## NATIONALS NEWS

### FINAL STAND

The Washington Nationals welcome the Miami Marlins to Nationals Park for the final home series of the 2018 season...The Nationals are looking to finish the 2018 home slate at or above .500 for the ninth consecutive season (2010-pres.).

- Following this three-game series, Washington will enjoy an off day on Thursday before heading to Colorado for a three-game weekend set to cap the 2018 season.

### HE'S STREAKING

**Anthony Rendon** has reached base safely in a career-high 31 straight games dating to Aug. 21...It is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and is the third-longest streak in the National League this season...**Matt Carpenter** is second on the list with a 35-game streak (7/8-8/17) and **Odubel Herrera** had the longest streak in the NL this year (40 G, 3/30-5/19)...During the streak, Rendon is hitting .350 with a .438 on-base percentage and a .593 slugging percentage.

- Rendon has also hit safely in nine straight games, going 16-for-35 (.457) with two doubles, three homers, 12 RBI, six walks and seven runs scored.
- On the season, Rendon ranks in the NL in doubles (2nd, 41), average (6th, .306), OPS (7th, .894), slugging percentage (9th, .522) and extra-base hits (T10th, 64).
- Since 2016, his 120 doubles are tied for the most in the National League with **Nick Markakis** (120) and are tied for third in all of Major League Baseball behind **Jose Ramirez** (139), **Mookie Betts** (134) and with Markakis.

### EVERYDAY TREA

**Trea Turner** has played in each of Washington's 156 games this season, making 152 starts and four appearances off the bench...The only player in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to appear in all 162 games in a season was **Ryan Zimmerman**, who started all 162 games in 2007.

- If Turner starts each of the six games left on the schedule, he will tie **Alfonso Soriano** (158 in 2006) for second on the list behind Zimmerman's 162 starts in 2007.
- Turner enters Sunday riding a career-long 23 game on-base streak dating to Aug. 29.

### CHASING 100-100-100

**Bryce Harper** enters Monday with 98 runs scored, 99 RBI and 126 walks in 2018...He is looking to become the sixth player since 2014 to record at least 100 runs, RBI and walks in a season...He would join **Joey Votto** (2017), **Aaron Judge** (2017), **Mike Trout** (2016), **Paul Goldschmidt** (2015) and **Jose Bautista** (2015, 2014).

- On the season, he ranks in the National League in HR (T2nd, 34), OBP (5th, .391), runs (T6th, 98), RBI (6th, 99), XBH (T10th, 64) and OPS (11th, .887).
- His career-high 126 walks lead MLB and the most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

### BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in on-base percentage (1st, .347), batting average (1st, .262), doubles (1st, 117), stolen bases (1st, 46), runs (2nd, 315), walks (2nd, 249), OPS (2nd, .782), slugging percentage (3rd, .435) and home runs (T5th, 72).

- Washington's second-half surge has placed them among the top five NL offenses in 2018 in on-base percentage (2nd, .332), runs (4th, 732), home runs (5th, 184), OPS (4th, .746) and slugging percentage (5th, .414).

### ALL HANDS ON DECK

The Nationals have used 53 players in 2018, tied for the third-most in the National League this season and the fourth-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...The 2006 Nationals used 57 players, while the 2009 and 2005 Nationals each used 55.

- 31 different players have toed the rubber for Washington, the most in a season in Nationals history and tied for the fourth-most in the National League this season.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### September 24 (6-5 on this date)

2016 – The Washington Nationals celebrated their third National League East title in the last five seasons, clinching the crown and a trip back to the Postseason at PNC Park. The Nationals sewed up their playoff plans with a 6-1 victory over the Pirates, coupled with the New York Mets' loss to the Phillies. The Nationals' game concluded slightly before the Mets' game, so Washington gathered in the visiting clubhouse to watch the final outs of the Phillies' victory, before popping the champagne.

