OF Ronald Acuña Jr. drove a 3-2 pitch out to left field last night to lead the Braves to a 1-0 win over Tampa Bay.

Acuña Jr. (20 years, 141 days) became the youngest player to homer in a 1-0 game since Phil Cavarretta (19 years, 68 days) on September 25, 1935.

He also became just the third rookie in Atlanta franchise history to homer in a 1-0 game, joining Brooks Conrad (August 12, 2010 vs. Los Angeles-NL) and Ryan Langerhans (April 18, 2005 at Houston).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Tampa Bay finish a two-game set tonight with the second game of the Braves' third road trip of the season...This is the first meeting between the clubs since 2015 when the Braves dropped three of four games to the Rays...The teams will meet again in Atlanta, August 28-29.

*A* The Braves improved to 12-6 at Tropicana Field.

*A* RHP Julio Teheran is set to make his first career start against Tampa Bay...The right-hander is 5-9 with a 5.37 ERA (63 ER/105.2 IP) in 18 career games against the American League...Tonight's start will snap a string of 11 consecutive starts against the N.L. East...Is last start outside of the division also came in interleague play, a 5-4 win vs. Texas on September 6, 2017.

*A* LHP Ryan Yarbrough has never faced the Braves...He dropped a 10-4 decision on April 15 vs. Philadelphia, his only other start and interleague appearance.

**SCORELESS:** The Braves ran their road scoreless streak to 27.0 innings with their third consecutive shutout away from SunTrust Park...The club beat the Mets, 7-0 and 11-0 on May 2 and May 3 before last night's 1-0 win over Tampa Bay.

*A* The three consecutive road shutouts are the longest such streak in Atlanta franchise history and the longest by a Braves team since the 1948 Boston club also had a three-game run.

*A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the 27.0-inning road scoreless streak is the second longest such run in the franchise's modern era (since 1900)...The 1992 team compiled a 30-inning run in July of that season.

*A* The last major league team to fashion three consecutive road shutouts was the 2016 Los Angeles Dodgers (April 4-April 6).

**ON THE ROAD:** The Braves won their sixth consecutive road game last night, and have outscored the opposition 36-4 over this stretch...Their six-game road winning streak is the club's longest single-season road run since 2013, when they also won six from August 2-August 7.

*A* They last won seven straight road games in a single season in 2009, when they took 10 consecutive away from Turner, September 10-September 27.

*A* The Braves have gone 12-7 away from SunTrust Park this season, while compiling the fifth-best road ERA in the majors at 3.20 (61 ER/162.2 IP)... Only Colorado (23) and Pittsburgh (21) have played more road games in the N.L. than the Braves

*A* The Braves have not finished with a winning road record since 2012, when they went 46-35 away from Turner Field.

**INTERLEAGUE:** The Braves finish their first interleague series of the season tonight...They went 9-11 against the American League last season and have not finished with a winning record in interleague play since 2013, when they went 11-9...Atlanta's .375 (30-50) interleague winning percentage over the previous four seasons was the third worst in baseball.

*A* Braves designated hitters have hit 16 home runs in interleague play, tied for the second fewest among N.L. teams...They hit none last season.

**SHUTOUTS:** The Braves tossed their fifth shutout of the season last night, tied for the second most in the majors and one off the lead of the Pittsburgh Pirates...The Braves had six shutouts all of last season.

**VS. LEFTY STARTERS:** The Braves are set to face another left-handed starter tonight, LHP Ryan Yarbrough, after facing LHP Ty Blach, LHP Andrew Suárez and LHP Blake Snell the last three games...Prior to this stretch the Braves had faced four left-handed starters all season...The Marlins are set to throw LHP Caleb Smith tomorrow.

*A* The Braves are hitting .283 against all lefties, the only team in the majors with a mark above .270... Tampa Bay is third at .268...Atlanta also has the sixth-best on-base percentage (.341) and the second-best slugging percentage (.467).

