#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost three of the last four games and 10 of the last 14 as they begin their final homestand of the season this afternoon vs. the Cubs in the Crosstown Cup opener.
- RHP Reynaldo López, who has allowed one run or less in each of his last four starts, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The White Sox went 4-5 on their last trip at Cleveland (1-2), Baltimore (2-1) and Kansas City (1-2) from 9/10-20.
- Following this weekend's series vs. the Cubs, the Sox will conclude the home portion of their schedule with three games vs. the Indians next Monday-Wednesday ... they will finish the 2018 season with four games at Minnesota (9/28-30; DH on 9/28).
- The White Sox went 3-7 on their last homestand vs. Boston (2-2), Detroit (1-2) and the Angels (0-3) from 8/30-9/9.

#### TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox need to win three of their final 10 games to avoid the fourth 100-loss season in franchise history.
- This weekend's series marks the final three games of Ken "Hawk" Harrelson's iconic broadcasting career.
- The Sox have lost five of the last six games vs. the Cubs, and have been outscored, 43-19, during that span.
- Reynaldo López is 2-0 with a 0.67 ERA (2 ER/27.0 IP), 0.78 WHIP, .160 opp. average and 28 strikeouts in his last four starts.
- López is the first Sox starter to allow one run or less in 6.0-plus IP in four straight starts since José Quintana (4/22-5/8/16) ... the last Sox to record a streak of five was Eric King (4/22-5/13/89).
- Daniel Palka has homered in three of his last four games, and has hit seven home runs with nine RBI over his last 14.
- Tim Anderson needs one home run to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Matt Davidson snapped a 4-4 tie with a game-winning, RBI single in the top of the 12th inning to give Chicago a 5-4 win.
- The win was the White Sox first at Cleveland since 9/30/17, snapping a nine-game losing streak at Progressive Field.
- The Sox opened an early 4-0 lead after three innings but Cleveland hit back-to-back homers in the third and scored twice in the eighth to force extra innings.
- James Shields received a ND despite making his 19th QS of the season (2 ER/6.0 IP) ... Héctor Santiago worked 3.0 scoreless IP in relief to earn his sixth win.
- Yoán Moncada went 3-5 with a double and two RBI, Omar Narváez hit his ninth homer and Yolmer Sánchez was 2-5.

#### YOUNG AND PRODUCTIVE

- Yoán Moncada last night reached 60 RBI for the season ... he needs two doubles to become the fifth player in club history, age 23 or younger, to record 30+ 2B/15+ HR/60+ RBI in one season.
- The first four were Chet Lemon (1977), Frank Thomas (1991), Paul Konerko (1999) and Carlos Lee (1999).
- Moncada also would become the first player in Sox history, 23 or younger, with 30+ 2B/15+ HR/60+ RBI/10+ SB in one season.

#### FAMILIAR FACE

- Cubs starter José Quintana today will face the White Sox for the first time since being traded on 7/13/17.
- Quintana went 50-54 with a 3.51 ERA (412 ER/1,055.1 IP) and 890 strikeouts in 172 games (169 starts) with the Sox from 2012-17 ... he was named to the American League All-Star team and finished 10th in AL Cy Young voting in 2016.

#### CROSTOWN SIGHTS AND SOUNDS

- Former Chicago Bears RB and current NBCSCH football analyst Matt Forte will throw out a ceremonial first pitch today.
- Today's Hero of the Game is Captain Jim Lovell of the United States Navy and Spacecraft Commander of the Apollo 13 flight ... Lovell is the first man to twice journey to the moon.
- Chicago Bulls forward and Simeon graduate Jabari Parker, and Sr. Mary Jo Sobieck of Marian Catholic High School, will throw out ceremonial first pitches prior to tomorrow night's game.
- "Chicago P.D." actor LaRoyce Hawkins, a native of Harvey, Ill., and Barton Fitzpatrick from Showtime's "The Chi" will throw out ceremonial first pitches on Sunday.

#### SOX SPLIT SATURDAY

- Tomorrow's Sox Split raffle will begin at a guaranteed jackpot of \$50,000, with 50 pct. of net proceeds going to one lucky winner and the remainder supporting Chicago White Sox Charities.
- Fans can purchase tickets from sellers in the ballpark and at kiosks in left field and behind home plate (100 and 500 levels).
- Illinois residents ages 18 and older can purchase Sox Split tickets online during every home game at whitesox.com/soxsplit beginning three hours prior to the scheduled game time.

