## HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs are 8-3 in their last 11 games.
- ♦ The D-backs have won 7 straight @ Rockies since June 21, 2017.
- ♦ The D-backs are 6-1 in their last 7 games vs. Rockies, 11-3 in their last 14 games (since July 1, 2017) and 13-4 in their last 17 games (since June 21, 2017).
- ♦ Among NL teams since May 28, the D-backs rank in slugging pct. (1st, .528), OPS (1st, .878), home runs (2nd, 22), runs (2nd, 73), on-base pct. (4th, .350) and walks (T-4th, 43).
- ♦ **Zack Godley**, in 3 career starts vs. Rockies, is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP), .174 opp. average (12-for-69) with 22 strikeouts.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** has a club-record 4 straight games of 3-or-more hits...has a personal best and club-record-tying back-to-back 2-homer games...has hit in 5 straight games at a .667 clip (14-for-21) with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 9 RBI...hit safely in 12 of last 14 games at a .411 clip (23-for-56)/.484 OBP/.929 SLG/1.413 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 7 homers, 16 RBI, 2 HBP, 6 walks.
- ♦ **David Peralta**, in his last 9 games, is hitting .368 (14-for-38)/1.163 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 10 RBI and 2 walks.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte**, in his last 11 games, is batting .324 (11-for-34)/1.155 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI, 2 walks.

## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- ♦ The D-backs had a season-high-tying 12 runs, including a season-high 6 runs in the eighth inning, in a 12-7 win @ Rockies.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** set a club record with his fourth straight game of 3 or more hits, going 3-for-4 with 2 homers and 4 RBI.
- ♦ **David Peralta** went 4-for-5 with a double and 3 RBI.
- ♦ **Nick Ahmed** was 3-for-5 with 2 doubles, a homer and 3 RBI.
- ♦ **Silvino Bracho** earned the win (2-0) with 4 strikeouts in 2.0 perfect frames...**Archie Bradley** and **Fernando Salas** each tossed a scoreless inning.
- ♦ **Matt Koch** allowed 7 runs (5 ER) in 5.0 innings.

## ROSTER MOVES

- ♦ The D-backs placed C **Jeff Mathis** on the Paternity Leave List and recalled INF **Christian Walker** (No. 53) from Triple-A Reno.
- ♦ Walker has appeared in 16 games for the D-backs, 14 as a pinch-hitter, and is batting .125 (2-for-16) with a double, homer, 2 RBI and 3 walks...in 31 games at Reno, is batting .252 (29-for-115) with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 20 RBI and 11 walks.

## 20TH ANNIVERSARY FAST FACT

- ♦ On this day in 1996, a D-backs uniform was worn for the first time on the field...4 days after the club's first draft, the first players in franchise history worked out in a summer minicamp at Peoria Sports Complex.
- However, the first time the uniforms were ever worn in public was November 2, 1995 when the club unveiled them with members of the Phoenix Suns - Danny Manning, Danny Ainge, Wesley Person, Paul Westphal and Kevin Johnson.

## THIS DAY IN HISTORY

- ♦ On this day in 2002, Randy Johnson fanned Bernie Williams to start the eighth inning - at Yankee Stadium - for his 3,535th career strikeout, passing Gerald Perry for seventh all-time.

## GOLDY'S STREAKS

- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** has a club-record 4 straight games of 3-or-more hits and club-record-tying back-to-back 2-homer games.
- ♦ Since 1998, the only player with 5 straight games of 3+ hits is Jose Altuve/HOU (July 4-9, 2017)...per **Elias Sports Bureau**: other notable 5-game streaks included Rod Carew/MIN (May 31-June 5, 1975) and Ted Sizemore/LAD (August 8-12, 1970)...the Major League record is 6 straight by George Brett/KC (May 8-13, 1976) and Jimmy Johnston/BRK (June 25-30, 1923).
- ♦ The Major League record is 3 straight multi-homer games by Jeff DaVanon/ANA (June 1-4, 2003), Lee May/CIN (May 24-28, 1969), Frank Thomas/NYM (August 1-3, 1962) and Guz Zernial/PHA (May 13-16, 1951) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

## GOLDY HEATING UP

- ♦ Among NL players since May 23 (min. 50 PA), **Paul Goldschmidt** is first with a .411 average, .929 slugging pct., 1.413 OPS, 7 homers, 14 extra-base hits, second with a .484 on-base pct. and tied for 11th with a .432 batting average on balls in play.
- ♦ In his last 9 road games, is hitting .500 (18-for-36)/1.700 with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 12 RBI and 4 walks...ranks among NL leaders on the road in slugging pct. (1st, .689), OPS (2nd, 1.081), extra-base hits (2nd, 22) and average (8th, .328).

