TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Tribe has reached the 90-win mark for the 22nd time in club history...the Indians have also recorded 90+ victories in three consecutive seasons for the third time in franchise history (1999-2001 and 1950-55).

» Cleveland is heading to its fourth Postseason in the past six campaigns...the club's 544-425 (.561) record since the start of 2013 is the best in the A.L. (2nd-best in MLB - LAD, 563-408).

» The Indians have gone 48-27 (.640) vs. the A.L. Central, marking the 3rd-best intradivisional record in MLB (BOS - 51-24, .680; ATL - 49-26, .653)...the club's 2.94 ERA vs. the Central is the lowest by any team against their own division, and the Tribe's 2nd-lowest intradivisional ERA since 1994 (2.73 ERA in 2017).

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY

» The Indians are headed to their fourth Postseason in their past six campaigns, all under the management of Terry Francona.

» Cleveland has posted a record above .500 in each of the past six seasons, marking the club's longest such streak since doing so in eight straight campaigns from 1994-2001...also represents the 2nd-longest active streak in the American League (NYY - 26 straight seasons) and the 5th-longest in MLB.

» The Tribe won its 90th game of the season on Sept. 28...combined with 102 wins in 2017 and 94 wins in 2016, Cleveland has recorded 90+ wins in three consecutive seasons for the third time in franchise history, after also doing so from 1999-2001 and the franchise-long streak of six consecutive seasons from 1950-55.

» Since Francona's tenure began in 2013, the Indians hold the best record in the American League (2nd-best in MLB).

PLAYOFF PRIMER

» The Indians clinched their third consecutive A.L. Central division title on September 15, their earliest clinch date since doing so on September 8, 1999.

» Boston's victory vs. Baltimore on Monday ensured that they will hold home-field advantage throughout the Postseason...since Houston won and Oakland lost on Sept. 25, the Astros have officially clinched the A.L. West and the #2 seed in the A.L. bracket.

» The Indians and Astros, the American League's last two representatives in the World Series, will officially meet in the ALDS for their first-ever Postseason matchup...Games 1 & 2 will be held in Houston on October 5 & 6, while Cleveland will host Game 3 on October 8 and Game 4 (if necessary) on October 9.

ROYAL FAREWELL

» The Indians are in Kansas City this weekend to close out the 2018 regular season with four games against the Royals...Tribe has posted an 11-7 record through the first 18 contests of the season series, outscoring the Royals 99-70 in that span.

» Cleveland has gone 6-3 at home and 5-4 in Kansas City this season...the Indians have a 156-168 (.481) record at Kauffman Stadium since the park opened in 1973...this includes a 28-27 (.509) mark since 2013, and the club's 28 wins in that span are the most by any opponent in this ballpark...overall, Tribe owns a 369-335 (.525) record vs. KC, dating back to 1969.

DOUBLE OR NOTHING

» JOSÉ RAMÍREZ enters today's regular season finale with 34 stolen bases, 39 homers, 39 doubles and 106 RBI on the year...already marks the third batter in franchise history with 30+ homers and 30+ steals in a season.

» If he doubles today, he would become the second player in Indians franchise history with 30+ steals, 40+ doubles and 100+ RBI in a season, after Roberto Alomar in 1999 (3SB, 402B, 120RBI).

» If he homers today, Ramírez would become the first player in franchise history with 30+ SB, 40+ HR and 100+ RBI in a single season, as well as the ninth batter (11th time) in MLB history.

» If he both homers and doubles today, Ramírez would become the fourth batter in MLB history with 30+ SB, 40+ 2B, 40+ HR, 100+ RBI in a season, joining Colorado's Ellis Burks (1996) and Larry Walker (1997), and Houston's Jeff Bagwell (1997).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians dropped last night's game to the Royals, 9-4, falling to 1-2 in this regular season-ending series.

» JOSÉ RAMÍREZ went 3-for-4, recording his 40th multi-hit game of the campaign...also hit a solo shot in the 8th, his 39th longball.

» YONDER ALONSO put the Tribe ahead on an RBI-single in the top of the 3rd and went 1-for-3...MELKY CABRERA followed Alonso with an RBI-single of his own, finishing the night 2-for-4.