#### WHITE SOX VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- The Cubs lead the season series, 2-1, after winning the series at Wrigley Field from 5/11-13 ... the White Sox are hitting .208/.294/.323 with two homers, own a 6.48 ERA (18 ER/25.0 IP) with zero quality starts and have been outscored, 22-11.
- The Sox have lost five of the last six, seven of nine and 10 of 15 ... they are 5-9 in the last 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The White Sox went 1-3 in 2017, splitting two games at Wrigley Field and losing both contests at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The White Sox are 1-2-2 in season series since 2013 after winning four straight from 2009-12.
- The Sox lead the all-time series, 59-56, going 30-26 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 29-30 at Wrigley Field.

#### CROSTOWN CONNECTIONS

- Below is a breakdown of Crosstown Cup connections for members of the White Sox roster, coaches and broadcasters:
  - ◆ Rick Renteria managed the Cubs to a 73-89 record in 2014.
  - ◆ C Wellington Castillo played for the Cubs from 2010-15 after signing with the club as an international free agent on 12/8/04.
  - ◆ TV analyst Steve Stone and radio analyst Darrin Jackson played for both clubs ... Stone spent 20 years as a Cubs TV analyst.
- A breakdown of Crosstown Cup connections for members of the Cubs roster, coaches and broadcasters:
  - ◆ Pitching coach Jim Hickey is a Chicago native, graduate of Kennedy High School and was selected by the White Sox in the 13th round of the 1983 draft ... he pitched in the Sox system from 1983-87.
  - ◆ LHP José Quintana pitched for the White Sox from 2012-17, and was named an American League All-Star in 2016.
  - ◆ Quintana was acquired by the Cubs from the Sox in exchange for four prospects, including OF Eloy Jiménez and RHP Dylan Cease on 7/13/17 ... it marked the teams' 15th trade involving MLB players.
  - ◆ Radio analyst Ron Coomer is a graduate of Lockport high school.

#### INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT

- The White Sox are 5-12 during interleague play, losing three of the last five and six of the last 10 ... they have been held to three runs or less eight times in 2018.
- The Sox will finish with a losing record vs. the National League for the fourth straight season (last winning mark in 2014; 11-9).
- Chicago is 5-4 over its last nine games, but 5-9 in its last 14 IL games at Guaranteed Rate Field ... the Sox went 6-14 in 2017.
- The Sox are 211-189 all-time during IL play (since 1997).

#### HOMER HAPPY

- The White Sox have hit 92 home runs since 7/2, the fourth-highest total in the American League and seventh-most in MLB.
- The Sox feature six players with 17-plus home runs this season, tied for the second-most in MLB behind the Dodgers (eight).
- Chicago has hit 98 HRs on the road, compared to 78 at home.

#### PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka is tied with Matt Davidson (2017) in White Sox single-season history among rookies with 26 home runs in 2018, one shy of tying Zeke Bonura (1934) for third place ... the 25 homers are the most by a Sox left-handed hitting rookie.
- He ranks among MLB rookie leaders in homers (T1st, 26), RBI (4th, 62), extra-base hits (T5th, 43) and total bases (7th, 191).
- Palka is trying to become the first White Sox rookie to lead all MLB rookies in home runs since José Abreu (36) in 2014.

#### POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (19 HR/26 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 19 home runs and 26 stolen bases this season, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story.
- Anderson needs one homer to become the first White Sox SS to record a 20-HR/20-SB season ... he is one homer and four steals shy of joining Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only Sox to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

#### GRAB SOME BENCH

- Chicago has struck out 1,485 times in 2018, the most in MLB and the most in a single season in franchise history.
- Yoán Moncada leads MLB with 206 strikeouts ... he is 16 shy of tying Adam Dunn (222 in 2012) for the club record.
- The White Sox struck out 14-plus times in three straight games from 9/16-19, becoming the fourth team in MLB history to accomplish the feat (COL-2015; BAL-2016; TOR-2016).

#### QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,386 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, tied with the New York Mets (1,386) for the most in MLB during that span, and 56 more than Oakland (1,330), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox rank third in the AL with 72 quality starts in 2018 ... RHP James Shields is tied for sixth in the AL with 19 QS.

**LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE**

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 31st start of the season, 15th at home and first career against the Chicago Cubs.
- Is 2-0 with a 2.60 ERA (10 ER/34.2 IP), 40 strikeouts and a .197 (25-127) opponents average over his last six starts.
- Is 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA (12 ER/12.0 IP), eight strikeouts and a .321 (17-53) opponents average in interleague play lifetime.
- Is 0-2 with a 5.05 ERA (23 ER/41.0 IP), 41 strikeouts and a .233 (37-159) opponents average over his last seven home starts.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

**LAST START**

- Received his sixth win of the season on 9/15 at Baltimore ... tossed 7.0 scoreless IP allowed four hits and six strikeouts ... extended his scoreless streak to 13.0 IP.
- Has received one run or less of support nine times over his last 13 games.
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 1-0, after throwing 104 pitches (73 strikes) ... the White Sox went on to win, 2-0 ... Yolmer Sánchez recorded a RBI double in the sixth and Avisail García homered in the ninth.

**LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD**

- Is limiting opponents to a .216 average with RISP (32-148) and .174 mark with RISP/two outs (12-69) this season ... opponents are 53-242 (.219) with RISP and 21-109 (.193) with RISP/two outs in his career.
- His .216 opponents average with RISP is the fourth-lowest in the American League.

**HOME NOT SO SWEET HOME**

- Is making his 20th career start at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has gone 3-5 with a 3.75 ERA (49 ER/117.2 IP), 91 strikeouts and a .221 (98-444) opponents average in 19 career starts.
- Is 2-3 with a 3.81 ERA (37 ER/87.1 IP), 69 strikeouts and a .213 (69-324) opponents average in 14 starts this season.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 9/9 vs. Los Angeles-AL ... tossed 6.0 scoreless IP, allowing two hits and a season-high tying 10 strikeouts.

**HELP WANTED**

- Owns a 3.07 run support average (60 RS/175.2 IP) in 2018, the lowest in the majors.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 22 of his 30 starts ... the Sox have scored five runs of support over his last six starts.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

**NO DECISION MADE**

- Ranks third in the MLB with 15 no decisions this season ... owns a 3.07 ERA (31 ER/91.0 IP) in those starts.
- The Sox have scored a total of 20 runs of support in his 15 no decisions this season ... including one run three times, two runs three times and three runs once ... the Sox are 6-8 when López receives a no decision.

**DAY AND NIGHT**

- Is 3-5 with a 3.65 ERA (36 ER/88.2 IP), .214 (70-327) opponents average and .655 opponents OPS in 15 day starts (nine quality) this season ... compared to 3-4 with a 4.45 ERA (43 ER/87.0 IP), .260 (86-331) opponents average and .791 opponents OPS in 15 night starts (eight quality).
- Has gone 4-5 with a 4.09 ERA (45 ER/99.0 IP), .222 (82-369) opponents average and .680 opponents OPS in 19 career appearances (16 starts, nine quality) during the day, compared to 10-10 with a 4.44 ERA (83 ER/168.1 IP), .261 (170-652) opponents average and .767 opponents OPS in 30 career games (28 starts) at night.

**MAKING HISTORY**

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he thre 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

- Is making his fourth career appearance (third start) against the American League Central.
- Is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP), 12 strikeouts and a .228 (13-57) opponents average lifetime.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 5/15 at Pittsburgh, allowed six runs on seven hits over 2.0 IP.

**VS. CHICAGO CUBS**

- Is scheduled to make his first career start against the Chicago Cubs.

**TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER**

- RHP Lucas Giolito (10-11, 5.77 ERA) is scheduled to make his 31st start of 2018, 15th at home and second career against the Chicago Cubs.
- Is 1-2 with a 4.23 ERA (13 ER/27.2 IP), 21 strikeouts and a .221 (23-104) opponents average over his last five starts.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 9/16 at Baltimore, allowing six runs on eight hits over 6.0 IP.
- Is 1-2 with a 6.84 ERA (20 ER/26.1 IP), 21 strikeouts and a .238 (24-101) opponents average over five career starts in interleague play.
- Earned the win in his only start against against the Cubs on 5/13 ... allowed three runs on two hits with three strikeouts over 5.2 IP.
