FISH BITES

Miami looks to even up this three-game series this afternoon at 1:05 p.m. Left-hander **Wei-Yin Chen** will climb the bump for Miami; he is 1-0 with a 4.38 ERA (12.1 ip/6 er) in two career starts against the Buccos. Pittsburgh will counter with right-hander Ivan Nova, who is 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in three career starts against the Marlins, including a 7-3 victory at Marlins Park on April 15 this season (6.2 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 3 er, 9 so, hr, hb). Miami is coming off a 3-3 homestand against the Blue Jays (1-2) and Phillies (2-1). The Marlins also face the Mets (Sept. 10-13) and Phillies (Sept. 14-16) on this trip. **Programming note:** the Marlins will have four remaining games moved to 610AM WIOD; today vs. Pittsburgh, Sept. 15 vs. Philadelphia, Sept. 22 vs. Cincinnati, and Sept. 29 vs. Mets.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The long ball helped the Marlins overcome a 2-0 deficit last night, but it also cost them in the late innings, as Jordan Luplow broke a 3-3 tie with a game-winning, two-run homer in the seventh in a 5-3 setback for Miami. The Marlins were down 2-0 in the sixth when **Lewis Brinson** belted a three-run homer, his second extra-base hit in a 3x4 outing. Pittsburgh overcame the deficit in a three-run seventh, capped by Luplow's homer. Miami starter **Dan Straily** exited with two outs in the fifth with a left oblique strain (day-to-day), having allowed two runs on four hits (one home run), with four strikeouts.

VS. PITTSBURGH

Miami trails the 2018 series, 1-3, following a three-game series at Marlins Park from April 13-15 and last night's loss in the opener of this series. The Marlins are 36-62 all-time in Pittsburgh, and trail the all-time series, 90-103.

BACK IN FORM

Since returning from the 10-day disabled list (right hip inflammation) on September 1, **Lewis Brinson** has posted a hit in all six games, going 11x22 (.500) with four multi-hit games. He has extended his overall hitting streak, which began on July 2, to eight games, a new career high. He is batting .406 (13x32) with two doubles, a home run, and four RBI during the streak.

ROAD RULES CHALLENGE

Marlins' starter **Wei-Yin Chen** has faced his share of challenges on the road this season, going 1-6 and posting a 9.35 ERA (43.1 ip/45 er) in 10 starts, compared to a 5-3, 1.77 (71.0/14) record in 12 home starts. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that gap of 7.58 is the biggest between home and road ERA by a starting pitcher in the Majors this season (min. 10 GS at home and on the road). Sam Gaviglio (5.93) has the second-greatest gap between home (1.09) and road (7.02). Chen's last road start was on August 18 at Washington, when he did not factor in a 7-5 win despite tossing 5.2 innings and allowing just two runs; he also did not walk a batter in that start, his first road start without issuing a free pass since July 20, 2016 at Philadelphia, a span of 13 starts. Chen's last win on the road came on June 16 this season at Baltimore (6.0 ip, 8 h, 3 r, 3 er, bb, 2 so, hr).

DOWN BY THE RIVER

The Marlins are 5-3 at PNC Park since the start of 2016, winning their first five games of that span before dropping the last three. Miami has batted .285 as a team in that time, with 5.1 runs per game (41 total) and 12 home runs. Since the start of 2016, the only NL venues in which the Marlins average more runs per game are Coors Field (5.8), Busch Stadium (5.5), and Petco Park (5.4). They only venues with a higher team average are AT&T Park (.299), Busch (.294), and Coors (.287). Among non-divisional venues, the 12 home runs are third-most, behind 15 at Miller Park and 13 at Dodger Stadium.

2-FOR-1

Sandy Alcantara made his second start and appearance of the season for Miami on Wednesday, marking his second career Major League starting assignment (appeared in eight games out of the bullpen for St. Louis last year). He improved to 2-0 on the year after tossing 7.0 shutout innings against the Phillies, allowing just three hits and two walks, while striking out a career-high six. In his Marlins debut on June 29 vs. the Mets, he allowed just one run on three hits and five walks over 5.0 innings in an 8-2 win. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is just the seventh pitcher in Marlins' history to allow up to one run over his first two career starts, the third this season. The others were: Andy Larkin (1996-1998); Tommy Phelps (2003); Alex Sanabia (2012); José Fernández (2013); **Jarlin Garcia** (2018); and **Elieser Hernandez** (2018).

CATCH & HIT

J.T. Realmuto hit his 19th and 20th home runs of the season Tuesday night vs. Philadelphia, extending his single-season career high. His 17 home runs as a catcher rank as the second-most by a Marlins backstop in Club history, two behind Charles Johnson's 19 in 1997. His 59 RBI when behind the plate are the fourth-most in a single season in Marlins history, behind Ivan Rodriguez (82 in 2003) and Johnson (69 in 2001 and 63 in 1997). Realmuto leads qualified MLB catchers in runs scored (61) and doubles (26), ranks tied for first in hits (109), is second in slugging (.497), third in average (.282), and tied for third in home runs and RBI (all numbers are as catcher).

