### SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Clayton Richard** tallied a season-high eight strikeouts and 102 pitches in his third quality start of the season...worked a season-high 8.0 innings...his 8.0 IP are the longest a Padres starter has gone in a game this season.
  - His 3.63 ERA (23 ER, 57.0 IP) in 12 games (eight starts) against the Nationals is his lowest ERA against any National League opponent in which he's made at least seven starts against.
- **Travis Jankowski** has hit safely in seven of his last nine games, batting .346 (9-for-26) in that time...extended his hitting streak to four-straight games, tying the second longest streak of his career (Sept. 21-25, 2016)...is now chasing his career-high nine game streak (July 31-Aug.10, 2016).
- **Franchy Cordero** has reached base safely in a career-high 12 consecutive games with eight walks.

### WASHINGTON NOTES

- **Jeremy Hellickson** worked a season-high 6.2 innings in tonight's game, surpassing his previous season-high of 5.2 innings on May 3rd vs. PIT...in 2017, he worked 15 starts of six-or-more innings...tonight's game marks the 12th time in his 202 career starts in which he allowed two or fewer hits...logged a season-high eight strikeouts and earned his first win of the season.
  - Recorded his first hit of the season with an RBI double.
- **Matt Adams** has hit safely in three straight games...went 1-for-3 tonight with a double, an RBI and a run scored.
- **Pedro Severino** recorded his third multi-hit game of the season and his first since April 7th vs. NYM.
- **Howie Kendrick** has hit safely in 12 of his last 16 games, going 19-for-58 (.328) with two home runs, six doubles and four RBI.
