### MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners fall to 18-15 against the AL East this season.
- The Mariners are now 16-5 in 2-run games.
- The Mariners bullpen has allowed only 2 runs over its last 12.0 innings dating back to 9/5 vs. BAL... during that span, the bullpen has posted a 1.63 ERA (1 ER, 11 IP) with 14 strikeouts.
- **Mike Zunino** (1x3, R, HR, RBI) hit his 19<sup>th</sup> home run of the season to tie the score at 1-1 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning.
  - Has more extra-base hits than singles this season (32 XBH, 30 1B)... his 32 extra-base hits this season rank T3<sup>rd</sup> among catchers in the American League (most: Salvador Perez, 43).
- **Shawn Armstrong** tossed 2.0 scoreless innings without allowing a hit... has yet to allow a run with the Mariners this season, tallying 6.2 innings of work with 5 strikeouts and only 2 hits allowed.
- **Félix Hernández** tossed 4.0 innings and allowed 2 runs on 6 hits with 2 strikeouts before leaving the game in the top of the 5<sup>th</sup> inning with right hamstring tightness.
- **Dee Gordon** (1x3, RBI) has hit safely in 7 of 9 games vs. the Yankees, batting .324 (12x37) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 triple, and 4 RBI.
  - Tied the game at 2-2 with his RBI single in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning.
- **Mitch Haniger** (1x4, 2B) recorded his 15<sup>th</sup> double since August 1... ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> most in the Majors during that span, trailing only Matt Chapman (16).
  - Is batting .320 (47x147) since August 1 with 22 runs scored, 15 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 16 RBI, and 6 walks.
- **Kyle Seager** (1x4) snapped a 0x10 skid with a leadoff single in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning.

### YANKEES NOTES:

- The Yankees are now 3-2 on this road trip.
- Gleyber Torres has hit safely in 17 of his last 21 games, including 9 multi-hit games. He's batting .321 (27x84) during that span.
- The Yankees are a Major League-best 22-9 (.710) vs. the AL West this season... are 10-5 in 15 road games vs. AL West clubs in 2018 after going 7-10 in 2017.
  - Are 15-2 in 17 games in Seattle since 6/8/13...are 21-5 in their last 26 games at Safeco Field
- The Yankees raised their Major League-leading home run total to 232, their 6<sup>th</sup>-highest single-season total in club history... have homered in 14 consecutive games at Seattle (6/11/14 - c) tied for the second-longest streak by an opponent at Safeco Field, behind Oakland's 23-game streak from 9/13/14-5/16/17.
- **Andrew McCutchen** hit his second home run with the Yankees since being acquired by the club on Aug. 31...he now has 17 home runs on the season (15 w/SF, 2 w/NYY).
  - **McCutchen** is the 3<sup>rd</sup> different Yankee this season with a leadoff HR (also: Gardner and Hicks). The last time the Yankees had at least three batters hit a leadoff home run in a single year was 1995 (Fernandez, Williams, Polonia, Boggs).

## NEW YORK MANAGER AARON BOONE:

### On what he has learned about Lance Lynn as a competitor this season:

"I just like the way he has been able to slow some things down. We saw early in the season some situations kind of speed up on him, and he has done a much better job at that. Then tonight, he finds himself in a little bit of trouble, but what I liked is that he kept making pitches. They had some tough at bats against him, but he kept pounding the strike zone with both his fastball and his breaking balls. He came up with a lot of big pitches in that inning."

### On the blood Dellin Betances had on his hand and pants:

"Unfortunately we're used to seeing it. Sometimes I have to go out there, but Larry (Rothschild) wanted to pay him a visit just to talk to him. When he came back, he said he was bleeding, but that it's a non-issue. It's just something, unfortunately, he has to deal with sometimes. We try and stay on it as best we can."

### On himself being fired up when they got the final out:

"Yeah, I thought it was a well-played game, and just grinding away. Obviously it got a bit tight there in the ninth, and I was just proud of Dellin. I just really thought the quality of his pitches... Even though he got into some trouble, he continued to make quality pitches. No matter the situation, or the pitch before, he was able to keep going."
