



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Padres fell 6-0 to the Diamondbacks on Tuesday night, pushing SD's record vs. ARI this season to 5-11 overall and 4-5 @ Chase Field...starter **Joey Lucchesi** was saddled with the loss after working 5.0 innings and allowing just two runs (earned) on three hits...**Austin Hedges** added a double in the game (now has an extra-base hit in four of his last five games), and **Franmil Reyes** extended his hitting streak to a career-high 10 games...their three hits were the fewest in a game since they had two hits on July 22 @ PHI.

**YOU'VE GOT A FRAN IN ME:** **Franmil Reyes** has hit safely in a career-high 10 straight games (.400, 12-for-30) and in 13 of his last 14 games, going 16-for-39 (.410) with one 2b and 6 hr...his 10-game spree ties with STL's Tommy Pham for the longest active streak in the NL and is second-longest in the ML, behind SEA's Mitch Haniger (riding a 17-game hitting streak).

**SEEING RED:** The Padres have a .286 clip vs. the Reds this season (28-for-98), which is the highest average the Friars have posted against any single club...they went 2-1 @ Petco Park this season vs. CIN, scoring 5.33 runs per game.

**SD HURLERS VS. THE REDLEGS:** SD hurlers have a 3.67 ERA against the Reds in 2018, and they have received an average of 5.33 runs of support when playing Cincinnati, the second-highest run support average for SD against any single team this season (behind their 5.52 RSA vs. CHC).

**RISP AND REWARD:** Prior to the All-Star break, the Padres slashed .247/.314/.401 with RISP...in the second half of the season, they've slashed just .215/.282/.337 in such scenarios.

**20 START CLUB:** With his start tonight, **Eric Lauer** will become the 20th rookie in Padres history to reach the 20 start plateau...**Joey Lucchesi** became the 19th rookie to make 20 starts in a single season earlier this year, and it is the first time the Padres have had two rookies make 20-or-more starts since 1977...it's now been done so on five occasions (also: 1969, 1972 and 1974)...the Padres have now had a rookie reach the 20 start mark in three consecutive seasons, with **Dinelson Lamet** making 21 in 2017 and **Luis Perdomo's** 20 in 2016.

**PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME:** The Padres lead the majors in pickoffs (19), and starter **Eric Lauer** leads all players in pickoffs (10), and he's the ninth rookie in ML history to accrue 10-or-more pickoffs in a single season (the first since Greg Smith's 16 for OAK in 2008)...the Reds have been picked off the basepaths 13 times this season, the fifth-most of any club.

**VS. THEIR CASTILLO:** Friars with notable numbers vs. opposing starter **Luis Castillo:** **Eric Hosmer** (1.000, 3-for-3) and **Wil Myers** (.667, 2-for-3 with one HR).

**BUCKLE UP YOUR CHINSTRAPS:** The Padres bullpen has a 3.14 ERA since the break, the best mark in the NL and second-best in the majors (OAK's 2.77 ERA).

**PADRES ON DECK:** Last night, the Padres two affiliates in their respective minor league playoffs (Triple-A El Paso and Double-A San Antonio) each lost their best-of-five series openers...Fresno scored in the top of the 10th to defeat El Paso 8-7 in Game 1 of the Triple-A Pacific Coast League's Pacific Conference playoffs...El Paso stranded 14 runners, including the game-tying run at second in the 10th...CF **Dusty Coleman** homered, 1B **Allen Craig** had a solo homer with two walks, 3B **Ty France** went 2-for-4 and DH **Brett Nicholas** went 2-for-4 with two walks...Corpus Christi defeated San Antonio 7-0 in the opener of the Double-A Texas League Southern Division playoffs.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (5-7, 5.01)**

**LAUER HOUR:** 23-year-old Eric Lauer is set to make his 20th start of the season and second against the Cincinnati Reds...the Elyria, Ohio native earned his second career win in his first career start vs. the Reds on 6/2, tossing 5.0 IP of one-run ball in the Padres 8-2 victory.

**20 START CLUB:** With his start tonight, the southpaw will become the 20th rookie in Padres history to reach the 20 start plateau...Joey Lucchesi became the 19th rookie to make 20 starts in a single season earlier this year...its the first time the Padres have had two rookies make 20-or-more starts since 1977...it's now been done so on five occasions (also: 1969, 1972 and 1974).

- The Padres have now had a rookie reach the 20 start mark in three consecutive seasons, with Dinelson Lamet making 21 in 2017 and Luis Perdomo's 20 in 2016...prior to 2016, the last Padre rookie to make 20 starts was Justin Germano in 2007.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Reinstated from the 10-day DL on 8/30 vs. COL (left forearm strain) after missing the club's previous 25 games...tossed 5.0 IP of hitless ball, allowing one unearned run with two walks and two strikeouts in SD's 3-2, 13-inning victory.

