WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won three of their last five games as they continue a seven-game, six-day trip tonight in Minnesota LHP Héctor Santiago, who pitched for the Twins from 2016-17, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox opened the trip yesterday by splitting a doubleheader with the Twins, losing the opener, 4-2, before posting a 6-3 victory in the nightcap.
- Following this four-game series, the White Sox conclude the trip with three games at Boston (6/8-10) before returning home for seven games vs. Cleveland (6/11-14) and Detroit (6/15-17).
- The Sox went 2-1 on their last homestand vs. Milwaukee from 6/1-3 and 1-5 on the last trip to Detroit (1-2) and Cleveland (0-3) from 5/25-30.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- White Sox starting pitchers own a 1.80 ERA (5 ER/25.0 IP) over the last four games.
- The Sox bullpen owns a 2.99 ERA (24 ER/72.1 IP) over the last 22 games.
- The White Sox have lost eight of their last 10 games vs. Minnesota and seven of their last nine at Target Field.
- José Abreu has 33 RBI in 39 career games at Target Field.
- Daniel Palka is hitting .333 (10-30) with three home runs and six RBI over his last nine games.

ROSTER MOVE

- The White Sox have outrighted C Alfredo González to Class AAA Charlotte ... González, 25, was 1-9 with one RBI in three games with the Sox before being optioned to Charlotte on 6/3.
- Chicago's 40-man roster decreases to 39.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- José Abreu's two-run homer off Zack Littell highlighted a four-run first inning and the White Sox went on to record a 6-3 victory over Minnesota to salvage a split of the doubleheader.
- Abreu's homer was the 134th of his career, tying Jim Thome for 13th in Sox history ... Yolmer Sánchez hit a pair of doubles, including a two-run shot in the fourth to give the Sox a 6-2 lead.
- Lucas Giolito earned his fourth victory, allowing two runs on six hits over 6.0 IP ... Joakim Soria recorded the final four outs for his fifth save and first since 4/27 at Kansas City.
- In the opener, Eduardo Escobar capped a four-run, eighth inning rally with a three-run homer off Nate Jones as the Twins defeated the Sox, 4-2.
- Reynaldo López posted a no decision despite holding the Twins scoreless on one hit over 7.0 IP ... López became the first Sox starter to allow one hit over 7.0 IP or more since José Quintana on 5/19/17 at Seattle (1 H/8.0 IP).
- Yoán Moncada hit his third career leadoff homer (all in 2018).

LONG BALL

- José Abreu hit his 134th career home run last night, a two-run shot off Zack Littell, to tie Jim Thome for 13th in White Sox history ... Minnie Miñoso is 12th in Sox history with 135 home runs, José Valentín is 11th with 136 and Ron Kittle is 10th with 140.
- Yoán Moncada hit his third leadoff homer of the season in yesterday's opener, already tied for the 11th-highest, single-season total in franchise history ... Ray Durham holds the Sox record with six in 2001.

SOX DRAFT RECAP

- Through 10 rounds of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, the White Sox selected five pitchers (three LHP and two RHP), two outfielders, one catcher and two infielders.
- The Sox opened the draft on Monday by taking Oregon State INF Nick Madrigal in the first round (fourth overall) and Oklahoma OF Steele Walker in the second round (46th overall).

SOUTHERN STARS

- OF Eloy Jiménez, SS Danny Mendick, RHP Ian Hamilton, and C's Zack Collins and Seby Zavala will represent Class AA Birmingham in the 2018 Southern League All-Star Game.
- Those five will play for the North Division All-Stars on 6/19 at Birmingham's Regions Field.

LAST NIGHT ON THE FARM

- Class AAA Charlotte RHP Carson Fulmer threw 6.0 scoreless IP in a victory vs. Syracuse, allowing two hits ... Class AA Birmingham RHP Spencer Adams allowed one unearned run over 7.0 IP in a no decision vs. Jacksonville.
- OF Luis Robert, the No. 25 overall prospect in baseball per MLB Pipeline, made his season debut with Class A Kannapolis in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Hickory, going 0-4 ... OF Luis González drove in five runs in that game for the Intimidators.

WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- The Twins lead the season series, 5-2, going 2-1 at Target Field (three PPD) and 3-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The Sox are batting .223/.269/.395 (52-233) with a 4.57 ERA (31 ER/61.0 IP) and have been outscored, 35-25.
- Chicago is 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups (2001-17).
- The White Sox trail the all-time series, 427-478 ... they are 231-221 at home (117-102 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 196-257 on the road (37-42 at Target Field).

