WASHINGTON NATIONALS (45-44) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (41-48)

July 9, 2018 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA --- GAME #90/HOME #46

RHP JEFY RODRIGUEZ (0-0, 5.52 ERA) vs. RHP IVAN NOVA (4-6, 4.48 ERA)

THE PIRATES...snapped their season-high tying five-game losing streak Sunday with a 4-1 win over the Phillies...Have lost five of their last six games after winning four-of-six...Have gone 15-31 in their last 46 games since their record was a season-high nine games over .500 on 5/17 (26-17)...Won a season-high five straight games on two occasions (4/25-29 & 5/6-12)...Were 42-47 after 89 games in 2017 (43-47 after 90).

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Felipe Vázquez has been named to his first All-Star team...Vázquez has made 10 straight scoreless appearances and has been scored upon just once in his last 14 outings (15.0ip/2er)...His selection marks the sixth time in the last eight seasons in which the Pirates closer has been named to the All-Star team; he joins Joel Hanrahan (2011 and 2012), Jason Grilli (2013) and Mark Melancon (2015 and 2016) in that group... Vázquez picked up his 18th save of the season on Sunday, which ranks seventh among the National League leaders and fourth among all southpaws in MLB behind Aroldis Chapman (24), Brad Hand (24) and Sean Doolittle (22).

NATIONAL HEADLINES: Pittsburgh's 11-game homestand continues tonight with the first of three games against the Washington Nationals...The Bucs won two of the three games played against Washington last year at PNC Park from May 16-18...Tonight's game is being televised nationally on ESPN.

SWATTING THE NATS: Corey Dickerson went 5-for-16 with two home runs and five RBI in the four games played in Washington earlier this season and is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with five doubles and three homers in 11 career games against the Nationals...He has reached base safely in all 11 games while hitting safely in 10 of the 11 (eight straight).

NOVA SUPER AT HOME: In his six starts at PNC Park this season, Ivan Nova has produced a 2.77 ERA (39.0ip/12er)...He has been charged with just one earned run in his last two home starts (14.0ip), which includes 8.0 scoreless frames in his last start here on 6/22 vs. Arizona...In 23 career starts at PNC Park with the Pirates, Nova has a 2.62 ERA (147.2ip/43er).

THE MOVE TO 2: In the last four games while batting second in the lineup, Starling Marte has gone 9-for-16 (.563) with a double, a home run, four RBI and four stolen bases while producing four straight multi-hit efforts.

UP THE CRICK: Kyle Crick has made 11 consecutive scoreless appearances (11.0ip), dating back to 6/15...The 11.0 straight scoreless innings is the eighth-longest active streak in the National League...Crick has held opposing hitters to a .200 average in his 35 appearances this season and to a .154 (6-for-39) clip over his last 11 games.

SAVING THE DAY: Felipe Vázquez has converted 18 of his 22 save opportunities this season and has recorded 39 saves in his two seasons as the Pittsburgh closer...His 39 saves are tied with Ramon Hernandez for the most by a left-handed pitcher in club history...The single-season club record for most saves by a LHP was set by Mike Gonzalez in 2006 (24)...Vázquez had a career-high 21 saves with the Bucs last season.

PIRATING: The Bucs have swiped eight bases in their last three games and have been successful 15 times in their last 16 stolen base attempts...Starling Marte is tied for third among the the N.L. leaders with 22 stolen bases.

ON THE SHORT LIST: Jordy Mercer is currently tied with Bones Ely for seventh place in club history with 735 games played at shortstop...Frederick "Bones" Ely played with the Pirates between 1896 and 1901...Gene Alley, who played 11 seasons with the Bucs between 1963-1973, ranks sixth with 977 games played at short.

GOLDEN ARM: Bucco Gold Glove outfielder Starling Marte collected his eighth assist of the season on Saturday...He is tied for the National League lead in assists among all outfielders this season...Dating back to the 2014 season, Marte's 53 assists are tops among all Major League outfielders.

WHAT A CATCH: The Pittsburgh catchers (Francisco Cervelli, Elias Díaz and Jacob Stallings) have combined to produce the best on-base percentage (.375) among all catching units in the Major Leagues this season...In addition, their 57 combined RBI and 15 home runs from the catching position are tops among N.L. teams and are second behind the Yankees (61 & 20) in MLB.

RIGHT ON: Gregory Polanco shares the National League lead among right fielders with 34 extra-base hits...Polanco also ranks fourth among N.L. right fielders in total bases (121) behind Nick Markakis (162), Andrew McCutchen (136) and Bryce Harper (127)...In addition, Polanco's .432 OBP since 6/10 ranks fifth among all National League players.

J-HAY THE MAN: Josh Harrison is hitting .407 (33-for-81) with runners on base this season and .432 (16-for-37) with runners in scoring position...Harrison's .432 average with runners in scoring position ranks second among all Major League players (min: 30 at bats) behind Matt Kemp (.438).

REHABBING PIRATE: Sean Rodríguez, on the D.L. with a right quad strain, has gone 6-for-23 (.261) with a double, a home run and four RBI in six rehab games with Triple-A Indianapolis...He has started games at second base, third base, shortstop and in right field, along with serving as the designated hitter.

FIRING BLANKS: Pittsburgh's pitching staff has posted nine shutouts this season, trailing only the Giants and Cubs (10 apiece) among all Major League teams...The Bucco staff had a total of 12 blankings last season.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

July 9, 2017: The Pirates used a 10-run first inning to cruise past the Cubs in a 14-3 win at Wrigley Field in the final game before the All-Star break. Pittsburgh's first-inning outburst was the club's first 10-run first inning since June 8, 1989 at Philadelphia. Francisco Cervelli highlighted the scoring in the first with his third career grand slam. Cervelli finished the day with a career-high tying five RBI. Chad Kuhl started on just two days rest in place of Jameson Taillon, who was scratched prior to game time with flu-like conditions.

JOE MUSGROVE: The 25-year-old righthander is expected to be reinstated from the D.L. and make his eighth start of the season tomorrow...Has been sidelined since 6/30 with a right index finger infection...Made his last start on 6/29 and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings for the win in front of friends and family in his hometown of San Diego...Has gone 1-3 with a 5.47 ERA (26.1ip/16er) in his last five starts after winning each of his first two; a 2-1 decision (7.0ip/1r) over the Cubs on 5/30 and an 8-1 win over the Cardinals at PNC Park on 5/25 (7.0ip/0r)...Began the season on the D.L. due to a right shoulder muscle strain...Went 1-2 with a 4.58 ERA (17.2ip/9er) in four total rehab starts between 5/1-18...Was one of four players acquired by the Pirates from Houston on 1/13/18.
