THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-3 through five games on their nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Cleveland and 1-1 in Texas...today the Twins will continue the trip with the third of three at Texas...following today's game, the Twins will travel to Houston for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

TEXAS TAKES THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night by a score of 7-4...José Berríos (11-10) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Andrew Vasquez made his major league debut, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 0.2 innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Logan Forsythe and two from Joe Mauer.

EXTRA-BASE MAUER: Joe Mauer has 596 extra-base hits in his career and needs two to tie Tony Oliva for fourth most in Twins history (since 1961):

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Zack Littell from Triple-A Rochester...Littell, 22, finished the Triple-A season going 6-6 with a 3.57 ERA (106.0 IP, 42 ER), 40 walks and 98 strikeouts over 19 games (15 starts) for the Red Wings...this will mark Littell's third stint with the Twins this season, having previously appeared in two games including making one start on June 5 vs. Chicago-AL...Littell was acquired by the Twins (with Dietrich Enns) last July from the New York Yankees in exchange for Jamie Garcia...the Twins now have active 31 players on their major league roster.

MAUER MAKING A RUN: Joe Mauer has scored 1,003 runs in his career and needs one to tie Clyde Milan for sixth on the Twins/Senators franchise list (since 1901):

TWINS AND TEXAS: The Twins are 2-3 vs. the Rangers this season, 1-2 at Target Field and 1-1 at Globe Life Park...they are 5-2 in their last seven at Texas...in those seven games, they are averaging 11.4 hits-per-game and 7.0 runs-per-game.

- ☞ Max Kepler has 17 RBI in 17 career games against Texas.
- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .352 (31-for-88) with seven doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and 14 runs scored...his 31 hits are his most vs. any non-AL Central opponent.
- ☞ Joe Mauer is hitting just .237 (90-for-379) in 99 career games vs. Texas, his lowest average against any AL team.
- ☞ Chris Gimenez played two seasons for the Rangers in 2014 and 2015, hitting .259 (53-for-205) with 16 doubles, five home runs and 25 RBI in 70 games.
- ☞ Bullpen Coach Eddie Guardado appeared in 55 games for the Rangers in 2008, going 3-3, 3.65 (49.1 IP, 20 ER) with four saves...he was traded back to Minnesota mid-season, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Mark Hamburger.
- ☞ Twins First Base Coach Jeff Smith finished his professional career in the Texas organization with Triple-A Oklahoma and Double-A Frisco, playing at those levels in 2004.

ABOVE AVERAGE JOE: Since July 6, Joe Mauer is hitting .304 (58-for-191) with 10 doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, 14 walks, 25 runs scored and at .350 on-base percentage in 76 games...additionally, he is hitting .412 (28-for-68) with a .500 on-base percentage with runners in scoring position on the season, best in baseball, ahead of J.D. Martinez (.408)...his average with RISP is second highest in club history for a single season, just behind Rod Carew's 1975 mark of .421.

MAY THE FORS BE WITH YOU: Logan Forsythe is hitting .326 (31-for-91) with five doubles, 10 RBI, 12 walks and a .418 on-base percentage in 27 games since being traded to Minnesota from Los Angeles-NL on July 31 (for Brian Dozier)...in that span, he has reached safely in 23 of 27 games.

TWINS WEEKLY MINOR LEAGUE HONORS: The Twins have named Single-A Cedar Rapids infielder **Michael Davis** and Twins left-handed pitcher **Andrew Vasquez** Twins minor league Player of the Week and minor league Pitcher of the Week...in seven games for the Kernels, Davis hit .464 (13-for-28) with one double, one triple, three home runs and 13 RBI...the Bedford, Texas native was drafted by the Twins in the 24th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech...prior to joining the Twins, Vasquez appeared in three games for the Red Wings, pitching 4.1 scoreless innings with three walks and 10 strikeouts...the Rancho Cucamonga, California native was drafted by the Twins in the 32nd round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

IN THE BIGS: Littell has never faced the Rangers and this will be just his third career big league appearance...has made one previous start for the Twins this season against the White Sox, in game two of a double-header...later came out of the bullpen in relief at Milwaukee on July 2...is still in search of his first big league win after suffering the loss in both prior appearances.

IN ROCHESTER: Littell has gone 6-6 with a 3.57 ERA (106.0 IP, 42 ER) in 19 games with Triple-A Rochester this season, including 15 starts...his last appearance came on August 28 where he earned the win in his 15th start of the season for the team...went 6.0 innings and allowed four runs on eight hits, one walk and five strikeouts...since being optioned back to Rochester has gone 5-3 in 10 appearances and seven starts.

2017 RECAP:

- Began season with Single-A Tampa (New York-AL).
- Named Midseason All-Star while at Tampa.
- Promoted to Double-A Trenton June 14 and went 5-0, 2.05 ERA (44.0 IP, 10 ER) in seven starts.
- Acquired by Minnesota along with left-handed pitcher Dietrich Enns on July 30, in exchange for left-handed pitcher Jaime Garcia; assigned to Double-A Chattanooga.

IN THE MINORS: In six minor league seasons (prior to his debut), is 41-28 over 109 games (102 starts) with a 3.28 ERA (589.1 IP, 215 ER) with 147 walks and 536 strikeouts...has made five starts with Double-A Chattanooga and five appearances (4 starts) with Triple-A Rochester, 1-4, 4.06 ERA (51.0 IP, 23 ER) across both levels...with Chattanooga, is 0-3, 5.87 ERA (23.0 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts...with Rochester, 1-1, 2.57 ERA (28.0 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks and 30 strikeouts.

JOURNEY TO THE TWIN CITIES: Littell was drafted in the 11th round (327th overall) of the 2013 draft by Seattle out of Eastern Almadene HS (NC)...spent first three professional seasons in the Mariners organization, going 22-23 over 72 games (71 starts), allowed 158 runs over 381.1 IP combined with AZL Mariners, Rookie Pulaski, Low-A Clinton and High-A Bakersfield...traded to New York after the 2016 season for LHP James Pazos, spent half of 2017 in the Yankees organization with High-A Tampa and Double-A Trenton, earning a Midseason Florida State League All-Star selection with Tampa...traded to Minnesota on July 30th, 2017 with LHP Dietrich Enns for LHP Jaime Garcia, assigned to Double-A Chattanooga...promoted to Triple-A Rochester on May 4 before getting the call-up to the big leagues.

FRESH FACES: Littell is one of 31 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Williams Asutdillo and catcher Mitch Garver), tied for fourth most in the AL with Toronto, for the Twins...with his debut coming earlier this year, he also is one of seven Twins this season to make their big league debut...Stephen Gonsalves 8/20 vs. CWS, Kohl Stewart 8/11 at DET, Williams Astudillo 6/30 at CHC, Jake Cave 5/19 vs. MIL, Fernando Romero 5/2 vs. TOR, and Tyler Kinley 4/7 vs. SEA.
