### BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Have lost 3 consecutive home series (now 2-3-1)...Allowed at least one run in each of their first 5 innings, doing so for the 19<sup>th</sup> time in team history (last: 8/23/13 at HOU)...Allowed a season-high 17 hits...Had their starters ERA reach 5.53 (127 ER/206.2 IP)...Entered tonight with the 27<sup>th</sup> ranked starters ERA at 5.31 (13<sup>th</sup> in AL)...Grounded into a season-high 3 double plays (had 8 3+ GIDP games in 2017).
- J.A. HAPP** allowed a season-high 7 ER and 10 hits over 3.1 innings, his shortest start since 9/4/16 at TB (2.2 IP)...Last allowed 7+ ER on 7/23/17 at CLE (7ER)...Last allowed 10+ hits on 6/13/12 at SF (11H)...Surrendered his 4<sup>th</sup> career grand slam.
- RUSSELL MARTIN** hit his 5<sup>th</sup> home run, a two-run shot in the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning...Was his first HR at home since 4/2 vs. CWS...Has homered 3 times in his last 7 games (2-HR in his first 18 games)...Has now hit 59 HR as a catcher for the Blue Jays, tying Darrin Fletcher for 3<sup>rd</sup> most in team history (Whitt-127, Arencibia-63).
- KEVIN PILLAR** hit his 16<sup>th</sup> double...Came in tonight tied for the MLB lead in doubles with Eduardo Escobar.
- JOSH DONALDSON** went 3-for-4 with a double for his 2<sup>nd</sup> three-hit game of the campaign (also 5/3 (1) at CLE).

### MARINERS NOTES:

- Improved to 8-2-2 in series play this season and 1-0-0 vs. AL East teams...Are now 13-7 on the road...Remain undefeated in road series (now 5-0-2)...Improved to 5-1 in rubber-match games...Improved to 12-0 when scoring 6+ runs...Matched their season high with 17 hits (4/14 vs. OAK)...Homed 4 times in a game for the 4<sup>th</sup> time this year - all wins.
- MIKE LEAKE** matched season highs with 7.0 innings and 101 pitches...Allowed 2 runs on 6 hits with 6 strikeouts and 1 walk...Is now 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA (6 ER/22.0 IP) in his four career starts vs. the Blue Jays.
- KYLE SEAGER** opened the scoring with a grand slam in the 1<sup>st</sup> inning...Was the 4<sup>th</sup> slam of his career (last: June 10, 2015 at CLE - off Bauer)...The 4-RBI blast came with 2 outs...Entered tonight with 12 two-out RBI (T-4<sup>th</sup> in the AL; leader was K. Davis with 17)...Also hit a solo shot in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning for his 7<sup>th</sup> career multi-HR game (last: 7/17/15 at NYY), 5 of which have come in road contests...5 of his 6 home runs this season have come on the road...The 5-RBI game was his 5<sup>th</sup> career effort of 5+ RBI, last doing so on 6/2/16 at SD (5RBI).
- RYON HEALY** hit his 6<sup>th</sup> home run as he led off the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning...All 6-HR have come in his last 11 games...Went 2-for-4 with a walk for his 5<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game, all of which have come in his last 10 contests...Over his last 11 games, is batting .341 (15-for-44) with 2-2B, 6-HR and 12-RBI for a 1.165 OPS.
- MIKE ZUNINO** hit the 3<sup>rd</sup> home run of his last 5 games, a solo shot to lead off the 9<sup>th</sup> inning, giving him 6 for the season...Has hit 5 of his homers on the road.
- JEAN SEGURA** doubled and singled three times in a 4-for-6 effort, his 13<sup>th</sup> career 4+ hit game (last: 7/6/17 vs. OAK)...Marked his 14<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game (was T-7<sup>th</sup> in the AL entering tonight) and his 7<sup>th</sup> 3+H game (was T-3<sup>rd</sup> in the AL entering tonight)...Has back-to-back 3+ hit games for the 8<sup>th</sup> time in his career, last doing so from 9/2-3 last season.
- ANDREW ROMINE** went 3-for-5 on a trio of singles for his 1st multi-hit game of the year and his 12<sup>th</sup> career three-hit effort.
- MITCH HANIGER** recorded another RBI to increase his team lead to 30...His 29-RBI entering tonight ranked T-4<sup>th</sup> in the AL.
