 2-3 with a 2.98 ERA in his eight starts away from Petco, with his only three road losses coming against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field...road opponents are slashing a line of .221/.278/.364...in his 14 starts at Petco, he has posted a 3.97 ERA and a .260/.332/.446 line.

REACHING...: Among all pitchers who have made at least 22 starts this season, Lucchesi has allowed 143 base runners, tied for the fourth-fewest in the majors.

COMING UP CLUTCH: With RISP this season, Lucchesi has a .229 opponent average (16-for-70) with three extra-base hits allowed (one double and two homers)...opponents have a .275 OBP in such scenarios.

- Opponents are hitting .171 (6-for-5) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME: Joey has recorded three pickoffs and fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with 10...their 13 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history, and the Padres' 19 pickoffs in total lead the National League and rank tied for first in the majors with the Chicago White Sox.

SINCE YOU'VE BEEN BACK: In his 13 starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL with a right hip strain on June 20, he is 4-6 with a 3.86 ERA (27 er, 63.0 ip), allowing two earned runs or less in 10 of those 13 outings while holding opposing bats to a .245 clip.

SHOWING HE BELONGS: The Padres selected Lucchesi to the Major League roster to start the club's second game of the season on March 30...he went on to allow three earned runs or fewer in eight of his first nine career outings from March 30-May 14, posting a 3-2 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 er, 47.1 ip) and 9.13 SO/9 IP.

- Missed 32 games from May 14-June 20 with a right hip strain, and he went 1-3 with a 3.60 ERA over his final five starts of the first half, limiting hitters to a .187 average.

THROUGH FOUR, UNDER 2.00: Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was **Odrisamer Despaigne** in 2014 (1.35).

FIRST IN CLASS: Made his Major League debut on March 30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**....teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league

LONGING FOR SOME LAUER: LHP **Eric Lauer** is set to make his 21st start and first of the season on Friday vs. the Rangers.

- Is one of just 20 rookies in Padres franchise history to make 20 starts in a single season...along with fellow lefty Joey Lucchesi, it marks just the fifth time the Padres have had two rookies make at least 20 starts in a season.
- In his last 13 starts since 6/2, Lauer has posted a 3.53 ERA (26 ER, 66.1 IP)...allowing three earned runs or less in 11 of his 13 outings.
