## CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

**ALBERT ALMORA JR.** (3-for-4, HR, R, 2 RBI) hit his second homer of the season, both coming against Atlanta (also, April 14) ... sixth multi-hit game of the season and fourth game with at least three hits.

**KRIS BRYANT** (1-for-5, HR, R, 2 RBI) hit his sixth homer in his last 11 games.

**JOSÉ QUINTANA** allowed a season-high nine hits and a career-high tying three homers ... has a 16.71 ERA (13 ER/7.0 IP) in two starts this season vs. the Braves and a 2.88 ERA (11 ER/34.1 IP) in his other six starts.

**NOTES:** The Cubs finished the homestand with a 5-2 record.

- © Tommy La Stella (1-for-4, R) has hit safely in five-straight games.
- © Kyle Schwarber (1-for-2, 2 BB, R) has scored a run in four-straight games.
- © Pedro Strop (1.0 IP, SO) has not allowed a run in nine-straight outings (9.2 IP).
- © Justin Wilson (1.0 IP, BB) has posted a 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10.0 IP) in his last 11 outings ... snapped a streak of seven-straight outings without a walk, which was his longest streak since 2016.
- © The Cubs bullpen did not allow a hit in 4.1-scoreless innings.

## ATLANTA BRAVES NOTES

**OZZIE ALBIES** (3-for-5, 2B, HR, R, RBI) hit his third leadoff home run of the season, tied with George Springer and Mookie Betts for the most in the baseball ... also led off the game with a homer against José Quintana, April 14 ... marked his fourth-career leadoff homer.

- © According to the Baseball-Reference Play Index, he is the first visiting player to hit two leadoff homers at Wrigley Field in a single season since at least 1974.
- © According to STATS Inc., his 13 homers in the first 40 games of the season ties the all-time record for an MLB second baseman.
- © Tied his season-high with three hits (fourth time).
- © Has gone 8-for-15 with four doubles, two homers, four runs scored and five RBI in three games vs. the Cubs this season.

**NICK MARKAKIS** (2-for-5, 2 R) has hit safely in six-straight games (.407/11-for-27), including five multi-hit games.

**TYLER FLOWERS** (2-for-2, HR, 2 R, 2 RBI, 3 BB) hit his first homer of the season ... has an RBI in three of his last four games ... reached base five times for just the second time in his career (also, August 24, 2016 at Arizona, 3 H, 2 BB).

**JOSE BAUTISTA** (1-for-4, HR, R, 3 RBI, BB) has homered in two of his last three games ... was his first-ever home run at Wrigley Field, the 30th ballpark he has homered in.

**JULIO TEHERAN** has earned the win in three-straight starts for the first time since August 25-September 12 of last season (four-straight starts) ... improved to 3-0 with a 3.12 ERA (9 ER/26.0 IP) in four-career starts at Wrigley Field.

**NOTES:** The Braves have won three-straight and six of their last seven games.

- © The Braves are 10 games over .500 for the first time since July 28, 2014 (58-48).
- © Atlanta improved to 11-2 in day games and 11-1 in their last 13 road games.
- © The Braves have homered in a season-high seven-straight games.