SOX-TWINS CONNECTIONS

- HOF Jim Thome played for both the White Sox (2006-09) and Twins (2010-11) and hit a game-winning homer in Chicago's 1-0 victory vs. Minnesota in Game 163 of the 2008 season.
- White Sox pitching coach Don Cooper (1981-82) and bullpen catcher Mark Salas (1985-87) both played for the Twins.
- Sox OF Daniel Palka played in the Twins organization in 2017.
- Twins LHP Zach Duke (2015-16), INF Eduardo Escobar (2011-12) and RHP Addison Reed (2011-13) played for the Sox.

REMEMBERING SNOW DAYS

- The final three games of the series between Chicago and Minnesota from 4/13-15 at Target Field were postponed due to rain, snow and blizzard conditions.
- According to Elias, the three straight postponements were the most in the major leagues since Seattle and Cleveland endured four in a row in April 2007.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 8-15 against the American League Central in 2018, going 1-6 at home and 7-9 on the road.
- Chicago has lost 15 of its last 21 games vs. the AL Central, and is 16-30 in its last 46 road games against the division.
- The Sox are 299-392 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

NO REST FOR THE WEARY

- The White Sox are in the beginning of a stretch from 6/5-24 where they play 21 games in 20 days from 6/5-24 ... they also are in the middle of a stretch from 5/25-6/10 where they play 13 of 16 games on the road.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,339 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the second-place New York Mets (1,335) and 44 more than Oakland (1,295), the next-closest American League team.

SEEING STARS

- Class A Kannapolis will send seven players plus manager Justin Jirschele to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.
- RHPs Blake Battenfield, Jake Elliott and Tyler Johnson, OFs Craig Delowal and Luis González and INFs Tate Blackman and Laz Rivera will represent the Intimidators at the All-Star Game on 6/19 in Greensboro, S.C.

30/30 THREAT

- SS Tim Anderson (11 HR/12 SB) is one of three players in the major leagues this season with at least 10 home runs and 10 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts (17/13) and the Angels Mike Trout (19/13).
- Anderson is on pace to record career highs with 31 homers and 34 stolen bases ... the 31 home runs would be the most by a shortstop in Sox history, and the 34 steals would be the most since Ozzie Guillén in 1989 (36).

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the major leagues with 51 stolen bases this season and rank second with an 82.3 (51-62) success rate.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 142 bases this season, which would be six less than their combined total of 148 from 2016-17 ... they have not led the majors in steals since 1966 (153).

TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank fourth in the majors this season with 18 triples ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their highest total since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez is tied for the major-league lead with six triples in 2018, and Daniel Palka is tied for 13th with three.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 13th in the American League and 27th in the majors with a .229 (102-446) average with RISP in 2018.
- The Sox are hitting .179 (19-106) with RISP in their last 15 road games (since 5/1).

SANTIAGO AT A GLANCE

- The 30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 17th appearance (seventh start) of the season, ninth (fourth) on the road and second vs. Minnesota.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.68 ERA (6 ER/14.2 IP), 12 strikeouts and a .250 opponents average (14-56) over three road starts this season.
- Was signed by the White Sox as a free agent on 2/15/18.
- Went 4-8 with a 5.63 ERA (44 ER/70.1 IP) over 15 games (14 starts) with Minnesota in 2017 ... missed the majority of the season due to shoulder and back injuries.
- Has gone 41-48 with a 4.06 ERA (376 ER/832.2 IP) and 724 strikeouts in 205 career games (136 starts) over eight major-league seasons with the White Sox, Angels and Twins.
- Originally was selected by the Sox in the 30th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST START

- Received a no decision on 6/1 vs. Milwaukee, allowing three runs on five hits over 3.1 IP ... struck out one and walked five ... walked at least five batters for the second time this season (walked six on 5/5 vs. Minnesota; 3.1 IP).
- Surrendered a two-run home run to Ryan Braun in the first inning and a sacrifice fly to Hernán Pérez in the third.
- Departed with the game tied, 3-3, in the fourth ... threw 88 pitches (56 strikes) ... the Sox scored three times in the sixth and twice in the seventh on their way to an 8-3 victory.

BITTEN BY THE LONG BALL

- Eight of his last nine runs allowed have come via the home run ... allowed three solo homers on 5/21 vs. Bal., two home runs on 5/26 at Det. (two-run and solo) and one homer on 6/1 vs. Mil. (two-run).
- Has allowed a team-high 11 home runs this season (eight as a starter and three as a reliever).
- His 2.08 home run per 9.0 IP ratio would be the third-highest in baseball with the required IP.

ROCKY ROAD

- Is 1-4 with a 8.17 ERA (23 ER/25.1 IP) and .284 (29-102) opponents average over his last seven road starts ... has tossed less than 5.0 IP in five of those starts.
- Has gone 21-24 with a 3.98 ERA (156 ER/353.0 IP), 292 strikeouts and a .242 opponents average (325-1,344) over 66 career starts on the road.

