#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox continue this seven-day trip tonight in Toronto ... RHP Reynaldo López takes the mound for the White Sox, who are looking for their first 3-0 start since 1992.
- The Sox are coming off an abbreviated two-game sweep in Kansas City, rallying to win the first two games (see note below) before yesterday's game was postponed due to weather (rescheduled as part of split doubleheader on 4/28).
- Following this three-game series, the White Sox return to Chicago for a six-game, seven-day homestand vs. Detroit (4/5, 4/7-8) and Tampa Bay (4/9-11).
- The Sox play 10 of their first 25 games vs. American League Central opponents, compared to 25 of their first 28 in 2017.

#### TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are 2-0 for the 34th time in franchise history (last 2016) ... they are the last remaining undefeated team in the American League.
- According to Elias, the Sox have won their first two games of a season on multirun comebacks for the third time in club history (also 1919 and 1978).
- The White Sox are 27-16 vs. Toronto since 2012 (14-7 in Toronto) ... they have won six of the last seven games at Rogers Centre, outscoring the Blue Jays, 45-22.
- The Sox bullpen has posted a 0.68 ERA (2 ER/26.2 IP) dating back to the eighth inning on 9/26/17 vs. the Angels.
- Chicago has scored 86 runs over its last 10 games, including spring training (8.6 per game).

#### SATURDAY'S RECAP

- Wellington Castillo hit a two-run double off Brandon Maurer with two outs in the eighth inning as the White Sox rallied to defeat Kansas City for the second straight game, 4-3.
- Trailing, 3-1, entering the eighth, Yoán Moncada hit a solo homer off Maurer to close the gap to 3-2, Avisail García followed with an infield single and Matt Davidson drew a one-out walk to set up Castillo's game-winner.
- Danny Farquhar (win), Nate Jones (hold) and Joakim Soria (save in Sox debut) each threw 1.0 scoreless IP in relief ... Jones (elbow surgery) was making his first appearance since 4/28/17.
- Lucas Giolito (3 ER/6.0 IP) posted his seventh quality start in nine outings since joining the White Sox.

#### HOME OPENER INFO

- The White Sox open the home portion of their schedule on Thursday vs. Detroit at 3:10 p.m. CT (NBC Sports Chicago) ... RHP James Shields is the scheduled starter.
- Parking lots open at noon and gates to the ballpark open at 1:10 p.m. ... fans are encouraged to be in their seats no later than 2:15 p.m. for the opening ceremony.
- Protective netting has been extended at Guaranteed Rate Field from the backstop to the outfield end of both dugouts ... the state-of-the-art netting extends across 21 sections (Sections 122-142) and matches the existing backstop's 30-foot height.

#### WHO'S HOT?

- Avisail García is hitting .389/.442/.550 (70-180) over his last 48 games dating back to 8/10/17.
- Jose Abreu is batting .356/.396/.690 (31-87) with six home runs and 20 RBI over his last 22 games (since 9/9/17).
- Tim Anderson owns a .345 average (39-113) with five homers, 14 RBI and 23 runs scored over his last 27 games (since 9/3/17).

#### SOUTHPAW SUCCESS

- The White Sox lead the majors with a .282 (419-1,486) average vs. left-handed pitchers since the start of the 2017 season.
- Avisail García led the majors with a .424 (56-132) average vs. lefties in 2017, while José Abreu ranked eighth with a .356 (53-149) mark.
- García's .424 average was the highest by a Sox player since at least 1974, and he became the first Sox player to lead the majors in that department since at least 1974 (STATS).

#### OPENING DAY FIREWORKS

- The White Sox tied the major-league record with six home runs on Opening Day (1988 Mets) ... some other notables:
  - ◆ The four-run comeback matched the Sox largest ever on Opening Day (fifth time, last 1971 at Oakland).
  - ◆ Matt Davidson (three) and Tim Anderson (two) joined Alejandro De Aza (2014), Jim Thome (2008), Sammy Sosa (1991) and Minnie Miñoso (1960) as only Sox players to hit two-plus home runs on Opening Day.
  - ◆ Chicago hit three home runs in one inning (fourth) on Opening Day for the first time in franchise history ... the previous club record for home runs in a single game on Opening Day was three in 2008 at Cleveland.
  - ◆ The Sox hit back-to-back homers (José Abreu and Davidson) on Opening Day for the first time in franchise history.

#### WHITE SOX VS. TORONTO

- The White Sox are 5-0-1 in the last six season series against the Blue Jays, going 27-16 during that span (14-7 in Toronto).
- Chicago's six-season unbeaten streak against the Blue Jays is the longest in club history.
- The teams split the 2017 series, with each winning two of three on the road ... the Sox batted .277/.319/.451 (59-213) with a 5.43 ERA (32 ER/53.0 IP) and were outscored, 32-31.
- Chicago's six-game winning streak at Rogers Centre ended in the last game on 6/18/17.
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 190-203 ... they are 101-93 in Chicago (61-50 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 89-110 in Toronto (56-70 at Rogers Centre).

#### LOOKING FOR AN EDGE VS. THE EAST

- The White Sox are 179-219 vs. the American League East since 2007, with their only winning record during that span coming in 2016 (19-14).
- The Sox went 13-20 vs. the A.L. East last season, including a 4-12 record on the road.

#### AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

#### ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The White Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (three left-handers), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... the average age is 27.7, including 28.8 for pitchers and 26.4 for position players.
- RHP James Shields (36) is the oldest player, and 2B Yoán Moncada (22) is the youngest ... RHP Nate Jones (2012-) is the longest tenured, followed by OF Avisail García (2013-).

#### DAVIDSON'S DAY

- Matt Davidson became the fourth player in MLB history to hit three home runs on Opening Day, joining Toronto's George Bell (1988), the Cubs' Tuffy Rhodes (1994) and Detroit's Dmitri Young (2005) ... he set career highs with five RBI and four runs scored.
- Davidson also became the 14th Sox player (15th time) to homer three times in one game and first since Dan Johnson on 10/3/12 at Cleveland ... Pat Seerey (7/18/48 at Philadelphia) owns the club record of four.
- According to Elias, Davidson is the first White Sox DH to record a three-homer game ... the Sox had been the last American League team in existence for the entirety of the DH rule without a three-homer game from a DH.

#### ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

#### CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman, Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

#### ON THE FARM

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.
