TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Rockies face off for the final time at Coors Field this season...the Giants have dropped 17 of their last 19 games here, including a 1-7 record this season.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: Over his last two starts, **LHP Andrew Suárez** has posted a 2-0 record and tossed 14.0-scoreless innings, allowing just five hits and three walks with 10 strikeouts...in his last start at Coors Field on July 4, he allowed one run on five hits in 7.0 innings of work...his only blemish was a solo homer to Chris Iannetta...he'll oppose Rockies' starter Antonio Senzatela, who's 4-0 with a 3.26 ERA in six career games vs. the Giants...in his last start against SF on July 3, he held the Giants to just three hits in 7.0-scoreless innings of work.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: The Giants have been successful in 20 of their last 22 stolen base attempts, including each of their last 16 attempts...the last time the Giants were successful in 16+ consecutive stolen base attempts was in 2012 when they were successful in 16 straight from June 5-18 (*Stats, LLC*).

POWER SURGE: OF Gorkys Hernandez hit his 15th home run of the season last night, tied with **Evan Longoria** for the most on the club...last season, Hernandez hit 0 HR in 348 plate appearances...according to *Elias*, the last MLB player to have 15-or-more HR the season after hitting 0 HR with 300-or-more plate appearances was Phil Bradley, who hit 26 HR in 1985 after hitting 0 HR in 373 PA in 1984.

QUALITY COUNTS: Giants starting pitchers have tossed a quality outing in 12 of their last 15 starts, posting a 2.09 ERA (22er, 94.2ip)...San Francisco has gone 7-8 during that stretch.

ON THE ROAD: SF has dropped eight of their past 10 road games, during that stretch they are hitting .198 and have posted a 4.53 ERA...the Giants' .408 (29-42) winning percentage overall on the road is the fourth-lowest in the league.

CLOSE CALLS: 11 of the Giants' last 15 games have been decided by two-runs or less...SF has played 77 games this season that have been decided by just two runs or fewer, posting a 38-39 overall record in such games.

GIANTS AT COORS: IF Evan Longoria has hit safely in 12 of 14 career games at Coors Field, batting .333 (20-for-60) with four doubles, four triples, five home runs and 17 RBI...**IF Brandon Belt** is a career .319 (58-for-182) hitter at Coors with 15 doubles, 10 home runs and 29 RBI...however, Belt has gone 31 plate appearances without an extra-base hit at Coors Field this season.

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants pitchers have posted a 3.35 ERA, which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors (Dodgers: 3.31 ERA).

JUST SCORE FOUR: San Francisco is 49-17 this season when scoring at least four runs in a game, compared to a 19-55 record when scoring fewer than four.

BLOWN SAVES: The Giants have blown 29 saves this season, which ranks as the most in the Majors.

ON DECK: Following tonight's game, the Giants will travel to Milwaukee and enjoy a day off tomorrow before beginning a three-game series against the Brewers (Friday-Sunday)...SF has won seven of its last 10 games at Miller Park.

This Date in Giants History: September 5, 1998

Giants' outfielder **Barry Bonds** set a new National League mark reaching base in 15 consecutive plate appearances...his five singles, two doubles, two homers and six walks during the streak broke Dodgers' Pedro Guerrero's mark of 14 established in 1983.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
6-9 Record, 4.19 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 25th career Major League start...has gone 6-9 with a 4.19 ERA (62er, 133.1ip) in 24 outings, with the Giants going 11-13 in those games.
- Among NL rookie leaders he ranks first in innings pitched (133.1), fourth in strikeouts (113) and eighth in ERA (4.19).
- His 113 strikeouts are the 14th-most by a rookie pitcher in franchise history...they rank eighth in the San Francisco era.
- Extended his winning streak to two games in the Giants' 7-0 victory over New York-NL on Friday...pitched 7.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and five strikeouts...has thrown 7.0 innings in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.
- Has a 2.28 ERA (15er, 59.1ip) in the 10 one-run games he has pitched in...opponents have two hits in 14 at-bats (.143) off him in close and late situations.
- Has struck out 113 batters while issuing just 34 walks in his first 24 career Major League starts.
- Is holding opponents to a .179 average (7-for-39) with RISP and two outs.
- With one out in an inning opponents are hitting .305 off him with an OBP of .348 and a SLG pct. of .523... however, with two outs in an inning opponents are hitting .219/.280/.384 (Baseball Info Solutions).
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 18 of his 24 starts.
- Has a 5.55 ERA (37er, 60.0ip) in 12 starts on the road compared to a 3.07 ERA (25er, 73.1ip) in 12 starts at home.
- Lefties are hitting .214 (28-for-131) off him with just six extra-base hits (three doubles, two triples, one home run).
- Has faced the Rockies twice in his career, both times at Coors Field...he is 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (4er, 12.0ip) in those starts.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).