OUT OF THE PEN

- Threw 1.0 scoreless IP in his last relief appearance on 5/28 at Cleveland ... has thrown at least 2.0 IP in seven of his 10 relief outings this season.
- Surrendered a season-high three runs on three hits over 2.1 IP in his season debut on 4/3 at Toronto ... has allowed one run or less eight times in 2018, including four scoreless efforts.
- Struck out four batters in relief on 4/18 at Oakland, tying a career high (4x, last 4/27/13 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Is 0-0 with a 3.10 ERA (7 ER/20.1 IP) and 19 strikeouts as a reliever in 2018.

2017 REVIEW

- Was limited to just 15 appearances due to shoulder and back injuries in his second season with Minnesota.
- Went 4-1 with a 2.76 ERA (13 ER/42.1 IP) in his first seven starts from 4/5-5/9 ... was 0-7 with a 9.96 mark (31 ER/28.0 IP) in his next eight games (seven starts) from 5/14-7/2.
- Earned the win in his season debut on 4/5 vs. Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits over 5.0 IP.
- Was on the disabled list from 6/7-27 with a left shoulder strain ... was placed on the DL a second time on 7/3 with upper thoracic back pain and missed the remainder of the season.
- Made three appearances for Team Puerto Rico in the World Baseball Classic.

IN THE COMMUNITY

- In 2015, was the Angels nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award ... hosted "Santiago's Soldiers" events at Angel Stadium.
- Made multiple appearances to visit children at the Children's Hospital of Orange County (CHOC) ... participated in the Angels Adopt-A-School program, visiting students at Cambridge Elementary School, as well as making appearances with fans at Fiesta Angels and the Angels 5K and Fun Run.
- In 2013, visited students at St. Rose Elementary School in Newtown, Conn. ... was Chicago's 2013 nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award.
- In 2012-13, sponsored and supported "Santiago's Soldiers," an inner-city youth baseball team in Chicago ... participated in the Sox Celebrity Bowling Classic benefiting pediatric cancer research and visited patients at Lurie Children's Hospital.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE CENTRAL

- Is 1-1 with 6.61 ERA (12 ER/16.1 IP) and .309 opponents average (21-68) over five games (three starts) vs. the American League Central this season.
- Has gone 17-18 with a 4.01 ERA (136 ER/305.0 IP), 256 strikeouts and a .244 opponents average (285-1,169) over 75 outings (51 starts) ... is 16-17 with a 4.35 ERA (131 ER/271.1 IP) and .249 opponents average (262-1,054) as a starter.

VS. MINNESOTA TWINS

- Is scheduled to make 12th career appearance (eighth start) against Minnesota and second this season ... is 3-3 with a 5.73 ERA (24 ER/37.2 IP) lifetime.
- Has gone 5-8 with a 5.83 ERA (60 ER/92.2 IP), 60 strikeouts and a .296 opponents average (112-379) over 19 career appearances (17 starts) at Target Field ... is 1-1 with a 7.13 ERA (14 ER/17.2 IP), 11 strikeouts and a .386 opponents average (32-83) as a member of the road team.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 5/5 vs. Minnesota (8 ER/3.1 IP) ... earned the win in his last start at Target Field vs. the Twins on 9/17/15 (5 ER/0.2 IP) as a member of the Los Angeles Angels.
- Went 7-14 with a 5.61 ERA (82 ER/131.2 IP) and 88 strikeouts over 26 appearances (25 starts) with the Twins from 2016-17.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (1-6, 4.48) is scheduled to make his 14th appearance (13th start) of the season, sixth (fifth) on the road and second against Minnesota.
- Is 0-6 with a 4.35 ERA (34 ER/70.1 IP) over his last 12 appearances (11 starts) ... last won on Opening Day on 3/29 at Kansas City (4 ER/6.0 IP).
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 6/2 vs. Milwaukee, allowing three runs on eight hits over 7.0 IP ... walked one and struck out six ... tossed at least 7.0 IP in his fourth straight start (all quality) ... allowed three home runs as the Brewers won, 5-0 ... received zero runs of support in five starts this season and in three of his last four.
- Is scheduled to make his 26th career start against the Twins ... is 8-9 with a 4.30 ERA (73 ER/152.2 IP) lifetime, 4-6 with a 4.58 ERA (40 ER/78.2 IP) on the road and 4-5 with a 4.16 ERA (29 ER/62.2 IP) at Target Field ... received a no decision in his last start on 5/6 at Guaranteed Rate Field (3 ER/6.2 IP).
