RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals wrap up their seven-game, eight-day homestand (4-PIT, 3-MIA) today against Miami...the Cardinals took three of four from the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates before losing two straight to the visiting Marlins...St. Louis travels to Cincinnati for a three-game weekend series before returning to Busch for a six-game, seven-day homestand (3-SD, 3-CHI) on Monday...the Cardinals began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.5 games back of the 1st place Milwaukee Brewers...the Redbirds are 5-5 in their last 10 games, and 10-10 over their previous 20, and 15-15 in their last 30 games.

GARCIA REINSTATED; GUILMET DESIGNATED FOR ASSIGNMENT: Before today's homestand finale, the St. Louis Cardinals announced that they reinstated infielder **Greg Garcia** from the paternity list and designated RHP **Pretson Guilmet** for assignment.

BOWMAN, HOLLAND BEGIN REHAB: Cardinals right-handed relievers **Matt Bowman** and **Greg Holland** will both begin 30-day injury rehab assignments tonight with the Memphis Redbirds (AAA). Bowman has missed 19 games (since May 27) while recovering from blisters on right index and middle fingers...Holland has missed the past 11 games (since June 5) while recovering from a right hip impingement.

#LOVERED2: The St. Louis Cardinals organization, the St. Louis community and baseball fans everywhere were saddened yesterday to learn of the passing of Hall of Famer **Albert Fred "Red" Schoendienst** at the age of 95. "Red was one of the greatest Cardinals of all time, and a beloved member of the Cardinals organization for over six decades," said Cardinals Principal Owner & Chief Executive Officer **William O. DeWitt, Jr.** "His influence on this organization cannot be overstated. Red was a great player, a great manager, and a wonderful mentor to countless players, coaches, and members of the front office. He was also a fan favorite who connected with millions of Cardinals fans across multiple generations. He will be sorely missed." Schoendienst was the oldest living member of the National Baseball Hall of Fame.

THESE GO TO 11: The Cardinals' season-high 11 runs surrendered last night marked the first double-digit run output allowed this season...St. Louis was the last Major League team to allow 10 or more runs in a game this season, beating the Diamondbacks by two days (10-3 loss at SF on June 4)...the club's 58-game streak to open the season, without allowing double-digit runs, is the 11th-longest streak in franchise history to open a season...the Cardinals 1968 National League Championship squad ranks first with a 153-game streak (11-5 loss at SF on 9/19).

THREE'S THE LIMIT: The Cardinals are one of six MLB teams to not have lost more than three straight games at any point during the season, joining Atlanta, Boston, Houston, New York (AL) and Oakland.

HOME GROWN: Twenty current players on the Cardinals 40-man roster were selected by St. Louis in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft: **Yadier Molina** (2000 - 4th Rd.), **Tommy Pham** (2006 - 16th Rd.), **Luke Gregerson** (2006 - 28th Rd.), **Matt Carpenter** (2009 - 13th Rd.), **Sam Tuivailala** (2010 - 3rd Rd.), **Greg Garcia** (2010 - 7th Rd.), **Tyler Lyons** (2010 - 9th Rd.), **Kolten Wong** (2011 - 1st Rd.), **Ryan Sherriff** (2011 - 28th Rd.), **Carson Kelly** (2012 - 2nd Rd.), **Oscar Mercado** (2013 - 2nd Rd.), **Mike Mayers** (2013 - 3rd Rd.), **Michael Wacha** (2012 - 1st Rd.), **Luke Voit** (2013 - 22nd Rd.), **Luke Weaver** (2014 - 1st), **Jack Flaherty** (2014 - 1st Rd.), **Austin Gomber** (2014 - 3rd Rd.), **Harrison Bader** (2015 - 3rd Rd.), **Jordan Hicks** (2015 - 3rd Rd.) and **Paul DeJong** (2015 - 4th Rd.). 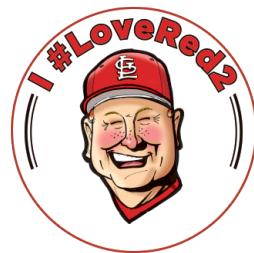

MIAMI CONNECTIONS

Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** spent parts of five seasons in a Marlins uniform (2013-17) where he was a two-time National League All-Star (2016-17)...won the 2017 National League Silver Slugger and Rawlings Gold Glove award selection...originally signed with the Marlins as a non-drafted free agent (February 15, 2008)...became a Cardinal via trade with the Marlins this off-season, exchanged for pitchers **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Sandy Alcántara** and outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** (December 14, 2017).

