TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their final road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game, 3-city jaunt, with the second (0-1) of 3 games at Texas...began the trip by going 3-1 at Los Angeles-AL and 2-1 at Houston...return home Monday to close out the 2018 season hosting Oakland (3 games) and Texas (4 games)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners lost last night, but have won 5 of their last 8 and 6 of their last 11...are 19-19 in their last 38 games dating back to Aug. 9...are 29-38 in their last 67 games since July 4 after winning a season-high 8 straight games, spanning June 25 - July 3...the Mariners are 44-45 in their last 89 games since June 10...Seattle is 70-58 in its last 128 games (4/28-c) and 75-61 over its last 136 games (4/20-c)...Seattle is 24-26 during the day and 60-43 at night...Seattle is 41-33 at Safeco Field, 43-36 on the road.

- **Full 90** - **Nelson Cruz** (90 RBI) has recorded at least 90 RBI for the 5th consecutive season...so far, he is the 2nd player in the Majors with 90+ RBI in every season since 2014 (also: Edwin Encarnación)...José Abreu (78 RBI) and Albert Pujols (64 RBI) could join this duo.
- **Exist to Assist** - **Mitch Haniger** has 12 outfield assists this season, tops in the American League and tied with Billy Hamilton-CIN for the Major League lead...each of Haniger's 12 outfield assists have come as a right fielder, tops by any right fielder in the Majors...Haniger's 12 outfield assists are the most by a Mariners player since **Ichiro Suzuki** also had 12 outfield assists in 2004.
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 61-19 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 23-50 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (73-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (76-0).
- **Division Rivals** - the Mariners are in the midst of playing their final 17 games (5-3) vs. AL West foes...Seattle is 36-31 (.537) vs. the AL West this season (**6-7 vs. TEX**, 10-9 vs. HOU, 11-8 vs. LAA and 9-7 vs. OAK).

ON THE MARCO...**Marco Gonzales** is making his 15th career appearance (7th start) in the month of September...he enters tonight's start with a record of 4-0 with a 3.53 ERA (17 ER, 43.1 IP) with 42 strikeouts and 15 walks in 14 games (6 starts) in the month of September...Gonzales made 5 appearances, including 2 starts, with the Mariners last September, posting a record of 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER, 16.0 IP)...in 2 starts so far this September, he has a 3.60 ERA (4 ER, 10.0 IP) with 8 strikeouts and 2 walks.

GLOBE TROTTER...in 69 career games at Globe Life Park in Arlington, **Kyle Seager** is batting .296 (81x274) with 49 runs, 23 doubles, 13 home runs, 49 RBI, 23 walks, a .359 on-base percentage and a .522 slugging percentage (.881 OPS)...Seager has hit safely in 22 of his last 32 games in Globe Life (8/17/15-c)...he has homered in 4 of his last 11 games at Globe Life...overall, Seager has 20 multi-hit games and 15 multi-RBI games at Globe Life...his 15 multi-RBI games are T4th-most by a visiting player in the 25-year history of the ballpark (also: Paul Konerko, Albert Pujols and Miguel Tejada), trailing Garret Anderson (21), Tim Salmon (20) and Torii Hunter (16).

GAMER...**Mitch Haniger** has played in 1314.2 innings this season, 5th-most in the American League...he trails only Marcus Semien-OAK (1359.1), Alex Bregman-HOU (1342.0), Matt Olson-OAK (1337.0) and Francisco Lindor-CLE (1317.1)...Haniger's 1314.2 defensive innings are 2nd-most of any outfielder in the Majors this season, trailing only Nick Markakis-ATL (1353.1).

COMING IN HOT...**Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 41 of his last 47 games, dating back to July 31...during that span, he's batting .330 (64x194) with 32 runs, 18 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs, 23 RBI, 2 HBP, 17 walks, a .386 on-base percentage and a .567 slugging percentage (.953 OPS)...among Major League leaders since July 31, Haniger ranks 2nd in hits, T3rd in doubles, T3rd in extra-base hits and 10th in batting...he has an active 10-game hitting streak (9/11-c), batting .400 (16x40) with 9 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 5 RBI and 4 walks over that span...Mitch went 1-for-3 last night, but has 6 multi-hit games in his last 9 contests.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME...with 2 road games remaining this season, the Mariners are 43-36 (.544), tied for the 6th-most road wins in the Majors...the Mariners are tied with Los Angeles-NL (43-32/.573), while trailing Houston (52/22.703), Boston (51-28/.646), Atlanta (45-30/.600), Oakland (44-31/.587) and St. Louis (44-34/.564)...in Mariners club history, the 2018 club is also tied for the 6th-most road wins in a single season (also: 2003, 43-38/.531), trailing 2001 (59-22/.728), 2014 (46-35/.568), 2002 (45-36/.556), 1997 (45-36/.556) and 2000 (44-37/.543).

