TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Red Sox continue a three-game set tonight with the fifth meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves dropped two of three in Boston earlier this season, May 25-27.

Since the beginning of the 2006 season, the Braves have lost 13 of 16 against the Red Sox in Atlanta, including each of the last four after dropping yesterday's series opener, 8-2...They club has not beaten the Red Sox in consecutive games here since June 14 and 15, 2002.

LHP Sean Newcomb went 3.0 innings and took a no-decision in his only career appearance against Boston, May 26 of this season...The native of Brockton, Mass., allowed three runs, earned, six hits and four walks in the eventual 8-6 loss.

RHP Rick Porcello has gone 6.1 innings in all three of his career appearances against the Braves...The righty beat the Braves at Turner Field in his last start against Atlanta, striking out six and allowing four hits in a 1-0 win on April 25, 2016.

INTERLEAGUE: This series marks the Braves final interleague matchup of the season...They are 8-10 against the American League so far this season...They have not finished with a winning interleague record since 2013, when they went 11-9.

Since winning consecutive series against Los Angeles and Oakland at Turner Field in 2014, the Braves have won one interleague set in Atlanta...They beat Detroit in two of three games to close out 2016.

From the start of interleague play in 1997 through the 2003 season, the Braves went 71-47 (.602) against the American League...That record was the best in the National League and trailed only Oakland (75-47) for the best in the majors.

Since 2004, the Braves have gone 115-144 (.444) in interleague play, the fourth-worst record in baseball...Only San Diego (.390), Cincinnati (.410) and Philadelphia (.423) have been worse over that time frame.

RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION: The Braves went 1-for-12 with runners in scoring position yesterday, while leaving 13 runners on base...Despite the struggles, the Braves have a slash line of .276/.359/.464 with runners in scoring position and lead the National League in all three categories in these situations.

Over the last 14 games, dating to August 20 at Pittsburgh, the Braves have gone 20-for-107 (.187) with runners in scoring position...They are 8-6 over this stretch.

They have a .210 batting average in balls in play in these situations over this stretch...For the season, the Braves have a .304 batting average on all balls in play.

UNEARNED RUNS: The Braves made at least one error in six straight games (seven total), after making just one error total over their previous 11 games.

Over these last six games, dating to August 29 vs. Tampa Bay the Braves have allowed nine unearned runs.

From the beginning of the season through August 28, the Braves allowed 36 total unearned runs, ninth fewest in all of baseball.

STOPPER: LHP Sean Newcomb is set to make his 16th start this season following a Braves loss...The lefty is 8-2 with a 2.84 ERA (28 ER/88.2 IP) in his previous 15 starts following an Atlanta loss.

Newcomb has 11 wins this season, and the last Braves lefty to have more in a single season was Mike Minor, who had 13 in 2013.

EXTRA DAY OF REST: LHP Sean Newcomb is set start tonight with five days of rest; he last pitched on August 29 against Tampa Bay.

When he starts on normal rest, Newcomb is 3-3 with a 5.61 ERA (27 ER/43.1 IP) in eight games, all starts...When he has more than four days of rest, Newcomb is 8-4 with a 3.10 ERA (35 ER/101.2 IP).

For the season, Braves starters are 15-13 (.536) with a 3.61 ERA (95 ER/236.2 IP) in 41 games on normal rest...With more than four days in between starts, the Braves rotation is 38-25 (.603) with a 3.47 ERA (202 ER/524.1 IP) this season.

ROOKIES OF THIS YEAR: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. is tied for the major league lead among rookies with 23 home runs...New York's Miguel Andujar also has 23 home runs, and has played 127 games...Acuña Jr. has played 86 games.

Among rookies with at least 300 at-bats, Acuña Jr. leads with a .568 slugging percentage, while his OPS (.925) is second.

Acuña Jr.'s 23 home runs are tied for the eighth-most in a season by any player prior to his 21st birthday...Acuña Jr. is tied with Micky Mantle, who also had 23 in 1952.

Tony Conigliaro is seventh on the list with 24 in 1964...The leader is Mel Ott, who had 42 in 1929.

WINKLER: RHP Dan Winkler has tossed 13.0 consecutive scoreless innings, dating to the seventh inning on August 3.

The righty's streak is tied for the third longest active streak in the National League and 4.2 innings behind a run by Pittsburgh's Trevor Williams

Winkler has fanned 14 and allowed eight hits during his streak, which spans 14 games.

Tonight's Game

- A Makes his 27th start of the season and the 46th of his career.
- A Last started on 8/29 vs. TB, and pitches tonight on five days' rest...Makes his 15th start of the season with an extra day of rest, and is 7-3 with a 2.73 ERA (25 ER/82.1 IP) in those turns...Holding opponents to a .188 average with an extra day.
 - A In eight games on four days' rest, is 3-3 with a 5.61 ERA (27 ER/43.1 IP) while opponents have hit .284.
- A Faces Boston for the second time in his career and his first time at SunTrust Park... Is a native of Brockton, Mass. and resides in Randolph...Attended Middleboro High School in Middleboro, Mass.
 - A Started against them earlier this season, 5/26 at Fenway Park, and allowed six hits and three runs over 3.0 innings...Walked four.
 - A His 3.0 innings at the time were a season low, before completing just 2.2 frames on 7/3 at NYY.
 - A Makes his sixth interleague start of the season, and is 1-2 with a 5.96 ERA (15 ER/22.2 IP) over his first five turns...Atlanta is 1-4 as a team.
- A Fell one out shy of a no-hitter, 7/29 vs. LAD, to lower his ERA at SunTrust Park to 2.86 in nine starts...In three starts since, is 0-2 with a 12.15 ERA (18 ER/13.1 IP).
 - A Has allowed 29 hits and seven walks over his last three home starts, as opponents are batting .420 (29-for-69) and reaching base at a .474 clip.
 - A Is the first Atlanta pitcher with three straight starts of at least eight hits and five runs at home since Terry Mulholland did so in 2000.

