HAPPY 28th The Padres look to claim their first series against the D-Backs this season, having lost 3 and tied 2 series for a 5-11 overall record...SD's last series win opposite ARI came on Sept. 18-20, 2017, and they intend to improve their record against their desert foe @ Petco Park, having gone just 1-6 opposite them in San Diego...Padres pitchers have a 6.29 ERA vs. ARI @ Petco Park and a 4.77 ERA against ARI @ Chase Field this season.

LAST TIME OUT In the Friars last game on Wednesday @ SF, **Luis Perdomo** made his 1st start since July 27 vs. ARI, and he worked 3.0 innings of 1-hit ball, allowing no runs with 4 strikeouts and no walks...**Travis Jankowski** collected his 4th 3-hit game of the season and his 1st game this year with multiple XBH (his 1st since Sept. 16, 2016 vs. COL)...he finished a double shy of hitting for the cycle...the win gave the Padres their 2nd series victory of the season vs. the Giants (also April 12-15 when they won 3-of-4 in SD)...it marked the 1st series win for the Friars @ AT&T Park since July 20-23, 2017, when they took 3-of-4 from SF.

GOODBYE YELLOW BRICK ROAD On the road in '18, the Padres finished 35-46 with a .239 average, 81 home runs and 295 RBI...SD pitchers owned a 4.53 ERA in grey with a .251 opponent clip...the Padres tied with KC for the shortest game times on the road on average (2 hours and 56 minutes).

CAN'T HEAR YOU, BETTER GET LAUER Starter **Eric Lauer** is set to make his final appearance of his rookie campaign, looking to improve on his 6-7 record and win consecutive starts for the 2nd time this season (did so once from July 5-10)...in his last time out on Sept. 21 @ LAD, the southpaw tossed 5.0 ip of 1-run ball...in his last four starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL on Aug. 30 vs. COL (originally placed with a left forearm strain), he has posted a 1.42 ERA (3 er, 19.0 ip) while limiting the opposition to a .134 clip.

THE MAN, THE MYTH, THE GALVIS **Freddy Galvis'** .500 clip in his last 8 games since Sept. 18 (16-for-32) leads the majors, and his 7 extra-base hits since then tie with MIL's Christian Yelich for the most in the NL...in that time, he has logged 2 4-hit games and 5 total multi-hit efforts.

SINCE THE BREAK SD's bullpen has a 3.46 ERA since the All-Star break (93 er, 241.2 ip), a mark that leads the NL and ranks 4th in baseball (behind OAK's 3.01, HOU's 3.35 and CLE's 3.43)...their 1.16 WHIP in the 2nd half of the season also ranks 4th in the ML.

DON WELKE ON DECK CLASSIC Last night, the Padres hosted the Texas Rangers organization for the annual prospect game...renamed as the "Don Welke On Deck Classic" (in honor of the late VP of Scouting Operations who recently passed away at the age of 75), the Padres fell 5-3...**Tucupita Marcano** went 2-for-3 and **Esteury Ruiz** homered...today, a group of Padres prospects will participate in various community events throughout the city...the 70+ SD prospects will be divided between volunteer opportunities with Hancock Elementary School, Harborside Elementary School, the Monarch School, Rady Children's Hospital and Feeding San Diego.

THIS DATE IN PADRES HISTORY On Sept. 28, 1996, **Tony Gwynn** hit a 2-out, two-run single off reliever **Mark Guthrie** in the top of the 8th to snap a 2-2 tie and lead the Padres to a 4-2 win @ Dodger Stadium...the win clinched the Padres' 1st trip to the playoffs in 12 year, and Gwynn called it his "biggest hit"...also, on Sept. 28, 2016, RF **Hunter Renfroe** became the 1st hitter to hit a ball onto the roof of the Western Metal Supply Co. building.

#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (6-7, 4.60)

LAUER HOUR: 23-year-old **Eric Lauer** is set to make his 23rd and final start of the season and second against the Diamondbacks tonight...it will be his first career start vs. the Diamondbacks at Petco Park...tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball on 7/5 at ARI in SD's 6-3 victory.

LAST TIME OUT: The southpaw tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball in his last outing on 9/21 @. LAD...in his last four starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL on 8/30 vs. COL (left forearm strain), he has posted a 1.42 ERA (3 ER, 19.0 IP) while limiting the opposition to a .134 clip.

GIVING THE DODGERS THE BLUES: In his 3 career starts vs. LAD, he is 3-0 with a 0.92 ERA (2 ER, 19.2 IP).

- With his 3 straight wins vs. LAD, he's the first Padre rookie to win three straight starts against any single divisional opponent since **Jimmy Jones** vs. Atlanta in 1987 (ATL was in NL West at the time).
- On 7/10 vs. LAD, he was 1 out shy of becoming the 1st SD rookie to throw a complete-game shutout since **Clay Hensley** in 2006 on 7/10 vs. LAD...tossed a career-high 8.2 IP of 4-hit ball, allowing 1 run behind a career-high 155 pitches and a career-high-tying 9 SO.

AN NL WEST KINDA GUY: In his 9 career starts vs. the NL West, he is now 4-1 with a 2.96 ERA (16 er, 48.2 ip).

- Allowed 3 earned runs or fewer in 8 of his 9 outings against NL West foes...excluding his ML debut @ COL on 4/24 when he gave up a career-high 7 runs, he is 4-0 with a 1.97 ERA against the NL West.