SEPTEMBER SONG...since Sept. 1, **Mitch Haniger** is batting .310 (22x71) with 13 runs, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs and 7 RBI in 18 games...in 27 games in the month of September last season, Haniger hit .365 (42x115) with 17 runs, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs and 14 RBI...over the last two Septembers, Haniger is batting .344 (64x186), the 5th-highest average in the Majors (min. 100 PA)...he trails only Nicholas Castellanos (.375/69x184), J.D. Martinez (.365/57x156), Kurt Suzuki (.354/35x99) and Alex Presley (.351/34x97).

WHAT A RELIEF...since Sept. 5, Mariners relievers have combined for a 1.47 ERA (9 ER, 55.0 IP), the 2nd-best bullpen mark in the Majors over that span...Seattle trails only Milwaukee (1.26/8 ER, 57.1 IP), while ranking ahead of Los Angeles-NL (2.45/14 ER, 51.1 IP) and Colorado (2.61/15 ER, 51.2 IP)...over this same span (9/5-c), Mariners relievers have recorded 49 strikeouts and 11 walks (1 IBB) while posting a 0.85 WHIP (11 BB, 36 H, 55.0 IP) and limiting opposing batters to a .187 (36x193) average against.

THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT...in 71 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 56-for-60 (93.3%) in save opportunities with a 2.02 ERA (16 ER, 71.1 IP) with 120 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .161 (40x249) average against with a 0.79 WHIP (16 BB, 40 H, 71.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 56 saves...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 42.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 120 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 136.
- Is 27-for-30 (90.0%) in one-run save opportunities with a 0.89 ERA (3 ER, 30.1 IP) with 55 strikeouts and 5 walks...the Mariners are 30-0 this season when he enters with a one-run lead.

AS YOU KNOW...**Mitch Haniger** recorded his 35th double of the season last night...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that Haniger is the 2nd Mariners **outfielder** in club history to record at least 35 doubles, 25 home runs and 90 RBI in a season?...Haniger joins Hall of Famer **Ken Griffey Jr.**, who accomplished this feat in 1992 and 1993.

ABOUT GONZALES...

- 26-year-old left-hander is making his 28th start of season, 50th career appearance (42nd start) and his 4th career start against the Rangers.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 years (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002).

LAST START...did not factor into the decision in the Mariners 3-4 loss to Los Angeles-AL on Sept. 16...allowed 3 runs on 6 hits and 2 walks while striking out 6 across 5.0 innings...all 3 runs scored on a Justin Upton home run with 2 outs in the 3rd inning.

STREAKY...lost 4 straight starts (Aug. 3 - Aug. 22) after winning 5 straight starts from June 29 to July 29...recorded a 10.35 ERA (23 ER, 20.0 IP) with opponents batting .396 (38x96) against over the recent 4-game skid...during the winning streak he posted a 1.57 ERA (6 ER, 34.1 IP) with 31 strikeouts while holding opposing hitters to a .198 (24x121) average.

NO FREE PASSES...has issued just 30 walks compared to 136 strikeouts across 155.2 innings pitched this season...is 5th in the AL with a 4.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio...ranks 4th in the AL with a 1.73 walks-per-9.0-innings ratio...has issued 1 or fewer walks in 18 of his 27 starts; his 18 such starts are T8th-most in the AL.

PICK YOUR POISON...ranks 1st in the American League/2nd in the Major Leagues with 7 pickoffs...trailing only Eric Lauer-SD (10) for the Major League lead.

GAS IN THE TANK...has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in 16 of his last 23 starts and 17 of his 27 starts overall this season...is 11-7 with a 3.88 ERA (60 ER, 139.0 IP) with 27 walks and 117 strikeouts in his last 23 outings, including 11 quality starts...prior to 2018, Gonzales had only reached the 6.0 inning mark in 1 start, on Aug. 30, 2014 vs. Chicago-NL with St. Louis (6.0,3,1,1,2,5).

HE'S BACK...reinstated from the 10-day disabled list prior to his start on Sept. 11...originally placed on the disabled list with a cervical (neck) muscle strain on Aug. 27.

GOING THE DISTANCE...tossed 1st career complete game on June 29 vs. Kansas City, allowing just 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks while striking out 7 batters across 9.0 innings...became the 2nd Mariners pitcher to throw a complete game this season (James Paxton, 2x)...held the Royals scoreless until the 9th inning.

2017 SEASON RECAP...went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 G (8 GS)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 G (7 GS) with Seattle.

BULLDOG ROOTS...played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.

POSTSEASON GLORY...added to the Cardinals roster for the 2014 National League Division Series vs. Los Angeles-NL...made 3 appearances in the NLDS, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk...picked up the wins in Game 1 and Game 4 vs. the Dodgers...became the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002)...in the 2014 NLCS vs. San Francisco, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk in 3 appearances.

CAREER...in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is 17-12 with a 4.67 ERA (121 ER, 233.0 IP) with 200 strikeouts and 63 walks in 49 games (41 starts)...originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.
