**RAIN DELAY:** The game was delayed 22 minutes, starting at 8:16 before resuming play at 8:38 with a runner at second and two outs in the top of the fourth.

**THE LOSS:** The Royals have lost five straight after winning seven of 12 following the ASB, dropping to 34-78 to match Baltimore for the worst record in the Majors.

- + Hosted the Cubs for the first time since 2011 and dropped to 9-13 all-time, including 5-5 at Kauffman Stadium, and are 3-7 in Interleague play this season.
- + Fell to 15-38 at Kauffman Stadium this season—matching their loss total from all of 2017—and are on pace for 58 home losses, seven more than the 1998 club.
- + Dropped to 13-23 vs. left-handed starting pitchers, including losses vs. the last nine since their last win on June 27 at Milwaukee (**Brent Suter**).

**JAKOB JUNIS:** He's 1-1 with a 4.19 ERA (9 ER in 19.1 IP) in his last four starts on the heels of a five-start skid in which he went 0-5, 9.33 ERA (28 ER in 27.0 IP).

- + Stranded a two-out single in the first and erased a one-out single in the second on a 9-6 putout...following a 1-2-3 third, he yielded a triple and a walk to leadoff the fourth, the first of which scored on a wild pitch...struck out **Javy Baez** and **Kyle Schwarber** before rain delayed the game at 8:16 with a runner at second and two out...resumed play after a 22-minute delay and struck out **Willson Contreras** to strikeout the side for the sixth time this season...allowed three straight to reach with one out in the fifth, but induced a force out at home and an inning-ending groundout to escape the threat and exited after 5.0 innings, tied 1-1...pitch count by inning: 16 (1st), 15 (2nd), 9 (3rd), 21 (4th), 26 (5th), 87 total...held the Cubs to 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position.
- + Struck out eight batters, one shy of his career high, including four straight to the last three batters in the fourth and the first batter in the fifth.

**ROSELL HERRERA:** Singled and scored the Royals' only run in the second, his 37th hit in 36 games since joining the Royals on June 17, third most on the team.

- + Threw out **Willson Contreras** at second base in the second inning, his first career outfield assist and the 290th by Kansas City since 2010, breaking a tie with Minnesota for most in the Majors during that time...he's the eighth different Royal to record an outfield assist this season, joining: **Alex Gordon** (8), **Abraham Almonte** (2), **Jorge Bonifacio** (2), **Jon Jay** (2), **Jorge Soler** (2), **Paulo Orlando** (1) and **Brett Phillips** (1).

**ALCIDES ESCOBAR:** Put Kansas City on the board with an RBI single in the second inning, his first RBI since July 13 at the White Sox and his first run-scoring hit with a runner in scoring position since July 9 in Minnesota...he's batting .333 (5-for-15) in his last four games on the heels of a 3-for-29 skid in his previous 10 games.

**CUBS:** Earned their first series-opening win since July 19 vs. St. Louis (0-4 in between), improving to NL-best 65-47 (.580), 1.5 games ahead of Milwaukee (65-50).

- + Are 10-9 since the All-Star break in 2018, but 159-82 (.660) since 2015, the best post-break record in the Majors during that time, ahead of Cleveland (146-91).
- + Improved to 9-4 vs. the American League this season and 36-17 (.679) since 2016, the second-best Interleague record in the Majors behind Boston (38-12).
- + Won without a hit with runners in scoring position (0-for-7) for the fifth time this season, and are batting .138 (11-for-80) in scoring situations in their last 13 games since July 24) on the heels of a 30-for-90 (.333) stretch with RISP in their previous eight.

**COLE HAMELS:** He's 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER in 11.0 IP) in two starts with the Cubs after going 5-9, 4.72 ERA (60 ER in 114.1 IP) in 20 starts with Texas.

- + He's 6-2 with a 2.58 ERA (19 ER in 66.1 IP), .226 opponents' average (56-for-248) and 72 strikeouts (9.8 K/9) in 12 road starts, in which his teams are 7-5.
- + **Alcides Escobar's** RBI single in the second was the first *earned* run he's allowed at Kauffman Stadium, snapping a streak of 21.0 innings without an earned run allowed here...his 0.35 ERA (1 ER in 26.0 IP) is tops in the 46-year history of this ballpark (min. 25.0 IP), ahead of **Rafael Betancourt's** 0.59 (2 ER in 30.2 IP).
- + Escaped a two-on, one out- jam in the first with an inning-ending 6-4-3 double play, but a leadoff single in the second later scored on a two-out RBI single by Escobar...following a 1-2-3 third, he stranded a leadoff single in the fourth and left the bases loaded in the fifth...stranded a one-out single in the sixth before exiting after 6.0 innings, leading 2-1...pitch count by inning: 18 (1st), 19 (2nd), 9 (3rd), 13 (4th), 23 (5th), 15 (6th), 97 total.

**PEDRO STROP:** Extended his career high in saves to eight, including six saves in his last seven appearances since **Brandon Morrow** went on the 10-day DL.

**JAVIER BÁEZ:** Hit a go-ahead solo HR on the first pitch of the sixth off **Kevin McCarthy**...it was his 25th HR of the season, extending his career high...he's homered in consecutive games for the 11th time in his career and fifth time this season and has six HR in his last 10 games, batting .400/.442/1.025 (16-for-40) with 14 RBI.

- + Also had had an RBI double in the eighth, his 88th RBI of the season, second most in the Majors behind only **J.D. Martinez** (93), whose Red Sox were off today.
- + He's one of three Cubs (4th time) to record at least 30 doubles, five triples, 25 HR and 15 stolen bases in a season, joining: **Ryne Sandberg** (1985 & '92) and **Alfonso Soriano** (2007).

**BEN ZOBRIST:** Tripled and scored Chicago's first run in the fourth and singled to leadoff the eighth and is batting .457/.500/.739 (21-for-46) in his last 14 games.

- + Returned to Kauffman Stadium for the first time since Game 2 of the 2015 World Series with Kansas City...he's batting .331/.415/.519 (60-for-181) with 21 extra-base hits and 19 RBI in 48 career regular season games in this ballpark, including .337/.455/.522 (31-for-92) as a Royal in 2015.