*A* 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .459 (17-for-37) against all left-handers, the second-best mark in baseball among qualifiers...His .946 slugging percentage is third behind New York's Giancarlo Stanton (1.133) and San Diego's Christian Villanueva (1.114)...Albies has fanned just four times against lefties this season.

**SWEEP:** A win tonight would give the Braves their second sweep of the season and their first over Tampa Bay since June 7-9, 1999 (three games)...Their last sweep in St. Petersburg came on June 30-July 2, 1998, another three-game set.

**THE OFFENSE:** The Braves offense leads all of baseball in batting average (.270) and on-base percentage (.338), while its 329 hits are seven off the lead...The club leads the N.L. in runs (182), doubles (77), slugging percentage (.441) and extra-base hits (123).

*A* The Braves have struck out 268 times, the fewest times in the N.L.

**DOUBLE PLAYS:** The Braves turned three more double plays last night, and have 37 on the season, second most in the N.L. ....Only San Francisco has more with 42.

**OZZIE IN THE FIRST:** 2B Ozzie Albies singled on the first pitch of the game last night and is now hitting .500 (17-for-34) in the first inning this season.

*A* His 17 hits, 12 runs, and nine extra-base hits in the first are all the most in the majors, while his five homers are tied for the lead.

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Set to make his eighth start of the season and the 170th (173rd appearance) of his career.
- A* Tonight's turn snaps a streak of 11 consecutive starts within the N.L. East...It's Teheran's first start outside of his division since 9/6/17, when he started versus Texas at SunTrust Park.
- A* According to STATS, LLC, Teheran was the first Braves pitcher to make 11 consecutive starts against his own division since RH Phil Niekro also made 11 straight in 1979-80.
- A* Set to make the 19th Interleague start of his career...Is 5-9 with a 5.37 ERA (63 ER/105.2 IP) in his career against the American League, including a 2-1 record and a 7.40 ERA (17 ER/20.2 IP) in four starts last year.
- A* Has never faced Tampa Bay, one of just three major league teams that he has yet to pitch against...He also never faced Cleveland or Houston.
- A* Is 2-1 with a 1.86 ERA (6 ER/29.0 IP) over his last five starts dating to 4/9 at WSH, allowing opponents to bat just .178 (18-for-101)...Pitched to a 10.13 ERA and opponents hit .313 in his first two starts of the season.
- A* Ranks sixth in the majors (third in the N.L.) in ERA since 4/9.
- A* Has a 12.86 ERA (10 ER/7.0 IP) in the first inning of his seven starts...Following the first frame, has logged a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30 IP) over the remainder of his outings.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Held the Mets to two hits and two walks over 7.0 scoreless innings in his last start, 5/3 at Citi Field...Fanned six.
- A* Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning before Asdrúbal Cabrera doubled with two outs...Was his longest no-hit bid since holding Pittsburgh without a hit for 7.2 innings on 6/5/13.
- A* Since his first full season in 2013, Teheran's 2.11 ERA (30 ER/128.0 IP) against the Mets is the second-best mark against the club among qualified starters in the majors...Only Max Scherzer (1.92) has a lower ERA against New York in that span.
- A* Allowed two hits and three runs over 3.0 innings, 4/27 at PHI...Left the game after 3.0 innings with right upper trap tightness.
- A* Threw just 43 pitches, the fewest he has thrown in a start in his career.
- A* Turned in 7.0 scoreless innings, 4/21 vs. NYM...Allowed just four hits and one walk while striking out six...Was his 11th straight start of at least 6.0 innings against the Mets.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/16 vs. PHI...Tossed 6.0 innings and allowed just five hits and one run, striking out a season-best nine.
- A* Snapped a six-start winless stretch with the victory, which dated to 9/17/17... Went 0-3 with a 5.18 ERA (19 ER/33.0 IP) during his winless stretch.
- A* Made his second consecutive start against Washington, 4/9...Took the loss despite holding the Nationals to five hits and two runs in 6.0 innings of work...Struck out seven.
- A* In eight career instances in which he has faced the same opponent in back-to-back starts, is 5-0 with a 2.52 ERA (14 ER/50.0 IP) and 31 hits allowed in the first meeting and 2-3 with a 3.61 ERA (19 ER/47.1 IP) and 52 hits allowed in the second.
- A* Went 2.1 innings and allowed six hits and five runs, 4/3 vs. WSH...Surrendered three home runs, which accounted for four of the five runs he allowed.
- A* Entered the game with a 19.0-inning scoreless streak against the Nationals before allowing three runs in the first...The 19.0-inning stretch was tied for the longest active scoreless streak by a starter against any one opponent in the majors...Research courtesy of STATS, INC.
- A* Made his fifth consecutive Opening Day start, which set the Atlanta era (since 1966) record for a pitcher...Only two other Atlanta pitchers (Greg Maddux from 1993-96 and Rick Mahler 1985-88) went four straight...Only Phil Niekro (8), Maddux (7) and Mahler (5) made at least five Opening Day starts in total for Atlanta.
- A* The last Braves pitcher to make more than four consecutive Opening Day starts was Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn, who started six straight Milwaukee openers from 1957-1962.
- A* Allowed four runs over 5.2 innings in a no-decision against Philadelphia, and is 1-1 with a 2.73 ERA (9 ER/29.2 IP) in five Opening Day starts.

