- TRIBE HEADLINES

 » Cleveland is heading to its fourth Postseason in the past six campaigns...the club's 543-424 (.562) record since the start of 2013 is the best in the A.L. (2nd-best in MLB - LAD, 560-408).
- » The Tribe has won 89 games this season and sits one win shy of posting 90+ victories in three consecutive seasons for just the third
- time in franchise history (1999-2000, 1950-55).

 » The Indians have gone 47-26 (.644) vs. the A.L. Central, marking the 3rd-best intradivisional record in MLB (BOS - 51-22, .699; ATL 48-25, .658)...the club's 2.81 ERA vs. the Central is the lowest by
- any team against their own division.

 » MIKE CLEVINGER owns a 7-1 record and 2.00 ERA in 13 starts against the A.L. Central this year, the lowest ERA vs. the division (min. 60.0IP)...has gone 5-3 with a 2.40 ERA in the second half, the 4th-lowest ERA among A.L. pitchers in that span (min. 50.0IP).

 ***JOSÉ RAMÍREZ (80XBH) and FRANCISCO LINDOR (84XBH)

- MODEL OF CONSISTENCY

 » The Indians are headed to their fourth Postseason in their past six campaigns, all under the management of **Terry Francona**. » Cleveland has posted a record above .500 in each of the past six
- seasons, marking the club's longest such streak since doing so in eight straight campaigns from 1994-2001...also represents the 2ndlongest active streak in the American League (NYY - 26 straight seasons) and the 5th-longest in MLB.
- » The Tribe enters tonight's contest with 89 wins on the season, after winning 102 in 2017 and 94 games in 2016...should Cleveland reach 90 wins this season, it would mark the third time in franchise history that the club won 90+ games three seasons in a row, after doing so from 1999-2001 and the franchise-long streak of six consecutive seasons from 1950-55.
- » Since Francona's tenure began in 2013, the Indians hold the best record in the American League (2nd-best in MLB).

- The Indians clinched their third consecutive A.L. Central division title on September 15, their earliest clinch date since
- will hold home-field advantage throughout the Postseason...since Houston won and Oakland lost on Sept. 25, the Astros have officially clinched the A.L. West and the #2 seed in the A.L. bracket. » The Indians and Astros, the American League's last two repre-
- sentatives in the World Series, will officially meet in the ALDS for their first-ever Postseason matchup...Games 1 & 2 will be held in Houston on October 5 & 6, while Cleveland will host Game 3 on October 8 and Game 4 (if necessary) on October 9

ROYAL FAREWELL

- » The Indians are in Kansas City this weekend to close out the 2018 regular season with four games against the Royals...<u>Tribe</u> has posted a 10-6 record through the first 16 contests of the season series, outscoring the Royals 81-55 in that span.
- » Cleveland has gone 6-3 at home and 4-3 in Kansas City this season...the Indians have a 155-167 (.481) record at Kauffman Stadium since the park opened in 1973...this includes a 27-26 (.509) mark since 2013, and the club's 27 wins in that span are tied with Detroit for the most by an opponent in this ballpark...overall, Tribe owns a 368-334 (.524) record vs. KC, dating back to 1969.
- » This weekend's series marks the eighth time (16 games) the Tribe will conclude the regular season against the Royals, as well as the first instance since 2016, when Cleveland swept KC 3-0 at Kauffman Stadium...Tribe is 14-2 overall across those 16 contests.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- » Cleveland fell to the Royals, 2-1, in 10 innings last night...Tribe is now 4-9 in extra innings this season.

 » JOSH DONALDSON went 3-for-4, notching a season-high tying three hits and recording his fourth multi-hit game since his Indians debut on September 11...**MELKY CABRERA** (2-4) and **YANDY DÍAZ** (2-4) also had multi-hit games.
- » GREG ALLEN stole two bases, bringing his season total up to 21 and becoming the fourth Tribe hitter with 20-or-more steals this season...marks the first time the Indians have four 20+ steal players since 1911 (Mike Pocta, SportsTime Ohio).
- » JOSH TOMLIN did not factor into the decision, holding the Royals to one run on four hits in 4.2 innings, with zero walks allowed and a season-high five strikeouts...marked his 66th career walkless start, the most by any pitcher in Tribe history.

KC AND THE SUNSHINE BAND

- » MIKE CLEVINGER will take the mound for the Tribe tonight vs. Kansas City, pitching on extended six days' rest after his last start on Sept. 22 vs. Boston (ND, 5.0IP, 3H, 2R/ER, 1HR, 5BB, 6K).