## VS. ROCKIES

- ♦ Among active players vs. Rockies, **Paul Goldschmidt** ranks in doubles (3rd, 34), extra-base hits (3rd, 60), RBI (4th, 96) and on-base pct. (6th, .426)...his 14 homers at Coors Field are tied with Luis Gonzalez for most by a D-back.
- ♦ **David Peralta** has reached base via hit/walk in 15 of his last 16 games vs. Rockies, hitting .394 (26-for-66) with 7 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 7 walks.
- In last 7 games @ Coors Field, is hitting .469 (15-for-32) with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 3 walks...overall, in 24 career games @ Coors Field, is hitting .368 (32-for-87) with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 6 walks.
- ♦ **Nick Ahmed** has hit in 8 of his last 9 games vs. Rockies at a .433 clip (13-for-30) with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 4 walks.
- ♦ **Chris Owings'** .380 average at Coors Field is second-highest among active players (min. 100 AB), behind Adrian Beltre (.400) and ahead of Buster Posey (.379).

## BACKSTOPS HIGH ON THE LEADER BOARDS

- ♦ D-backs catchers 3.43 ERA is fourth in the Majors behind the Astros (2.88), Cubs (3.15) and Nationals (3.28).
- ♦ Among NL catchers in catchers ERA (min. 165.0 inning), **Jeff Mathis** is fifth (3.17), **Alex Avila** is sixth (3.38) and **John Ryan Murphy** is tied for 12th (3.78).

## DOUBLE THE FIRST NAMES

- ♦ **John Ryan Murphy** has hit safely in 14 of 18 starts, batting .288 (21-for-73) with 4 doubles, 8 homers, 17 RBI and 3 walks.

## EXTRA EXTRA EXTRA EXTRA EXTRA EXTRA EXTRA

- ♦ **Ketel Marte's** last 9 hits have gone for extra bases...starting with May 29, he's had a double, homer, homer, triple, double, triple, double, double, double.
- ♦ Marte's streak is 1 shy of the franchise-record 10 extra-base hits in a row: Chris Iannetta (May 12-June 8, 2017), Paul Goldschmidt (May 7-21, 2014), Luis Gonzalez (April 7-20, 2006) and Steve Finley (September 4-9, 1999) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

## YOSHI + BRACHO DROPPING ZEROES ON OPPONENTS

- ♦ **Yoshihisa Hirano's** 12.2 inning scoreless streak (15 G) since May 6 is the fourth best active streak in the NL behind Jared Hughes (16.1 since May 4), Josh Hader (16.1 since May 5) and Jon Lester (15.0 since May 29)...has a .190 opponent average (8-for-42) and 13 strikeouts (8 H, 5 BB-1 IBB) during his streak.
- ♦ **Silvino Bracho** has a 7-game scoreless, hitless streak with 9 strikeouts (3 BB).

## DESCALSO DISHING IT UP

- ♦ **Daniel Descalso**, in last 9 games, is hitting .321 (9-for-28)/1.123 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.
- ♦ In his last 10 games vs. NL West, is hitting .385 (10-for-26)/1.231 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 9 RBI, 1 hit by pitch and 5 walks.

## MILESTONE WATCH

- ♦ **David Peralta's** 497 career hits are 3 shy of 500.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt's** 996 career games are 4 shy of 1,000.

- ♦ The D-backs split a 4-game set last May 11-14 then took 2 of 3 in Pittsburgh last May 29-31.
- ♦ **David Peralta**, in his last 10 games, is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with 6 doubles, 2 homers, 4 RBI, 1 hit by pitch and 2 walks.
- ♦ **Jon Jay**, in his last 16 games, is hitting .392 (20-for-51) with 1 double, 5 RBI and 5 walks.
- ♦ **Jake Lamb** has hit in 10 straight games vs. Pirates, since May 24, 2016, at a .415 clip (17-for-41) with 4 doubles, 1 triple and 5 RBI.

