



52 MIKE CLEVINGER RHP (12-8, 3.07 ERA)

TONIGHT'S START

The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his final start of the regular season in tonight's contest at Kansas City...will mark his 76th career appearance and 63rd start, as well as his 32nd start and appearance of the 2018 campaign.

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

Clevinger will face the Royals for the fifth time this season in tonight's contest...has compiled a 2-0 record and 2.33 ERA (7ER/27.0IP) vs. the Royals this year.

RAY OF SUNSHINE ON THE ROAD

Clevinger is due to make his 15th road start of the year, posting a 5-5 record and 2.99 ERA (29ER/87.1IP) across his 14 outings...enters play tonight with the 6th-lowest road ERA in the American League.

RIDING HIGH

Clevinger enters tonight's start with 12 wins, tying his single-season career high, also done in 2017...his 31 starts, 193.1 innings pitched and one complete game also mark single-season career bests...recorded his first career game with 10-or-more strikeouts on May 6, and has made five such starts overall this year.

Clevinger has recorded 20 quality starts so far this year, a career-high mark...Tribes starting pitchers have recorded 97 such starts this season, tied with Houston for the most in MLB.

Fanned 10 batters on September 4 vs. Kansas City (W, 6.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 1BB), marking his fifth career game with 10-or-more strikeouts, all of which have come this season...the Tribe pitching staff has 30 such starts this season, a new franchise record and tied with Houston for the most in the Majors.

Clevinger posted a 3-0 record and 2.21 ERA (9ER/36.2IP) in six August starts, his 2nd-lowest ERA in a single month (min. 5GS), behind Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA)...his 39 punchouts also tied his most in a single month, alongside May and July 2018.

Collected his 10th win of the season on August 30 vs. Minnesota (6.2IP, 4H, 2R/0ER, 1HR, 1BB, 9K), reaching the 10-win mark for the second time in his career after notching a career-best 12 victories in 2017.

Tossed 6.0 shutout innings on August 19 vs. Baltimore...marked his second scoreless start of 6.0-or-more innings this season (eighth of his career)...Tribes starters have recorded 27 such starts this year, the most in MLB and a new single-season franchise record.

Clevinger matched his career high with 11 strikeouts on July 9 vs. Cincinnati (also, June 14 at Chicago-AL)...marked his fourth career start with 10-or-more strikeouts.

Notched his seventh win on July 1 at Oakland, holding the Athletics to three runs on eight hits (2BB, 5K) over 6.0 innings...marked his 11th quality start of the season, matching his career high (set in 2017).

Concluded June with a 2-1 record and 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in five starts...marked his 4th-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 5G), trailing Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA), August 2018 (2.21 ERA) and March/April 2018 (2.56 ERA)...his 33 strikeouts in June marked his 4th-most in a single month, behind his 39 punchouts in May, July and August 2018.

On June 14 at Chicago-AL, set a new career-high with 11 punchouts in the Tribe's 5-2 win (7.0IP, 5H, 2R/1ER, 1BB)...combined with his start on June 19 (10K), struck out 10-or-more batters in consecutive starts for the first time in his career.

Tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21...held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts...his two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since CARLOS CARRASCO allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).
