TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets finish a three-game series tonight with the 19th and final meeting between the teams this season...The Braves will travel to Philadelphia following the game to close out the regular season with the Phillies.

A The Braves lead the season set, 13-5, and are one shy of the single-season franchise record for most wins against the Mets...They won 14 games in 1964 and 1966...They won 13 games in 1965, 2005, and 2009.

A Atlanta has won seven of nine games in New York this season, outscoring the Mets, 39-18...The seven wins in New York tie the single-season franchise record; the 2016, 2009, 1968 and 1966 teams also won seven.

A RHP Julio Teheran is set to face the Mets for the fifth time this season and for the 25th time (24th start) in his career...Teheran is 13-11 with a 2.42 ERA (40 ER/148.2 IP) lifetime against the Mets, including 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (5 ER/26.2 IP) this season.

A LHP Jason Vargas is scheduled to face the Braves for the fourth time this season...The lefty is 1-2 with a 6.14 ERA (10 ER/14.2 IP) against the Braves this season, including 0-2 with a 9.31 ERA (10 ER/9.2 IP) here in New York.

90 WINS?: With one victory in their final four games, the Braves would earn their 90th win of the season... They would become the first National League team to reach 90 wins in a season following three or more consecutive 90-loss seasons since the 1991 Braves.

A That 1991 club went 94-68 and reached the World Series after four consecutive 90-loss seasons.

A The Braves went 67-95 in 2015, 68-93 in 2016 and 72-90 last season.

A The Braves are looking for the franchise's 18th 90-win season since Major League Baseball went to a 162-game schedule in 1962.

A The 18 total 90-win seasons since 1962 would be tied for the second most in the National League with St. Louis (87-72 this season) and San Francisco...The Dodgers, 88-71 this year, lead with 23 such seasons.

A The Yankees have the most 90-win seasons in all of baseball with 28.

TEHERAN IN NYC: Tonight will mark RHP Julio Teheran's 13th start at Citi Field, where he is 6-2 with a 2.34 ERA (19 ER/73.0 IP)...He has won four consecutive decisions here, compiling a 1.32 ERA (6 ER/41.0 IP) over the six-game span that dates to June 19, 2016.

A Teheran has allowed one run or fewer in eight of his 12 starts here, and overall, has allowed just four home runs.

.200: RHP Julio Teheran enters tonight's start ranking sixth in the majors with a .199 batting average against, while teammate RHP Mike Foltynewicz is fifth with a .198 mark...The only National League pitchers better than the pair are RHP Max Scherzer (.188) and RHP Jacob deGrom (.196).

A Over the last 110 seasons, only three teams have had two qualified pitchers each finish with an average against below .200.

A The 1968 Cleveland Indians had three (Sam McDowell, Sonny Siebert, and Luis Tiant) while the 2015 Los Angeles Dodgers (Zack Greinke and Clayton Kershaw) and 1986 Houston Astros (Nolan Ryan and Mike Scott) had two.

A The Braves have only had one qualifier ever finish a season with a batting average against lower than .200...Greg Maddux had a .197 mark in 1995 (147-for-748).

VS. THE N.L. EAST: The Braves are 48-24 (.667) against the National League East this season...The club has a +118 run differential against the division this season and have gone 14-3-4 in intradivision series play.

A Only Boston (.704) has a better intradivision record...Intradivision record is the second tie-breaker, after head-to-head record, for determining home-field advantage in two-team tiebreakers... Atlanta tied Chicago in the season series, 3-3.

A The Braves went 33-43 (.434) against their own division last season.

A Since moving to the N.L. East in 1994, the Braves most ever wins against the East was 51 in 2004... Their best record was 35-16 (.686) in 1999...All of Atlanta's remaining games are against their division.

A The club's best ever intradivision record was 55-23 (.705) in 1993, their last in the N.L. West.

A The Braves have not had a winning intradivision record since 2014, when they went 40-36...Over the three previous seasons, the club went 103-124 (.454) against the N.L. East.

ACUÑA JR: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. swiped second base in the first inning, his 16th steal of the season...The last Braves rookie with more stolen bases in a season than Acuña Jr. was Rafael Furcal, who swiped 40 bases in 2000.

A Only four rookies have ever gone 25 and 20 in their rookie season, with the last being Mike Trout in 2012 (30 and 49)...Buck Freeman (25 and 21) also did it in 1899, while Chris Young had 32 and 27 in 2007 and Nomar Garciaparra, 30 and 22 in 1997.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves have the National's League best road record at 46-31 (.597)...The last Braves team to have more than 46 road wins in a season was the 2004 team, who went 47-34 away from Turner Field.

Tonight's Game

A Set to make his 31st start of the season and the 193rd (196th appearance) of his career.

A Made 30 starts for the sixth consecutive season, one of just five pitchers in the majors to do so...Teheran joined Mike Leake, Jon Lester, Max Scherzer and Jose Quintana as the only pitchers with 30 starts in every season since 2013.

A Since 2013, Teheran ranks tied for fourth in the majors with 188 starts, and 11th in innings pitched (1153.1).

A Is 9-6 with a 2.42 ERA (40 ER/148.2 IP) in 24 career games against New York, including 23 starts...Has allowed five runs over 26.2 innings (1.69 ERA) in his four starts against them this season.

A Since his first full season in 2013, Teheran's 2.24 ERA (35 ER/140.2 IP) against the Mets is the third-best mark against the club among qualified starters in the majors...Only Jake Arrieta (2.01) and Max Scherzer (2.20) have lower ERAs against New York in that span.

A Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 19 of his 23 career starts against the Mets, including 18 quality turns.

A Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning at Citi Field, May 3rd of this season...Asdrúbal Cabrera doubled with two outs in the frame to break up the no-hit bid, Teheran's longest since 2013.

A Has allowed opponents to hit just .199 against him this season, yielding 120 hits in 603 at-bats...His .199 opponents' average is sixth lowest in the majors.

A Only one qualified pitcher in franchise history has held opponents to an average under .200...Opponents batted .197 against Greg Maddux in 1995.

A Braves starter Mike Foltynewicz ranks fifth in the majors with a .198 opponents' average...Only three teams in major league history have had multiple qualified starters hold opponents to an average under .200, with the 2015 Dodgers (Clayton Kershaw & Zack Greinke) being the last to do so.

2018 Recap

A Has walked a career-most 82 batters this season, second most in the N.L...Has walked 13 batters over his last three starts.

A Walked two or more batters in 16 consecutive starts earlier this season, the second-longest such streak in the majors this season...Only Tyler Chatwood (18 starts) has walked multiple batters in more consecutive starts.

A The last Braves starter to issue more walks in a single season was Russ Ortiz, who walked 112 batters over 204.2 innings in 2004.

A Fanned Eduardo Escobar in the first inning, 9/8 at ARI, for the 1,000th strikeout of his career...Became the ninth pitcher in franchise history to fan 1,000 in a Braves uniform.

A Of the eight with at least 1,000 strikeouts, only five did so in baseball's modern era: John Smoltz (3,011), Phil Niekro (2,912), Warren Spahn (2,493), Tom Glavine (2,091) and Greg Maddux (1,828)...All five are in the Hall of Fame.

A Allowed six hits and four runs over 5.2 innings, 8/28 vs. TB...Has made seven starts against the American League this season, and is 1-3 with a 5.29 ERA (20 ER/34.0 IP)...He is not slated to face another A.L. opponent in the remainder of the regular season.

A Earned the win, 8/22 at PIT, after allowing two hits and one run over 7.0 innings.

A Walked just one, snapping a streak of 16 straight games with at least two walks...The streak was the longest of its kind in the majors at the time.

A Allowed two hits and one run over 6.0 innings, 8/11 vs. MIL.

A Teheran allowed his only run in the first inning, and has a 7.20 ERA (24 ER/30.0 IP) in the first frame this season.

A Slugged the first home run of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Took Corey Oswalt out to left in the fifth inning, a solo shot.

A Became the first Braves pitcher to homer since Jaime García hit a grand slam on 7/21/17 at LAD.

A Held San Diego hitless over 6.0 innings, 6/17...Was the first hitless start of his career.

A Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher (eight times overall) to not allow a hit in a start of at least 6.0 innings and the first since RHP Aaron Harang went 7.0 innings on 4/18/14 at New York-NL.

A Fanned 11, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to strike out double digits in a no-hit outing...Kent Mercker fanned 10 in his no-hitter on April 8, 1994 at Los Angeles (NL).

A Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/16...Missed nine games with a right thumb contusion after going on the D.L. on 6/5.

A Tossed just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at SD, before leaving with a right thumb contusion...Allowed five hits and four runs, including a season high-tying three home runs.

A Placed on the 10-day disabled list the following day, 6/5...The D.L. stint was the second of his career and his first since 2016.

Career Recap

A Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

- Has struck out 19 batters over 13.1 innings in 13 appearances with Atlanta...Has a 2.19 ERA with four hits, eight walks and three earned runs...Fanned the side on 11 pitches in a perfect ninth inning, 9/20 vs. PHI.
- Recalled, 9/8, from Triple-A Gwinnett and earned his first professional win that night in Arizona...Retired the only batter he faced and stranded two inherited runners in the bottom of the ninth.

- Has allowed five earned runs over 26 games (19.1 IP) since Atlanta acquired him on 7/26...Has a 2.33 ERA with the Braves...All five runs have scored in his last 15 games, spanning 9.2 innings (4.66 ERA).
- In 47 relief appearances this season, is 5-0 with three saves and a 1.64 ERA (6 ER/33.0 IP)...Allowed five runs in 0.1 inning in his only start, 6/6 at WSH.
- Earned the win in back-to-back appearances, 9/1 and 9/2 vs. PIT...Won consecutive games just once previously in his career, 5/1 vs. STL and 5/5 vs. MIL in 2011, also with Atlanta.
- Earned his first save with Atlanta with a scoreless ninth inning on 8/21 at PIT...The save came exactly seven years to the day since he recorded his last save as a Brave in 2011...Has two total saves for Atlanta.
- Atlanta acquired him from the Tampa Bay Rays, 7/26, in exchange for an international signing slot...Rejoined the Braves after spending three seasons in Atlanta, 2010-2012.

- Has one save (9/22 vs. PHI) and one hold (9/20 vs. PHI) since returning from the disabled list...Has allowed three hits and two runs in 5.0 innings since returning.
- Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 9/14, after missing 55 games with right shoulder inflammation...Also missed eight games with the same ailment earlier this season, 6/24-7/3.
- Allowed three hits and two runs, 9/17 vs. STL, to snap a 14.0-inning scoreless streak with Atlanta spanning 14 appearances...Was his second outing since returning from the disabled list.
- Since assuming the primary closer role for Atlanta on 7/30/17, has converted 29-of-32 (91%) save opportunities, including each of his last 10 opportunities.