HOT CORNER IS ON FIRE

Marlins third basemen have not committed an error over their last 82 games, marking the longest errorless streak at third in Franchise history. Martín Prado has made 25 starts at third in that time, while **Miguel Rojas** has made 24 starts (27 appearances), **Brian Anderson** 19 starts (24 appearances), and **Yadiel Rivera** 14 starts (24 appearances). Miami third basemen lead the Majors in fielding percentage with a .979 mark, committing just seven miscues in 338 total chances.

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (139), at-bats (531), runs (77), average with RISP (.369), and on-base percentage (.355); ranks second in hits (144), doubles (30), walks (56), and multi-hit games (42); ranks third in RBI (58) and average (.271); is tied for third in triples (3); fourth in slugging (.395); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, tied with Harrison Bader for most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton. His five total errors this season are fifth-fewest by a NL rookie (min. 60 GS), and he is the only rookie on that list to spend significant time at two different positions (48 GS at 3B; 89 GS in RF).

- He is on pace for 167 hits this season, which would rank as the fourth-most by a National League rookie since 2007, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, Troy Tulowitzki's 177 in '07, and Matt Duffy's 169 in '15, and would be the 11th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

SEPTEMBER 8

In **2005**, Miguel Cabrera became the youngest player in ML history to record back-to-back seasons of 30 or more home runs. At the age of 22 years, 143 days, Cabrera was 80 days younger than Albert Pujols when Pujols posted his second consecutive 30-homer season in 2002. Also on this date, the Marlins used all 25 players on their roster in their contest against the Dodgers in 1999. Florida was victorious, 5-4, in the 13-inning game.

Wei-Yin Chen is making his 23rd start of the season in the middle game of this three-game visit to PNC Park. Has won four of his last seven starts after taking four losses in previous five starts.

Has allowed a total of 34 hits over 48.1 innings since July 13, the fourth-fewest (min. 45.0 ip) among National League starters, behind Jack Flaherty (30), Dereck Rodriguez (30), and Cole Hamels (33). Is holding opponents to a .198 average against in that span, ranking eighth in the NL.

Has 1.77 ERA (71.0/14) in 12 home starts, compared to 9.35 (43.1/45) in 10 road starts. According to *Stats LLC*, the 7.58 difference in home/road ERA is the largest gap for any pitcher in the Majors since Dallas Keuchel had an 8.15 difference (11.10 on road/2.95 at home) in 2012 (min. 15 GS at home and on road).

His 9.35 ERA is the highest of any Major League pitcher this season (min. 10 GS), while his home ERA of 1.77 ranks as the fourth-lowest of any MLB pitcher (min. 10 GS). Among Marlins starters, his road ERA would rank as the highest single-season ERA in Club history, while his home ERA is currently the sixth-lowest in a single-season in Club history.

Pitched to a 1.54 ERA in four August starts, the lowest monthly ERA (min. 4 GS) of his career. His previous low was a 2.05 ERA in five starts in September 2014. His August ERA ranked 10th among Major League starters (min. 4 GS), behind leader Cole Hamels (0.69).

Tied a career high with 8.0 innings pitched in his last start, September 1 vs. Toronto. Marked longest start since going 8.0 innings on July 12, 2015 vs. Washington. Limited Blue Jays to just three hits and one run while walking none and striking out seven. Marked second start without issuing a walk in his last three assignments, and his walked just two in those three games.

On August 25 vs. Atlanta, limited Braves to six hits, while walking two and striking out a season-high 10, over 6.0 shutout innings. Tossed season-high 109 pitches and including his last start, has reached 100-pitch mark in three of his last four starts. His pitch total in the game was the most since throwing 111 on September 26, 2015 at Boston. Has broken 100-pitch plateau nine times dating back to the start of 2016 (49 starts). Over his first four Major League campaigns, eclipsed 100-pitch mark 54 times in 117 starts.

Opponents are batting .208 (37x178) first time through lineup, .262 (44x168) second time through, and .318 (28x88) third time through.

Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

Jeff Brigham, who had his contract selected by Miami on September 2, will make his second Major League start in the finale of this three-game series against the Pirates. In 17 starts across three levels in the Marlins system prior to his selection, went 10-3 with a 2.36 ERA (95.1 ip/25 er).

Made Major League debut on September 2 against Toronto, surrendering three runs on four hits and four walks, with two strikeouts, over 3.0 innings. Became the 10th Marlins player to make his Major League debut this season, tying the 1996 Marlins for the sixth-most debuts in a single season in Club history.

Began 2018 at Double-A Jacksonville, where he posted a 4-1 record and 1.18 ERA (38.0/5) over seven starts. He walked nine and struck out 41. He missed the entire month of May with a right oblique strain and was activated from the seven-day disabled list on June 22 following a one-start rehab assignment with GCL Marlins.
