TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians will send five players to the All-Star Game for a second consecutive year, their first time doing so since 1998 & 1999 (six in each of those seasons).
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has been voted the American League starter at third base...**Al Rosen** was the last Tribe third baseman to start consecutive All-Star Games, doing so in 1953 & 1954.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **COREY KLUBER** were both named to their third consecutive All-Star roster...Lindor is the second shortstop in club history to make three straight All-Star rosters (**Lou Boudreau**, 1940-44), while Kluber is the first Tribe starting pitcher to earn three consecutive nods since **Sam McDowell** (1968-1971).

BATTLE OF OHIO

» The Indians and Reds are set to begin their six-game season series as the clubs square off for the Ohio Cup...following this three-game set at Progressive Field, the Tribe will travel to Great American Ball Park from August 13-15.
» The two teams were evenly matched in the 2017 season series, as both teams went 2-2 and scored 18 runs each...since Interleague play began in 1997, Cleveland and Cincinnati have played each other in every year except 2002, with the Tribe owning an 8-5-7 record in season series play.
» In 103 all-time matchups, the Indians hold a 56-47 record (.544) against their intrastate rivals.

EVERYBODY IS A STAR

» Major League Baseball yesterday announced rosters for the 2018 All-Star Game, with five members of the Indians earning spots...Cleveland also had five All-Stars in 2017, marking their first time doing so in consecutive seasons since 1998 & 1999 (six in both years).
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** won fan voting for a second straight season and will be the American League starter at third base...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **COREY KLUBER** were each named to their third consecutive All-Star roster, while **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** earned his third career nod (also 2014 & 2017)...**TREVOR BAUER** garnered his first career All-Star selection.

ALL-STAR ACES

» **COREY KLUBER** (3rd career ASG) and **TREVOR BAUER** (1st career ASG) have become just the third pair of Indians starting pitchers in the divisional era (1969-) to be named to the All-Star Game...they join pairs from 2016 (**Kluber** and **DANNY SALAZAR**) and 2004 (**CC Sabathia** and **Jake Westbrook**).
» Kluber earned his third straight nod, becoming the first Tribe pitcher to make three straight All-Star rosters since **Doug Jones** (1988-1990) and the first Indians starting pitching since **Sam McDowell** was named to four straight teams (1968-1971)...Kluber was the winning pitcher for the American League in 2016.

MR. BRANTLEY GOES TO WASHINGTON

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** is headed to the All-Star Game for the third time in his career (also 2014 & 2017)...he is the Tribe's first three-time All-Star outfielder since **Grady Sizemore** represented the Tribe every season from 2006-2008.
» Brantley has held a batting average above .300 every day since April 17, and currently ranks 8th in the A.L. with his .306 season average (96-314)...his 19-game hit streak from May 9-30 remains the longest in MLB this season.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians dropped the rubber match of their weekend series vs. Oakland, falling 6-0 in yesterday afternoon's series finale.
» Cleveland was held to just five hits, led by a 2-for-3 performance from **EDWIN ENCARNACION**...**BRANDON GUYER** (1-1) doubled and **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (1-4) had a single, but the Tribe was shut out for just the third time this season (also April 7 vs. KC and June 25 at STL).
» **SHANE BIEBER** suffered his first career MLB loss, allowing four runs on eight hits over 6.0 innings of work...walked one batter and struck out seven, bringing his career total to 36 strikeouts...marks the 3rd-most strikeouts through six career appearances in franchise history, trailing only **Herb Score** (57) and **DANNY SALAZAR** (36).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1948: Hall of Famer **Satchel Paige** becomes the oldest rookie in MLB's modern era, making his Major League debut two days after his 42nd birthday vs. St. Louis-AL...Paige worked 2.0 scoreless innings of relief in the Tribe's 5-3 loss to the Browns, fanning Whitey Platt for his first strikeout...Paige finished his rookie campaign 6-1 with a 2.48 ERA and worked one scoreless appearance in Cleveland's World Series victory over Boston-NL.