Cardinals pitcher **Miles Mikolas** made his MLB debut vs. the Marlins in 2012 while with San Diego...graduated from nearby Jupiter (Fla.) HS and Nova Southeastern University.

Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** and pitcher **Carlos Martinez** represented St. Louis in the 2017 MLB All-Star Game at Marlins Park...Molina became the 7th Cardinal (14th time) to homer in an All-Star game, while Martinez joined **Dizzy Dean** (1934) as the only two Cardinals with four strikeouts in an All-Star Game.

Cardinals pitcher **John Brebbia** graduated from Wellington Community (Fla.) High School.

Cardinals Hitting Coach **John Mabry** appeared in 81 games for the Marlins during the 2001 season...traded by the Cardinals to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations (April 9, 2001).

Cardinals infielder **Luke Voit** hit his first Major League home run against Miami, a two-run shot off **Jarlin Garcia** (July 3, 2017).

Marlins pitcher **Brad Ziegler** graduated from Odesa (Mo.) High School...pitched at Missouri State University (2000-03) in Springfield, Mo.

Marlins pitcher **Trevor Richards** graduated from Mater Dei Catholic High School in nearby Aviston Ill...pitched at Drury University in Springfield, Mo., where his 230 career strikeouts were second-most in program history at the time of his graduation.

Marlins VP of Scouting **Stan Meek** was selected by the Cardinals in the 15th round of the 1974 MLB Draft...played four seasons (1974-77) in the Cardinals' minor league system.

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Marlins broadcaster **Jeff Nelson** was invited to 2006 Major League Spring Training with St. Louis as a non-roster player, but was released at the end of Spring Training.

Marlins pitcher **Kyle Barraclough** was selected by the Cardinals in the 7th round of the 2012 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2012-15)...traded by St. Louis to the Marlins for pitcher **Steve Cishek** (July 24, 2015)

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter Fla. as their Spring Training site...RDSC is also the only stadium in the country to host four minor league teams: Jupiter Hammerheads and Palm Beach Cardinals of the High-A Florida State League, and the GCL Marlins and GCL Cardinals of the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League.

The Marlins played their first regular-season game at Marlins Park against St. Louis (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win in **Mike Matheny's** first game managed.

- Leads all National League pitchers in fewest walks/9 IP (1.00) and ranks in the Top 10 in wins (6, T6th), winning pct. (.857, 4th), ERA (2.49, 8th), WHIP (1.00, 4th) and strikeout/walk ratio (6.63) and.
- Is one of 14 pitchers in MLB and four in the National League with a shutout this season.
- Limited opposition to two runs or less in seven straight starts (4/14-5/21).
- Has scoreless streaks of 14.2 (5/16-27) and 14.0 (4/27-5/10), the 2nd and 3rd longest scoreless streaks by a Cardinals pitcher this season.

- Threw his first career shutout firing a four-hit gem with nine strikeouts vs. KC (5/21). Set career highs in innings pitched (9.0) and strikeouts (9). Retired 15 straight from the 4th to the 9th inning and 16-of-17 to finish game.
- Did not walk a batter over three starts (4/22-5/4) totaling 21.0 IP, 4th longest streak in MLB behind Corey Kluber (33.1), Ivan Nova (27.2) and Mike Leake (27.0) in 2018.
- Also has logged walk-less streaks of 14.0 and 12.0 IP earlier this season.
- Pitched 6.2 innings allowing a solo home run (Raffy Lopez) against his former drafting team (at SD) in a 2-1 Cardinals win on 5/10. Walked his first batter since 4/14 at CIN.