» COREY KLUBER did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on seven hits, with two walks and six strikeouts.

COOKIE TO START...

» CARLOS CARRASCO will start this afternoon's regular season finale, taking the ball on regular four days' rest after making his last appearance in relief of Trevor Bauer on September 25 at Chicago-AL...took the loss in the Tribe's 5-4 walk-off loss to the White Sox (4.1IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 4BB, 8K).

» He is due to face the Royals for the first time since April 6 at Progressive Field...earned the win, holding KC to two runs on five hits (1BB, 4K)...owns a career 10-6 record and 3.55 ERA (46ER/116.2IP) in 23 appearances (18 starts) against Kansas City.

» Enters this afternoon's start with 225 strikeouts on the year, one shy of matching his career high of 226, done in 2017...he is averaging 10.8 SO/9 this season, a career-best mark and the 5th-best rate in the American League entering play today.

» Carrasco has enjoyed a strong second half, despite missing time on the Disabled List, posting a 5-5 record and 2.56 ERA (24ER/84.1IP) in 12 starts...owns the 4th-lowest second half ERA in the A.L. (min. 60.0IP), and his 113 second-half strikeouts are the 2nd-most in the A.L., behind Houston's Justin Verlander (118).

...AND BAUER TO FOLLOW

» TREVOR BAUER (12-6, 2.26) is scheduled to follow Carrasco in relief this afternoon, pitching on regular four days' rest after his last start on Sept. 25 at Chicago-AL (4.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 1HR, 4K).

» Bauer has compiled a 2.26 ERA (43ER/171.1IP) in 27 starts this season, a new career best ERA...his ERA is the 3rd-lowest single-season mark by an Indians qualified starter since the mound was lowered to its current height in 1969 (Gaylord Perry - 1.92 ERA in 1972 and Corey Kluber - 2.25 ERA in 2017).

» In seven career outings at Kauffman Stadium, Bauer owns a 3-1 record and 2.06 ERA (9ER/39.1IP)...since 2014, his ERA in this ballpark is the 2nd-lowest by an opposing pitcher (min. 30.0IP), behind Jordan Zimmermann (1.95 ERA).

» Despite missing more than a month on the Disabled List, Bauer enters today's regular season finale among the American League leaders in ERA (2.26, 2nd), strikeouts per 9.0 (11.5, 3rd), opponent batting average (.209, 4th) and road ERA (2.65, 4th).

STURDY STARTERS

» Tribe starters also have recorded 98 quality starts this season, tops in MLB and Cleveland's most in a single campaign since notching 108 in 1968...overall this year, Indians starters rank 2nd in the A.L. and 3rd in MLB with a 3.40 ERA (HOU - 3.17, LAD - 3.24).

» Cleveland starting pitchers rank 2nd in MLB with 1,060 strikeouts (HOU - 1,097), while they have allowed just 242 walks (5th-fewest in MLB)...Tribe starters' 240 walks allowed is the 2nd-lowest total by the Indians starting staff in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-), behind the 1981 rotation (235BB)...the Tribe rotation's 4.38 K/BB ratio currently stands as the highest in MLB history (2018 Dodgers - 4.23, 2011 Phillies - 4.22).

» Indians pitchers have recorded 30 starts with at least 10 strikeouts, 2nd-most in MLB behind Houston (31)...Tribe's 30 starts is tied with the 2002 D-backs for 4th-most in MLB history, behind Houston, the 2001 D-backs (35) and the 1973 Angels (32).

DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 48-27 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 16-5-2 in series play...the Indians' .640 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB behind Boston (BOS - 51-24, .680 vs. A.L. East) and Atlanta (49-26, .653 vs. N.L. East).

» In 75 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.94 ERA (220ER/673.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...Cleveland's 2.94 intradivisional ERA this year is the club's 2nd-lowest since the formation of the A.L. Central in 1994.

MISC. HITTING NOTES

» MELKY CABRERA enters this afternoon on a season-long nine-game hit streak (.379, 11-29), the longest active run on the Indians...he is batting .307 (58-189) in 60 games since rejoining the Indians on July 21...his batting average in that span is the 7th-highest in the A.L. (min. 200PA).