20 START CLUB: With his start in his home state on 9/6 @ CIN, the Elyria, Ohio native became the 20th rookie in Padres history to reach the 20 start plateau...teammate **Joey Lucchesi** became the 19th rookie to make 20 starts in a single season earlier this year...it is the 1st time SD has had 2 rookies make 20-or-more starts since 1977...it's now been done so 5 times (also: 1969, 1972 and 1974).

- The Padres have now had a rookie reach the 20 start mark in 3 consecutive seasons, with **Dinelson Lamet** making 21 in 2017 and **Luis Perdomo's** 20 in 2016...prior to 2016, the last Padre rookie to make 20 starts was **Justin Germano** in 2007.

SAMPLE SIZES: Allowed 3 earned runs or fewer in 8 consecutive starts from 6/2-7/10...his 2.33 ERA from 6/2-7/10 was the 10th-lowest mark among all ML starters, sixth-lowest in the NL and 2nd-lowest among all rookies.

- Over his last 15 starts since 6/2, his 3.42 ERA ranks 23rd among all ML starters and 5th among all rookies (min. 75.0 IP).

ERIC'S ARSENAL: Lauer has relied on 5 pitches this season: four seamer (59.1%), cutter (19.2%), curve (11.5%), slider (6.3%) and changeup (3.8%).

JUST BE SUPPORTIVE: When Lauer receives 3-or-more runs of support (7 starts), he is 4-0 with a 2.93 ERA (14 er, 43.0 ip)...when he gets 3 runs of support or less (15 starts), he's 2-7 with a 5.59 ERA (42 er, 67.2 ip).

GET TO THE FIFTH: Lauer has tossed at least 5.0 IP in 15 of his 22 starts this season...when throwing at least 5.0 IP, he owns a 6-2 record, a 2.38 ERA (22 ER, 83.1 IP), .252 opponent average and 1.31 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 0-5 record, 12.90 ERA (32 ER, 22.1 IP) with a .394 opponent average and a 2.51 WHIP.

JUNE BLOOM: After posting a 7.67 ERA from April-May (his first 7 starts), he tallied a 2.76 mark in June (his next six outings) for a -4.91 ERA differential.

- His -4.91 ERA differential ranked first among all ML pitchers that tossed at least 25.0 IP from March-May and also at least 25.0 IP in June.

PICKOFF ARTIST: Lauer's 10 pickoffs lead the majors, three more than the next closest hurler (SEA **Marco Gonzales'** seven).

- **Lauer** (10) and fellow rookie **Joey Lucchesi** (3) have combined for 13 pickoffs this year...it's the most pickoffs by a Padre rookie duo in franchise history.
- The Padres 19 pickoffs are tied with the Chicago White Sox and Chicago Cubs for the ML lead.
- Recorded pickoffs in 5 straight starts from 5/22-6/13, the longest pickoff streak in SD history and tied for the 2nd-longest in ML history with four others...**Andy Pettitte** had the longest streak (eight straight in 1997).

TOMORROW'S STARTER — #63 RHP Jacob Nix (2-4, 6.81) — [juicy_jake33](#)

NIX'N NOD: RHP **Jacob Nix** is set to make his 9th and final start of the 2018 campaign tomorrow against the Arizona Diamondbacks...it will be his 2nd career start against Arizona (0.2 IP, 5 H, 5 ER on 8/16 at Petco).

- On Aug. 28 vs. SEA, he tossed 8.1 IP of 1-run ball on no strikeouts and no walks, tossing just 79 pitches en route to his second career victory.
- In his Major League debut on Aug. 10 vs. PHI, he worked 6.0 innings of four-hit, scoreless ball, accruing four strikeouts on two walks and leading the Padres to their 2-0 victory over the Phillies, becoming the first Padre to toss 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in his debut since **Odrisamer Despaigne** on June 23, 2014 @ SF (7.0 innings).

- Sunday, made his first appearance since Aug. 16 vs. ARI...NL West opponents are hitting just .191 (17-for-89) against him.
- Posted a 1-1 record and a 3.76 ERA in 24 games for El Paso this season.
- His average pitch velocity of 77.4 mph is the second-slowest among major league pitchers (min. 200 pitches).
- This year, he's relied on five pitches: four seamer (65.3%), slider (17.8%), sinker (10.3%), curve (4.2%) and changeup (2.3%).

- Owns a 2.77 ERA (15 ER, 48.2 IP) in 46 career games at home with 52 strikeouts against 18 walks.
- Has allowed runners to score in six of his last nine games since Aug. 18 (9.00 ERA)...had held opponents scoreless in 9 of his previous 12 outings from July 23-Aug. 16 (3.27 ERA).
- This year, has relied on two primary pitches this season: four seamer (62.1%) and slider (37.9%)...leads the Padres with an average spin rate of 2632 RPM (min. 200 pitches thrown).

- Is 1-0 in six games vs. ARI this season with a 2.45 ERA (2 ER, 7.1 IP) while limiting D-backs hitters to a .214 clip.
- Has held opponents scoreless in 25 of his last 30 games, posting a 2.48 ERA, a .179 opponent's average and a 11.30 SO/9.
- His eight wins are the most by a Padres reliever in a single season since Scott Linebrink also tallied eight wins in 2005.
- This season, he's relied on three primary pitches: Sinker (67.8%), Slider (20.9%) and Curve (11%).
