FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a 10-game, 11-day road swing with the first of three games against the Arizona Diamondbacks tonight at 6:40 p.m.. RHP **Elieser Hernandez**, making just his fourth career start and sixth appearance, is facing Arizona for the first time. The Diamondbacks are countering with RHP Clay Buchholz, who in two previous starts against the Marlins has gone 2-0 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0 ip/6 er). Miami came into their current trip off a three-game homestand against the Nationals (0-3). Prior to that series, Miami completed a six-game road trip, going 1-2 against Atlanta and 2-1 against the Mets. This trip, which started in San Diego (1-3), will also see Miami in Arizona (3G) and St. Louis (3G). The Marlins have gone 15-19 since April 24, after beginning the season 5-17. The Club has won eight of their last 18 road games after starting the year 2-8 away from Miami.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami scattered 10 hits, but tallied only three runs in an 8-3 loss to San Diego. After the Padres opened the game with two first-inning runs, the Marlins responded with two of their own in the top of the second on a two-RBI single by **Wei-Yin Chen**. However, San Diego scored twice in the bottom of the inning to chase Chen, and added three more in the fifth to take a 7-2 lead before **Derek Dietrich** connected for a solo home run to lead off the eighth. Dietrich led the offense, tying a career high with three hits. **Brian Anderson** and **JT Riddle** each had two-hit affairs. Chen suffered the loss, allowing four runs on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 1.2 innings, marking the shortest start of his career.

RULE 5 - NO RETURNS/EXCHANGES

Elieser Hernandez is making his fourth career start tonight. With his first start on May 16 vs. the Dodgers (5.0 ip, 3 h, r, bb, 2 so), he became the first Marlins Major League Rule 5 selection to appear as a starting pitcher in Marlins history. Hernandez is only the fourth Major League Rule 5 selection to appear with the Marlins in the year following his selection. Matt Dunbar made eight appearances, tossing 7.0 innings in 1995, and Matt Mantei made 12 appearances with 13.1 innings pitched, also in '95. Dan Uggla was the most successful to date, appearing in 154 games with 27 home runs and 91 RBI following his selection in 2005 from Arizona.

IN CONTROL

Over his first three career starts, **Elieser Hernandez** has walked just one in 15.0 innings pitched. Since 1995, his 0.60 BB/9.0 IP ratio is the fifth-lowest over a pitchers first three career starts (min. 15.0 IP). He trails Jae Seo, who did not walk a batter over his first three starts. Johnny Cueto ranks second at 0.47, followed by Gerrit Cole (0.49) and Jeremy Hefner (0.57). - *Stats LLC*

WHEN FILLING OUT YOUR BALLOTS

For the month of May, **Brian Anderson** led all qualified Major League rookies in games (28), at-bats (107), hits (33), and runs scored (17), tied for the lead in doubles (7), ranked fourth in average (.308), and fifth in on-base percentage (.351). **Caleb Smith** tied for the Major League rookie lead in wins (3) for the month, ranked second in opponents average (.194), third in ERA (2.60), sixth in strikeouts (28), and seventh in innings pitched (27.2).

RAISING THE BAR

Over the first two months of the season, **Brian Anderson** has recorded 60 hits, leading all Major League rookies. He became just the 10th National League rookie since 1920 to record 60+ hits before June 1, and the first since Darwin Barney for the Cubs in 2011. Coincidentally, Anderson is the third Marlins rookie to appear on the list. Alex Gonzalez recorded 60 in 1999, while Dan Uggla tallied 63 in 2006. **See chart at right for the complete list.**

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 56 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (209), runs (30), hits (60), and on-base percentage (.363); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (17); ranks second in average (.287), walks (20), and doubles (13); is tied for third in RBI (24); and fourth in slugging percentage (.388). Has reached base safely in 34 of his last 38 games since April 20 and 47 of 56 this season.

- Is second among National League players 25-younger in hits behind Ozzie Albies (67).
- Owns three outfield assists in 29 G in RF - his first action at the position in his professional career. Is tied with Cincinnati's Jesse Winker for most assists among MLB rookies.
- His three assists are the most by a Marlins rookie since Marcell Ozuna (8) and Jake Marisnick (5) in 2013.
- Is on pace to record 105 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie. Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 42 first-half RBI, which would be the sixth-most by a Marlins rookie.

BEST IN THE WEST

In 13 games against the National League West this season, the Marlins have gone 7-6 with a 3.49 ERA (113.1 ip/44 er). Since the start of the 2016 season, the Marlins have played exceptionally well against the West. In that span, the Marlins lead all NL teams in average (.271) and winning percentage (.597; 46-31) against the West. Among non-NL West teams, Miami ranks second in wins, third in hits (717), and fourth in runs scored (351). Only the Nationals have more wins against the West (48), while the Nationals (760) and Reds (733) are in front of the Marlins in hits.