 » Last faced the Royals on September 4 at Progressive Field,
- striking out 10 batters in the Tribe's 9-3 win (6.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 1BB)...has compiled a 2-0 record and 2.33 ERA (7ER/27.0IP) in four starts against KC this season, including a no-decision on August 24 at Kauffman Stadium (6.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 1HR, 2BB, 8K). » Has dominated in his 13 starts against the A.L. Central this year, posting a 7-1 record and 2.00 ERA (19ER/85.2IP) vs. the division... his ERA is the lowest mark vs. the A.L. Central in 2018, as well as the 5th-lowest ERA by any pitcher against a single division.
- » He owns a 5-3 record and 2.40 ERA (19ER/71.1IP) in 12 second-half starts this year, the 4th-lowest second-half ERA in the American League (min. 50.0IP) entering tonight's contest.

 » Clevinger also enters tonight 6.2 innings shy of 200.0 for the sea-
- son and would join COREY KLUBER (216K/210.0IP) as the only Tribe pitchers to achieve those marks this season...Clevinger and Kluber would become the fourth Indians duo to each have 200K and 200.0IP in the same season.

STURDY STARTERS

- » Tribe starters also have recorded 97 quality starts this season, tops in MLB and Cleveland's most in a single campaign since notching 108 in 1968...overall this year, Indians starters rank 2nd in the A.L. and 3rd in MLB with a 3.40 ERA (HOU - 3.20, LAD - 3.22). » Cleveland starting pitchers rank 2nd in MLB with 1,049 strikeouts (HOU - 1,081), while they have allowed just 240 walks (T4th-fewest in MLB with Oakland)...the Tribe rotation's 4.37 K/BB ratio cur-
- rently stands as the highest in MLB history.

 » Indians pitchers have recorded 30 starts with at least 10 strike-
- outs, tied with Houston for the most in MLB this season and T3rd-most in MLB history, alongside the 2002 Diamondbacks (ARI 35 in 2001 and CAL - 32 in 1973).

- NERVES OF STEAL

 » GREG ALLEN stole his 20th and 21st bases of the season last night, tops among MLB rookies and the most by an Indians rookie since **Kenny Lofton** stole 66 bases in 1992...**Cleveland leads the** Majors with 132 steals this season and looks to lead MLB in the category for the first time in franchise history.
- » Allen became the fourth Tribe baserunner to reach the 20-steal mark this season, alongside JOSÉ RAMÍREZ (34), FRANCISCO LINDOR (23) and RAJAI DAVIS (21)...marks the sixth time in franchise history and first since 1911 that the Tribe has four-or-more players with 20+ stolen bases in a season (Mike Pocta/STO).

MISC. HITTING NOTES

- » JOSH DONALDSON matched his season high with three hits last night (third time)...after starting his Indians career 0-for-7, Donaldson is batting .333 (11-33) over his last 42 plate appearances, with a double, a homer and three RBI.
- » YAN GOMES had his nine-game hit streak snapped last night but has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 contests...he is batting .317 (40-126) since August 1, the 3rd-highest batting average among MLB catchers in that span (min. 70PA).
- » MICHAEL BRANTLEY is batting .306 (82-268) in 66 games against the A.L. Central this season, the 3rd-highest AVG vs. the division (min. 150PA)...he is a career .333 (79-237) hitter in KC, the 3rd-best mark by a visiting player in this ballpark (min. 150PA) since his MLB debut in 2009 (A. Cabrera - .341, Mauer - .335).

DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 47-26 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 16-5-2 in series play...the Indians' .644 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB behind Boston (BOS - 51-22 . .699 vs. A.L. East) and Atlanta (48-25, .658 vs. N.L. East). » In 71 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.81 ERA (205ER/656.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB... the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 47 intradivisional games (40-7 in those contests).

» Clevinger will pitch tonight on extended five days' rest after making his last start on September 22 vs. Boston...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 5-4 walk-off win, holding the Red Sox to two runs on three hits (5BB, 6K) in 5.0 innings...struck out Jackie Bradley Jr. in the top of the 2nd inning for his 200th punchout of the season, becoming the fourth Indians pitcher his year to reach 200K, a new MLB record.

» He is due to face the Royals for the fifth time this season, compiling a 2-0 record and 2.33 ERA (7ER/27.0IP) across his four prior starts.

» Clevinger has pitched well in his intradivisional outings this season, posting a 7-1 record and 2.00 ERA (19ER/85.2IP) in 134 starts against the A.L. Central...owns the lowest ERA vs. the Central this season (min. 60.0IP).

» He enters play tonight with 193.1 innings pitched this season. 6.2 shy of 200 for