**WHILE YOU WERE AWAY:** Made two scoreless rehab starts while on the 10-day DL...tossed 3.0 IP of three-hit ball on 8/18 for Lake Elsinore (45 pitches, 36 strikes)...tossed 3.1 IP of two-hit ball on 8/24 for El Paso (61 pitches, 34 strikes).

**ERIC'S ARSENAL:** Lauer has relied on five pitches this season: four seamer (60.2%), cutter (19.9%), curve (11.2%), slider (5.1%) and changeup (3.6%).

**JUST BE SUPPORTIVE:** When Lauer receives three-or-more runs of support, he is 4-0 with a 3.18 ERA (12 er, 34.0 ip)...when he gets less than three runs of support, he's 1-7 with a 6.09 ERA (39 er, 57.2 ip).

**AN NL WEST KINDA GUY:** In his eight career starts against the NL West, he is now 3-1 with a 3.09 ERA (15 ER, 43.2 IP).

- Has allowed three earned runs or less in seven of his eight outings against his NL West foes...excluding his ML debut against COL on 4/24...he is 3-0 with a 1.19 ERA against the NL West.
- Lauer was one out shy of becoming the first Padre rookie to throw a complete-game shutout since **Clay Hensley** in 2006 on 7/10 vs. LAD...he tossed a career-high 8.2 IP of four-hit ball, allowing one run with career highs in strikeouts (eight) and pitches thrown (115).

**SAMPLE SIZE:** Allowed three earned runs or less in eight consecutive starts from 6/2-7/10...his 2.33 ERA from 6/2-7/10 was the 10th-lowest mark among all ML starters and sixth-lowest in the NL.

**GET TO THE FIFTH:** Lauer has tossed at least 5.0 IP in 13 of his 19 starts this season.

- When throwing at least 5.0 IP, he owns a 5-2 record, and a 2.33 ERA (19 ER, 73.1 IP), .259 opponent average and 1.35 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 0-5 record, 15.71 ERA (32 ER, 18.1 IP) with a .430 opponent average and a 2.78 WHIP.

**JUNE BLOOM:** After posting a 7.67 ERA from April-May (his first seven starts), he tallied a 2.76 mark in June (his next six outings) for a -4.91 ERA differential.

- His -4.91 ERA differential ranked first among all ML pitchers that tossed at least 25.0 IP from March-May and also at least 25.0 IP in June.

**PICKOFF ARTIST:** Lauer's 10 pickoffs lead the majors, four more than the next closest hurlers (SEA **Marco Gonzales'** and ATL **Julio Teheran's** six).

- Recorded pickoffs in five straight starts from 5/22-6/13, the longest pickoff streak in SD history and tied for the second-longest in ML history with four others...**Andy Pettitte** had the longest streak (eight straight in 1997).
- **Lauer** (10) and fellow rookie **Joey Lucchesi** (three) have combined for 13 pickoffs this year...it's the most pickoffs by a Padre rookie duo in franchise history.
- The Padres 19 pickoffs lead the majors, ahead of the Chicago White Sox' 16.

**CHECK THE SPLITS:** Lauer has walked eight left-handed batters this season and yielded 31 free passes to right-handed hitters...lefties have also accrued just 10 RBI off the southpaw, while righties have combined for 43 RBI.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER — #60 RHP Brett Kennedy (0-2, 7.58) — allday\_bk**

**HE'S A KENNEDY:** 24-year-old RHP **Brett Kennedy** is set to make his sixth-career start and first against the Cincinnati Reds.

- Tossed 6.0-shutout innings of four-hit ball in SD's 7-0 victory over COL his last time out on 8/31, earning his first career win.
- In his four starts, he's relied on three pitches: four seamer (65.8%), slider (25.3%) and changeup (8.9%)
- Was 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA across his 16 starts with El Paso (AAA) this season.

- Has only appeared as a starter for the Padres this season, tossing 5.0 innings-or-more in four of his nine starts...his next relief appearance will be his first since June 10, 2016 at COL.
- Has relied on four pitches: Sinker (45.3%), Slider (25.4%), Four Seamer (17.6%), Split Finger (11.7%).

- Has held opponents scoreless in 19 of his last 21 games, posting a 1.90 ERA, a .171 opponent's average and a 11.03 SO/9.
- Owns a 71.5 first-pitch strike percentage and is limiting opponents to a .226 batting average on the season overall.
- His 2.86 career ERA during the month of September is his lowest during any single month in his career (min. 55.0 IP).