» Since August 26, JASON KIPNIS is batting .304 (28-92) with seven homers and 26 RBI...his RBI total in that span is 2nd-most in the A.L. (T5th-most in MLB), behind OAK's Stephen Piscotty (29).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1956: Hall-of-Famer Bob Feller pitches in the final Major League game of his storied career, going the distance in Cleveland's 8-4 loss to the Detroit Tigers at Cleveland Stadium...Feller allowed eight runs on 14 hits (one home run), in what was just his fourth start of the 1956 season...he remains the Indians all-time franchise leader in wins (266), strikeouts (2581), complete games (279), innings (3827.0), games started (484) and walks (1764).

TODAY'S START

» Today will mark Carrasco's 30th and final start of the 2018 regular season (32nd appearance overall) in this afternoon's finale at Kansas City.
 » The 31-year-old right-hander is pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last appearance in relief on September 25 at Chicago-AL...was handed his 10th loss of the season after allowing three runs on four hits over 4.1 innings of work in the Tribe's 5-4 walk-off loss to the White Sox (4BB/8K).
 » Carrasco will be making his second start and appearance this season against Kansas City...previously faced the Royals on April 6 at Progressive Field, earning the win after allowing two runs on five hits (1BB, 4K) over 6.0 strong innings of work.
 » Carrasco owns a 5-5 record with a 2.56 ERA (24ER/84.1IP) in 12 starts (13 appearances) since the All-Star break...owns the 4th-lowest second-half ERA (min. 70.0IP) in the American League and ranks 2nd with 113 strikeouts since the All-Star break.
 » Enters play today with 225 strikeouts (4th-most in A.L.), one shy of matching his single-season career high (226 in 2017).

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

» Carrasco is pitching on regular four days' rest after making his second relief appearance on the season on September 25 at Chicago-AL...took his 10th loss of the season after working the final 4.1 innings of the Tribe's 5-4 walk-off defeat, allowing three runs on four hits...struck out eight batters, marking the most by a Tribe reliever since **Kazuhiro Tadano** fanned nine in a 6.0-inning outing on June 26, 2004 vs. Colorado.
 » Enters play today with 225 strikeouts (4th-most in A.L.), reaching the 200-strikeouts mark for the third time in his career...Carrasco has gone 8-5 with a 2.63 ERA (28ER/95.2IP) in 14 starts (16 appearances) since returning from the D.L. on July 6.
 » Tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit... held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters.
 » Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee, holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, a total he matched on September 7 at Toronto.
 » Earned his 10th win of the season on July 11 vs. Cincinnati after holding the Reds to one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work...struck out seven batters to reach 1,000 career punchouts, making him the 12th pitcher with 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform and the 44th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000.

STRIKEOUTS RISING

» Despite missing three weeks on the Disabled List, Carrasco enters play today ranked 4th in the American League with 225 strikeouts...since returning from the D.L. on July 6, he has recorded 129 strikeouts, 3rd-most in the MLB over that span behind Houston's Justin Verlander (136) and New York-NL's Jacob deGrom (135).
 » Marks Carrasco's 3rd career season with 200-plus strikeouts, after previously doing so in 2015 and 2017...he is just the fifth player in Indians franchise history to reach the milestone in three-or-more seasons (with McDowell, Feller, Kluber and G. Perry).
 » Sits one strikeout shy of matching his single-season career high (226 in 2017).
 » Carrasco has also surpassed Gary Bell (1,104 K) for 9th place on the Indians all-time franchise leaderboard...he sits 40 shy of matching Mel Harder for 8th place (see chart below).
 » He has struck out at least six batters in each of his last 14 starts, the 2nd-longest streak of his career (21 straight from 6/13/2015 - 4/19/2016)...Carrasco has struck out 10-or-more batters in seven starts this season, tied with Corey Kluber and TB's Blake Snell for the 6th-most such outings in the American League this season.
 » Currently ranks 15th in the American League with 10.69 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...he also is 3rd in the A.L. with a 5.49 K/BB ratio and 6th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.97).