2018 Recap

- A His 11 wins lead the Atlanta staff...Became the first left-hander to win 11 games for Atlanta since Mike Minor won 13 in 2013.
 - A The Braves logged just 33 wins by left-handed starters from 2014-2017, tied for fifth fewest in the National League.
- A Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 8/23 at MIA, to defeat the Marlins 5-0.
 - A Went 4-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24.0 IP) in his four starts against Miami this season...Became the third Atlanta starter in franchise history to beat the Marlins four times in a single season, joining Tom Glavine and Greg Maddux, who both did so in 2002.
- A Fell one strike shy of a no-hitter, 7/29 vs. LAD...Chris Taylor hit a two-strike single to left with two outs in the ninth for the Dodgers first hit.
 - A Newcomb's performance was the longest a Braves pitcher took a no-hit attempt since Shelby Miller also went 8.2 no-hit innings on 5/17/15 at Miami...Miller allowed a first-pitch single to Justin Bour.
 - A Miller and Newcomb are the only two pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to lose a no-hitter with two outs in the ninth inning, according to research from the Elias Sports Bureau.
- A Held Miami to four hits and one run, 7/23 at Marlins Park...Stopped a season-worst three-game losing streak, and stopped a five-game skid by Atlanta in his starts.
 - A Went 7-1 with a 2.49 ERA over his first 12 starts of the season...Went 1-4 with a 5.45 ERA in his next seven turns.
- A Made 19 starts before the All-Star break in his first full major league season, going 8-5 with a 3.51 ERA and 97 strikeouts.
 - A Eight wins before the break were most on the Atlanta staff, and the most for a Braves pitcher since 2014 (Julio Teheran and Aaron Harang).
- A Set career lows in innings pitched (2.2) and pitches (70), 7/3 at NYY...Allowed a season high-tying five earned runs.
 - A Yielded just three hits, two of which were home runs...Has allowed nine home runs over his last eight starts after allowing just three homers in his first 12 turns.
- A Beat the Padres 1-0, 6/16 at SunTrust Park...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits and seven strikeouts.
 - A Is 3-0 with 18 scoreless innings against the Padres...Has thrown 6.0 scoreless frames in each of his three career starts.
- A Finished the month of May 5-0 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) and no home runs allowed...Atlanta went 5-1 in his six starts.
 - A His five wins in the month were most in the majors, while his 1.54 ERA ranked sixth best in the N.L...His batting average against of .158 was the lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.
- A Faced Miami for the second consecutive turn, 5/19, and allowed four hits and one run over 6.0 innings...A run-scoring groundout in the second inning snapped his career-long scoreless streak at 21 consecutive innings.
- A Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a career-low one hit, 5/13 at MIA...The start was his third consecutive scoreless turn.
 - A Became the first Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to allow two hits or fewer and no runs in three consecutive starts.

- A Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 2/2 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 1/3 **Holds:** 9 **1st Batter/Retired:** 49/35 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 13/3

- Has a 2.28 ERA in 49 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the second lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Only Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lower.
- Allowed a pair of unearned runs, 9/4 vs. BOS, but has an eight-game streak without an earned tally dating to 8/19...Has fanned 10 over 7.1 innings.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts...Three of his four wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 8-for-42 (.190) with runners in scoring position, including 3-for-19 (.158) with two outs.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arodys Vizcaino, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson, Jonny Venters and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Brad Brach • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #46

Saves/Opp: 11/14 **Holds:** 10 **1st Batter/Retired:** 58/40 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/2

- Has allowed just one earned run in 16 appearances (14.1 IP) since the Braves acquired him on 7/29...Has seven holds since being acquired by Atlanta, tied for the third most in the majors in that time span.
- Took his second loss with Atlanta, 8/31 vs. PIT after allowing one unearned run in 0.2 innings...Both of his losses with the Braves have come in games in which he did not allow an earned run.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .234 (30-for-128) average, while lefties are hitting .337/.430/.424 in 108 plate appearances.
- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 12 **1st Batter/Retired:** 46/29 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 22/7

- Has retired all five batters he has faced since returning from the disabled list on 9/1...Went on the disabled list on 8/7 and missed 25 games with right shoulder inflammation.
- Made two rehabilitation appearances with Gwinnett and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings with two hits and a strikeout.
- Pitched to a 5.40 ERA (17 ER/28.1 IP) in his last 24 appearances prior to his placement on the disabled list...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season with just six walks.
- Is 3-1 with a 1.88 ERA (6 ER/28.2 IP) in 24 games at SunTrust Park.