#### 2017 Recap

- A* Made a team-high 32 starts to become the first Braves pitcher to make 30 starts in five consecutive seasons since Greg Maddux went eight straight from 1996-2003.
- A* Finished with 188.1 innings pitched and has tossed 185.0 innings in every season since 2013...Is one of four starters in the majors to accomplish that feat... Washington's Max Scherzer, San Francisco's Jeff Samardzija and Chicago's Jose Quintana are the other three.

#### Career Recap

- A* Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

**Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 7/5 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/3

- Right-handed batters have just two hits, both singles, in 22 at-bats (.091) against him...Lefties are hitting .455/.538/.909 with five hits, two walks, two doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/17, for his first appearance on an active roster.

**Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Converted his sixth hold of the season, 5/8 at TB...Six holds pace the club and are second most in the majors among rookie pitchers...No rookie has paced the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding right-handed batters to a .143 (6-for-42) average...Lefties are hitting .273 (9-for-33).
- Returned to action 5/5 vs. SF and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Threw two pitches and left with numbness in his right index finger and thumb in his last outing, 5/1 at NYM.
- Holding batters to a .171 (6-for-35) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-25, .120) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .257 (9-for-35) with no one on base.
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH...Tossed 3.1 scoreless innings, while also stranding the bases loaded after entering the game in the third.
- Took the loss in his Braves debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed one run over 2.0 innings...The loss was his first major league decision.

**Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 18/13 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 18/3

- Has not allowed a hit to a left-handed batter this season (0-for-17).
- Allowed just two hits and two walks over his last four appearances, totaling 4.2 scoreless innings...Prior to his current run, allowed two hits, eight walks and eight runs (six earned) over four games (2.1 IP) from 4/14-23.
- Ranks tied for 14th in the majors with 18 appearances this season...Has pitched in 53% of Atlanta's games...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited an N.L.-most (tied) 18 runners, and has stranded 15 (83%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

**Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 0/0 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/8, for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA), combining to go 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts...Went 4.1 innings in his last start, 5/2 at Charlotte, and allowed eight hits and six runs.
- Made five starts with Atlanta last season, going 1-3 with a 4.91 ERA...Spent time at three different levels of the Braves farm system before making his major league debut last September...Became the first Braves starter since 2004 to begin the year in Single-A and make his MLB debut later that season.
- Ranked by Baseball America as Atlanta's No. 2 prospect, and by MLB.com as the Braves' No. 4 farmhand.