In 2004, he was named the Florida Marlins Minor League Player of the Year...**Ryan Zimmerman's** 35 home runs are third-most all-time against the Florida/Miami Marlins...**Bryce Harper** (24) is tied for 11th on that same list.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #37 - STEPHEN STRASBURG - RHP

Tall, powerful right-handed pitcher is a three-time All-Star who is Washington's all-time (2005-present) leader in wins (93) and strikeouts (1,432)... On May 10, 2016, he inked a seven-year contract extension that will keep him with the Nationals through the 2023 season.

**AGAINST THE MARLINS:** Is facing the Marlins for the second time in as many starts...Is 5-0 with a 1.09 ERA in his last five starts against Miami dating back to April 3, 2017, including a shutout on Aug. 30, 2017...His 17 wins against Miami are his most against any team.

**LAST START:** Earned the win after tossing 6.0 innings of two-run ball while striking out 11 batters and walking two in Washington's 4-2 victory over the Miami Marlins on Sept. 18 at Marlins Park.

### 2018 NOTES

- Is 3-0 with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER/34.2 IP) and 43 strikeouts in six starts since returning from the disabled list...Allowed five earned runs in his first start back, but has allowed three earned runs or fewer in his last five starts.
- Has 20 strikeouts against just two walks in his last two starts...Has surrendered just two homers in five starts dating to Aug. 27.
- Prior to the start in which he suffered right shoulder inflammation, he ranked among National League pitchers in strikeouts (4th, 93), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 4.89), WHIP (7th, 1.06), opp. OBP (7th, .274), wins (7th, 6), opp. AVG (10th, .220), and hits allowed per 9.0 IP (11th, 7.32)... Also ranked seventh in the National League with a 2.33 road ERA (10 ER/38.0 IP).
- He ranked in the top 10 in the NL in opp. AVG with runners in scoring position (8th, .196) at the time of the injury with right shoulder inflammation.
- Since Aug. 19, 2017, he ranks sixth in the National League with a 2.86 ERA among pitchers with at least 25 starts...Among National League pitchers during this stretch, he ranks in opp. OBP (5th, .277) and opp. AVG (10th, .222).
- Continued his progression since returning from the disabled list...Allowed two earned runs on five hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in Washington's 5-4 win over Milwaukee...Earned his first win since May 27 at Miami.
- Fanned a season-high 11 batters on May 2 vs. Pittsburgh...Allowed two earned runs on seven hits in 7.0 innings of work.
- Allowed just three hits while striking out eight batters and walking two in 8.0 shutout innings on April 10 vs. ATL...It was his longest outing since Sept. 10, 2017 at PHI (8.0 IP)...Earned his second win as Washington topped Atlanta, 4-1
- Opened his 2018 season by tossing 6.1 innings while allowing one earned run as Washington topped Cincinnati, 13-7, on March 31...The lone earned run came via fourth inning home run by **Scott Schebler**.

### 2017 NOTES

- Put together a strong first half of the season en route to being named an All-Star for the third time in his career.
- Was a finalist for the National League Cy Young Award...Capped 2017 being named National League Pitcher of the Month in September.
- Also ranked in NL in HR/9.0 IP (1st, 0.67), opp. SLG (1st, .317), opp. OPS (2nd, .581), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opp. OBP (3rd, .265), & opp. AVG (3rd, .204).
- On May 27 at San Diego, he struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 shutout innings.
- On Aug. 19 at San Diego, he returned from a three-week stint on the disabled list...He went 5-1 with a 0.84 ERA (5 ER/53.2 IP) in his final eight starts of the regular season following reinstatement...He racked up 63 strikeouts, allowed just 10 walks and surrendered only one home run.

### CAREER NOTES

- Is 88-49 with a 3.16 ERA in 192 starts since Sept. 6, 2011, his return from 2010 Tommy John Surgery.
- When starting, Washington is 128-76 (.641) since his debut...Since the start of 2016, the Nationals are 52-20 (.722) when he starts.
- Since 2012, he ranks in NL in strikeouts (2nd, 1,316), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (5th, 10.50), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 4.45), opp. OBP (7th, .282), opp. AVG (8th, .226), opp. SLG (9th, .357) and ERA (14th, 3.19).