SECOND-HALF STUD

» Carrasco currently sits 5-5 with a 2.56 ERA (24ER/84.1IP) in 12 starts (13 appearances) since the All-Star break, marking the 4th-lowest second-half ERA in the American League (min. 60.0IP) behind TB's Blake Snell (1.17), BOS's David Price (2.25) and Mike Clevinger (1.38)...he has struck out 113 batters (2nd in A.L., 5th in MLB) and allowed just 18 walks in the second half.

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

» Carrasco will be making his second start and appearance of the season against Kansas City, as well as the 19th start (24th appearance) of his career. owns a lifetime record of 10-6 with a 3.55 ERA (46ER/116.2IP) in his previous outings vs. the Royals.
 » Previously faced the Royals in his second start of the season on April 6 at Progressive Field...earned the win after allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings of work (1BB, 4K) in the Tribe's 3-2 victory...his last start at Kauffman Stadium came on June 3, 2017, where he took the loss after allowing five runs on five hits over 4.1 innings (2BB, 3K).
 » Tonight will also mark Carrasco's 14th start (15th appearance) this season against A.L. Central opponents, going 6-5 with a 2.50 ERA (24ER/86.1IP) in those appearances...currently owns the 5th-lowest ERA vs. the division (min. 60.0IP), trailing teammates Mike Clevinger (1.95), Trevor Bauer (2.04) and Corey Kluber (2.43), as well as Minnesota's José Berrios (2.47).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Owns a 7-6 record with a 3.02 ERA (35ER/104.1IP) through his first 16 road outings (15 starts) this season, marking the 6th-lowest road ERA in the American League...Carrasco threw a complete game on May 9 at Milwaukee, striking out 14 batters while allowing two runs on five hits...also fanned 14 on September 7 at Toronto, allowing two runs (one earned) over 8.0 innings of work.
 » In his most recent road start (September 12 at Tampa Bay), Carrasco recorded a quality start in a losing effort, allowing three runs on six hits over 7.0 innings (2BB, 5K).
 » Carrasco owns a 2.66 ERA on the road since the start of 2015, marking the 3rd-lowest ERA in MLB over that span behind Clayton Kershaw (2.47) and Max Scherzer (2.49).

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).
 » Went 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) and 51 strikeouts in six September starts, finishing the season on a career-best six-decision winning streak.
 » Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

TODAY'S OUTING

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his third appearance since being activated from the Disabled List on September 21 in this afternoon's regular season finale, pitching in relief for the first time this year.

» Bauer is scheduled to pitch today on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 25 at Chicago-AL...tossed 4.0 innings in a no-decision, allowing two runs on five hits (one home run), with zero walks allowed and four strikeouts.

» Tossed 1.1 shutout innings in his first start back from the D.L. on September 21 vs. Boston, allowing two hits and striking out one batter (1BB, 34/17).

» He was placed on the D.L. on August 14 (retroactive to August 12) with a right fibula stress fracture, marking his first career stint on the Major League Disabled List...was removed from his start on August 11 at Chicago-AL in the 7th inning after being struck on the right ankle by a line drive.

» Will be making his 10th career relief appearance and first since August 17, 2017, in the second game of a doubleheader at Minnesota...tossed the final 0.2 innings (1H, 1K) of the Tribe's 4-2 loss to the Twins.

» Bauer has posted a 1-1 record and 2.66 ERA (6ER/20.1IP) in three starts against the Royals this season, including a 1-0 record and 1.17 ERA (1ER/7.2IP) in one start at Kauffman Stadium.

» Despite missing more than a month on the Disabled List, Bauer enters today's regular season finale ranked among the American League leaders in ERA (2.26, 2nd), strikeouts per 9.0 (11.5, 3rd), opponent batting average (.209, 4th) and road ERA (2.65, 4th).

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

» Bauer is due to face the Royals for the fourth time this season and has compiled a 1-1 record and 2.66 ERA (6ER/20.1IP) in his three prior appearances, all starts.

» Last faced Kansas City on July 4 at Kauffman Stadium, earning the win after allowing two runs (one earned) on seven hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 7.2 innings.

» Owns a career 3-4 record and 3.17 ERA (27ER/76.2IP) in 13 starts vs. the Royals, including a 3-1 mark and 2.06 ERA (9ER/39.1IP) in seven starts at Kauffman Stadium...his career 2.06 ERA at Kauffman Stadium is his lowest mark in any ballpark (min. 5GS).