- ♦ Last time out, got a 3-2 win @ Giants on June 5, allowing 1 run in 6.1 innings (4 H, 2 BB, 7 K).

- ◆ Acquired from the Cubs on Dec. 9, 2014, with RHP Jeferson Mejia, for C Miguel Montero.
- ◆ Cubs 10th-round pick in the 2013 draft.

- ◆ Didn't record his sixth win in 2017 until Aug. 29 vs. Dodgers (13th start).
- ◆ Is 3-0 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER in 23.2 IP), 23 strikeouts and 9 walks in 5 games (3 starts) vs. Rockies.

**LAST START**

- ◆ Took the loss on June 4 @ Giants, allowing 7 runs on 5 hits in 3.1 innings.

**VS. ROCKIES**

- ◆ Is 3-0 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER in 23.2 IP), 23 strikeouts, 9 walks and .207 opponent average in 5 games (3 starts) vs. Rockies.
- ◆ Is 2-0 with a 4.02 ERA (7 ER in 15.2 IP), 16 strikeouts, 9 walks and a .214 opponents average in 4 games (2 starts) @ Coors Field.

- ◆ Is 16-6 with a 2.64 ERA (55 ER in 187.2 IP) when throwing 6.0+ innings (D-backs are 20-9).

**2018 CURVEBALL INFO**

- ◆ Ranks second among Major League starters by throwing a curveball 38.6 pct. of the time, behind only Lance McCullers Jr./HOU (43.3%).

**PLAYER PROFILE**

- ◆ As a senior at University of Tennessee, in 2013, he led the SEC in complete games (6) and innings (108.1) and has second in strikeouts (98).
- ◆ Nickname is the "Bull" because his teammates at Tennessee called him that due to his demeanor on the mound and his sprints on and off the field.
- ◆ Is an avid bass fisherman...has accidently sunk 2 boats.
- ◆ Roomed the majority of the 2017 with Andrew Chafin in his 42-foot RV.
- ◆ Was an alternate on the 2012 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, appearing in 4 games.
- ◆ Married to Autumn.

**2017 CURVEBALL INFO**

- ◆ Finished second in the Majors by throwing 852 curveballs in 2017, behind Rich Hill/LAD (871) and ahead of Gio Gonzalez/WSH (829) and Aaron Nola/PHI (820) [source: Baseball Prospectus].
- ◆ Opponents hit .151 with a .229 slugging pct. on the curve in 2017...threw a career-high 51 curve balls on Aug. 13, 2017 vs. Cubs.
- ◆ Changed how he threw his curveball after conversations with then teammate Jeremy Hellickson in 2015.

**WHO WANTS MORE CURVEBALL INFO?**

- ◆ Ranked third in the NL on "whiff rates" on curveballs in 2017 (45.74)...only Jon Lester/CHC (50.32) and Robbie Ray/ARI (47.27) were better.
- ◆ His average velocity on his curveball (83.44) in 2017 was fourth hardest in the NL, trailing Jimmy Nelson/MIL (84.87), Luis Perdomo/SD (84.80) and Alex Wood/LAD (83.78).

**2017 REVIEW**

- ◆ Set career highs in starts (25), wins (8), innings (155.0) and strikeouts (165) in his third season with the D-backs, going 8-9 with a 3.37 ERA, 53 walks and a .221 opponent average.
- ◆ Among NL starters (min. 20 GS), ranked ninth with a 1.14 WHIP and .657 opponent OPS and 10th with a .221 opponent average.
- ◆ Recorded 4 strikeouts in the first inning on Aug. 13, 2017 vs. Cubs, the second pitcher in team history to record 4 strikeouts in a single inning, joining Oliver Perez on Sept. 20, 2014 @ Rockies.

**POSTSEASON:** Threw 5.0 innings of 2-run baseball with 5 strikeouts out of the bullpen in his lone appearance in NLDS Game 1 @ Dodgers.
