TWINS CAN'T WRAP TRIP THE RIGHT WAY: The Twins lost to the Brewers yesterday afternoon but a score of 3-2 at Miller Park, suffering their fifth sweep this season, second on the roadtrip...José Berríos (8-7) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched, all three runs being solo homers...the offense recorded six hits, two from both Eduardo Escobar and Jorge Polanco...the Twins went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position and left four men on base.

AGAINST THE ORIOLES: Slegers will be making his first career start vs. the Orioles today... has faced one AL East opponents previously in 2017, did not factor into the decision against Tampa Bay on September 6, 2017 when he allowed five runs on five hits and two walks with three strikeouts...has faced Baltimore minor league affiliates twice in his career, both coming last season in Triple-A Rochester against Norfolk...went 1-0 in two starts with a 5.12 ERA (12.1 IP, 7 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts...earned a win against Norfolk on August 12, 2017, allowed two runs on eight hits with six strikeouts over 7.1 innings.

LAST YOU SAW ME: Slegers was recalled on May 30 and joined the bullpen...he entered in the second inning at Kansas City and threw 5.1 innings allowing just two runs on six hits, one home run and one walk...did not factor in the decision, an eventual Twins loss 8-11...struck out three batters, tying his career-high and made it the fourth time in five appearances he struck out exactly three batters.

ROCKIN' ROCHESTER: Slegers has made 14 starts in Triple-A Rochester this year, going 5-6, 3.55 ERA (83.2 IP, 33 ER) with 19 walks and 55 strikeouts...started the year 5-0 with a 1.97 ERA (50.1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts with six walks and 29 strikeouts...has since gone 0-6 with a 5.94 ERA (33.1 IP, 22 ER) with 13 walks and 26 strikeouts...his last start was June 30 against Lehigh Valley, suffered the loss after allowing four runs on four hits and three walks with eight strikeouts, a season high, over 6.0 innings.

ANOTHER FRESH FACE: By making his start today, Slegers is now the ninth different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year...he's also the 24th different pitcher to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre), tied for most in the AL with Tampa Bay and tied for sixth most in baseball.

HOW DID I GET HERE?: Slegers was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana University from 2011-2013, going 9-3, 2.29 ERA (114.0 IP, 29 ER) with 21 walks and 64 strikeouts in 24 games (18 starts)...went 9-2, 2.04 ERA (106 IP, 24 ER) in 18 starts as a junior in 2013.

- Spent most of the season with Triple-A Rochester