HITTING THE ROAD

J.T. Realmuto is a career .316 hitter on the road, and owns a .330 road avg. (211x640) since 2016, fourth-highest in the Majors over the stretch behind only Houston's Jose Altuve (.382; 283x740), Washington's Daniel Murphy (.337; 187x555) and Cincinnati's Joey Votto (.331; 225x679). As a team, the Marlins have posted the Majors best road average since 2014 with a mark of .261; Kansas City ranks second (.259) and Detroit third (.259).

DRAFT INFO

The 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place from June 4-6. Miami will have three selections on the Opening Day of the draft (7:00 p.m., ET, MLB Network & MLB.com), beginning with the 13th overall pick in Round 1. The Marlins will follow in Round 2 with the 53rd overall selection, followed by the first Comp B selection (69th overall) to finish Day 1. Miami holds four picks in the first three rounds of the Draft, tied for the second-most among NL clubs, behind only the Cubs (5). The intervals between selections during round one will last four minutes, followed by one-minute intervals between selections for the remainder of day one. The Draft will resume at 1:00 p.m. (ET) on Tuesday, June 5th, when selections will be made for rounds 3-10, with one minute intervals between selections. Day three of the Draft on Wednesday, June 6th will begin at 12:00 p.m. (ET), featuring picks in rounds 11-40, with no time delay between selections.

➤ Elieser Hernandez is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season (sixth appearance) when the Marlins face the D-backs in the opener of a three-game set in Phoenix tonight.

➤ Made MLB debut on May 10 with a relief appearance against Atlanta in Miami. Tossed 2.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits. Came back for second relief appearance on May 13 against the Braves, tossing 1.0 inning and allowing one run on four hits, with one strikeout.

➤ Has followed that up with three consecutive starts, tossing exactly 5.0 innings in each outing and allowing two-or-fewer runs in each game, for a 2.40 ERA (4 ER). Has struck out eight and walk just one batter (none in last two starts).

➤ Was selected by Marlins from Houston in MLB phase of Rule 5 Draft on December 14, 2017. Had never appeared above Single-A prior to this season.

➤ Opened season on 10-day Disabled List due to a tooth infection suffered during Spring Training. Made four rehab appearances between Single-A Jupiter and Double-A Jacksonville prior to return from rehab and reinstatement on May 10.

➤ First rehab outing was on April 6 at Palm Beach for Jupiter. Suffered broken fingernail on April 9 and did not appear again until April 24, again for Jupiter at Palm Beach.

➤ Combined to go 0-1 with a 4.80 ERA (15.0 ip/8 er) in his four rehab outings, walking eight and striking out 15.

➤ Was selected by Marlins from Houston in MLB phase of Rule 5 Draft on December 14, 2017. Had never appeared above Single-A prior to this season.

➤ In 2017, posted 4-5 record and 3.98 ERA (63.1 ip/28 er) over 15 appearances (11 starts) with Single-A Buies Creek in Astros organization. Missed two months due to a back injury suffered May 19.

➤ Following reinstatement, went 2-2 with 2.67 ERA (33.2/10) in eight appearances (six starts).

➤ In 2016, combined to post 6-8 record and 4.51 ERA (107.2/54) in 24 appearances (19 starts) between Single-A Quad Cities and Single-A Lancaster. Established career highs in appearances, starts, innings pitched and strikeouts (107).

➤ In July 4 win against Beloit that season, tossed career-high 8.0 shutout innings while recording 10 strikeouts. Allowed just one hit and one walk. Would tie the innings-pitched mark in his final start of season, August 4 at Peoria.

➤ Established career high with 14 strikeouts over 6.1 innings on July 22 vs. Dayton.

➤ Caleb Smith is making his 12th start of the season tomorrow when the Marlins play the middle game of this three-game series at Chase Field against the D-backs. It will be his first career appearance against Arizona.

➤ Made first career Opening Day roster after going 0-2 with 5.21 ERA (19.0 ip/11 er) in six Spring outings (two starts). Acquired by Miami this offseason, along with INF Garrett Cooper on November 20, from Yankees.

➤ Among pitchers with at least 11 starts, ranks fourth in National League (10th in MLB) with a strikeout rate of 29.9% (69/231). He trails only Max Scherzer (38.7), Patrick Corbin (33.1), and Jacob deGrom (32.8) in the NL.

➤ Also among pitchers with at least 11 starts, ranks third in the NL (seventh in MLB) in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (6.23). Trails only Scherzer (5.54) and Corbin (6.09) in NL. Only José Fernández (5.79) had a better mark for a rookie in Club history (min. 1.0 IP per team game).

➤ Leads all MLB rookies in strikeouts (69), ahead of Shohei Ohtani (57) and Tyler Mahle (56).

➤ Over last seven starts, has gone 4-3 with a 2.21 ERA (40.2 ip/10 er), striking out 47 (10.40 per 9.0). Opponents are batting just .164 (23x140) against him in that time.

➤ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in nine of his 11 starts this season, and two-or-fewer in six of his last seven, including two games with zero runs allowed (over 7.0 ip on April 29 vs. COL, and over 5.2 ip on May 5 at CIN).
