TODAY'S GAME: The Giants kicked off a six-game, two-city road trip last night with a 5-3, 12-inning win over the Padres...a win today and SF would win their fifth road series of the season.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Dereck Rodriguez, 26, will be facing the Padres for the second time this season...he held San Diego to one run on four hits over 7.0 innings in his only start against them on June 24 at AT&T Park...Rodriguez has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last five starts, posting a 1.67 ERA (6er, 32.1ip).

FAMILIAR FACE: Padres LHP Clayton Richard will be facing the Giants for the fourth time this season...he's 1-1 with a 7.20 ERA (12er, 15.0ip) in his three outings...Richard has faced San Francisco 23 times (20 starts) and is 7-8 with a 4.50 ERA.

NOTABLE MATCHUPS: C Buster Posey is 12-for-35 (.343) lifetime off Richard with two homers and nine RBI...**OF Andrew McCutchen** is 7-for-15 (.467) off him with two homers and **OF Gorkys Hernandez** is 10-for-19 (.526) with three doubles.

GOING FOR A SWEEP: The Giants will attempt to complete just their fourth sweep of the season today...SF hasn't swept a team since brooming the Diamondbacks in a three-game set, June 29-July 1 at Chase Field.

BYE BYE JULY: After an 18-10 month of June, the Giants have gone just 10-14 (.417) this month...the Giants have averaged 3.75 runs per game this month, the fourth-lowest average in the Majors ahead of only Seattle (3.41), Detroit (3.52) and San Diego (3.63)...SF has hit just 15 homers in July, the fewest of any team and their OPS of .648 is the third-lowest in the Majors.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants have gone 7-5 against the Padres this season, going 2-3 here at Petco Park...over the last five seasons, the Padres' pitching staff has posted a 2.82 ERA (124er, 396.0ip) against the Giants here in San Diego...SF has lost seven of the last 10 games and 14 of their last 21 here at Petco.

PITCHING IN: Giants pitchers have the second-lowest ERA in MLB beginning June 1, fashioning a 3.30 figure...the Yankees have the lowest figure at 3.29.

ON THE ROAD: The Giants are 22-32 (.407) on the road this season, tied with San Diego for the second-lowest road winning percentage in the NL and seventh-lowest in MLB...SF has lost six of their last nine road games and have won just four road series all year (at LAA, at WAS, at ATL & at ARI).

POSEY AT PETCO: C Buster Posey, who is 9-for-18 (.500) in his past four games, is a career .299 hitter with 10 homers and 42 RBI in 59 games here at Petco Park...his .299 batting average is the eighth-best among active players.

HAVING THE LEAD AFTER 6: The Giants are 44-5 (.898) this season when leading after 6.0 innings...that's the fifth-best record in the MLB...however, when tied or trailing through 6.0 innings, the Giants are just 10-49 (.169).

JUST SCORE FOUR: The Giants are 43-13 (.768) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game.

The Giants edged the Brewers, 4-3, in 11 innings, as **Robb Nen** set a new Major League record with his 14th save of July, one shy of the mark for any month.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez
6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992)
5-1 Record, 2.75 ERA

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 10th Major League start (12th appearance) today...the Giants are 7-2 overall when he takes the hill as a starter.
- Since making his big league debut on May 29, he's been one of the best Giants pitchers and one of the top NL rookies...ranks second among NL rookie pitchers in ERA (2.75), tied for second in wins (5), fifth in OPS (.692) and sixth in opponents batting average against (.236).
- His ERA is the fourth-lowest among all rookie pitchers in the big leagues behind Oakland's Lou Trivino (1.25), Boston's Hector Velazquez (2.45) and Atlanta's Shane Bieber (2.58).
- Beginning June 24, his 1.53 ERA (6er, 35.1ip) is the third-best in the Majors behind Boston's Chris Sale (0.23) and Arizona's Zack Greinke (1.33).
- Last pitched Thursday night versus Milwaukee and did not factor into the decision after yielding a pair of runs on five hits in 6.0 innings...marked his sixth-straight start of allowing two runs or fewer.
- Is 4-1 with a 2.91 ERA (17er, 52.2ip) in nine starts compared to a 1-0 record with a 1.42 ERA (1er, 6.1ip) in two relief outings.
- His last five starts: 2-0 record, 1.67 ERA (6er, 32.1ip), 22 strikeouts, seven walks, .200 avg. against.
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in eight of his nine starts this year.
- Opponents are hitless in their last 17 at-bats off Rodriguez with runners in scoring position and are just 3-for-their-last-27 (.111).
- Has faced the Padres once this year on June 24 and limited the Friars to a run on four hits in 7.0 innings... did not factor into the decision of a Giants 3-2 win.
- Prior to being called up by San Francisco May 28 he posted a 4-1 record with a 3.40 ERA (19er, 50.1ip), 53 strikeouts and 11 walks allowed in nine starts for triple-A Sacramento this season.
- Signed by the Giants this offseason (Nov. 15, 2017) as a six-year minor league free agent...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee.
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez...his dad has traveled to watch him pitch against the Nationals in Washington, the Marlins in Miami and against the Cardinals in San Francisco.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.

NOTES: The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill Thursday at Arizona for his 11th start of the season...the Giants are 4-6 in his outings this year, going 0-4 on the road...needs just one more win to match **Tim Lincecum** for the fourth-most in SF-era history...last pitched Friday vs. Milwaukee and was charged with his fourth loss of the year after allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits in a season-high 8.0 innings of work...the Giants lost 3-1...is 9-11 with a 2.60 ERA in 31 games (31 starts) against the Diamondbacks...enters his outing today having lost four in a row to Arizona, going 0-4 with a 2.67 ERA...has not earned a win over the Snakes since July 10, 2016.