» Tonight will mark his 15th appearance of the season against the A.L. Central, compiling a 9-3 record and 2.04 ERA (20ER/94.2IP) in his 14 prior starts...owns the 2nd-lowest ERA vs. the division this season (min. 60.0IP), behind **MIKE CLEVINGER** (1.95 ERA).

AT AN ALL-TIME LOW

» Bauer enters today's game with a career-best 2.26 ERA (43ER/171.1IP), the 3rd-lowest mark among Major League starting pitchers behind New York-NL's **Jacob deGrom** (1.70) and Tampa Bay's **Blake Snell** (1.89).

» Bauer's ERA this season represents the 7th-lowest single-season mark by a qualified Indians pitcher since 1919, as well as the 3rd-lowest ERA by a Tribe hurler since the pitching mound was lowered to its current height in 1969...his 43 earned runs allowed this season are the fewest by a qualified Cleveland pitcher in both of those spans.

ON THE ROAD

» Today will mark Bauer's 15th road outing of the season, compiling a 6-5 record and 2.65 ERA (26ER/88.1IP) in his 14 prior appearances, all starts...enters play today with the 4th-lowest road ERA in the American League (8th-lowest in MLB).

200K MAGIC IN THE AIR

» Bauer has eclipsed the 200-strikeout mark for the first time in his career and enters play today with a career-best 219 punchouts on the year, which ranks as the 7th-most in the American League and 13th-most in MLB...Cleveland is the only team in MLB history with four pitchers each having 200+ strikeouts in a single season.

» In reaching 200 strikeouts in just 156.0 innings, Bauer became the second-fastest pitcher in franchise history to reach the milestone, after **COREY KLUBER** (147.0IP in 2017)...also marked the fifth time an Indians pitcher got to 200 strikeouts in 24-or-fewer starts, joining **Bob Feller** (1946, 22GS), **Sam McDowell** (1968, 23GS & 1970, 24GS) and **KLUBER** (2017, 22GS).

A HALF TO REMEMBER

» Bauer has had a dominant start to the season, etching his name into the Indians record books in the first half...**he posted a 2.24 ERA in the first half, which marks the 5th-lowest first-half ERA by an Indians pitcher since 1969.**

» Bauer averaged 11.55 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP in the first half, which is the 2nd-highest rate by an Indians pitcher in the first half of the campaign (min. 80.0IP), behind **COREY KLUBER** (11.86 in 2017).

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS | 2018 RECAP

» **Bauer has allowed four-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last 52 starts, which the 2nd-longest such streak in the Majors since 1990,** behind Greg Maddux's 106-start run from July 11, 1991-June 22, 1994.

» From May 27 - July 25, Bauer struck out seven-or-more batters in 12 consecutive starts, which tied **Sam McDowell** (12GS, September 14, 1965-May 17, 1966) for the 2nd-longest such run in franchise history, behind **COREY KLUBER's** 14-start streak (June 1-August 13, 2017).

» **Bauer was named to his first career All-Star team this year, representing the Indians on the American League squad on July 17 in Washington, D.C....did not pitch in the A.L.'s 8-6 win over the National League.**

» From June 8 - July 10, Bauer recorded a streak of seven consecutive quality starts with eight-or-more strikeouts and no home runs allowed, which represented the **2nd-longest such streak in the live ball era (1920-),** behind Pedro Martínez's run of eight starts from July 1 - August 10, 2002 (STATS LLC).

» Bauer also struck out eight-or-more batters in nine consecutive starts from May 27-July 10, a career-long run for Bauer and the longest such run by an Indians pitcher since **COREY KLUBER's** 14-start streak from June 1-Aug. 1, 2017.

» Recorded a streak of 10-or-more strikeouts in four consecutive starts from May 27 to June 13...streak the longest such run in MLB this season...**marked just the third pitcher in Indians franchise history to record a streak of four-or-more starts with 10-or-more strikeouts,** joining teammate **COREY KLUBER** (two streaks of five starts in 2017) and Hall-of-Famer **Bob Feller** (one streak of four starts from 1938-39).
