This is the Mariners 42nd spring training in club history...Seattle trained in Tempe from 1977-1992 and have been in Peoria since 1993 (played all road games in '93 as stadium was being completed).

The spring roster is currently at **63** players (40 roster, 23 non-roster)...the camp breakdown by position is the following: 32 pitchers (9 non-roster), 6 catchers (3 non-roster), 13 infielders (5 non-roster) and 12 outfielders (6 non-roster).

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 42nd spring training with a Cactus League match-up today against the Milwaukee Brewers at Maryvale Baseball Park...today's game is the 9th of a 32-game Cactus League schedule for the Mariners that concludes March 27 vs. the Colorado Rockies at Salt River Fields...the Mariners will open the 2018 season March 29 vs. Cleveland at Safeco Field.

VS. THE BREWERS...the Mariners and Brewers are facing each other for the first of two games this spring (Seattle will all face Milwaukee on March 21 at Peoria Stadium)...Seattle and Milwaukee split the only two match-ups between the clubs last spring...Milwaukee leads the all-time regular season series 117-122, including going 5-7 vs. the Brewers since they moved to the National League...the two teams will not face each other during the upcoming regular season.

SENIOR CIRCUIT...Seattle is 2-1-1 against National League opponents this spring...the Mariners will play 16 games against the NL this spring, including 12 of their first 20 games...the Mariners went 12-8 during Interleague play during the 2017 season and overall are 203-181 (.529) all-time vs. the National League, the 9th-best winning percentage in Interleague play since its inception in 1997...Seattle has posted 14 seasons with a .500-or-better winning percentage vs. the NL since 2000.

ALL HANDS ON DECK...Seattle has used 72 players (who appeared in a game) this spring, including 22 players who have not a part of Major League Spring Training when camp started (MIL players from Mini Camp)...OF **Kirk Nieuwenhuis** leads the team appearing in 7 of the Mariners first 8 games while OF **John Andreoli**, INF **Mike Ford**, INF **Matt Hague** and INF **Taylor Motter** have each appeared in 6 games this spring with Seattle.

CAMP IS ABOUT TO GET CROWDED...the Mariners minor league pitchers and catchers will report on Monday, March 5 with their first workout on Wednesday, March 7...minor league position players will report on Saturday, March 10 with the first full squad minor league workout on Monday, March 12...there are approximately 40 minor league players currently participating in Mini Camp (which will run until MIL camp opens) with an additional 94 players showing up over the next week...the Mariners four full season minor league affiliates (AAA Tacoma Rainiers, AA Arkansas Travelers, High-A Modesto Nuts & A Clinton LumberKings) all open their 2018 seasons on Thursday, April 5.

IT'S EARLY...**Gordon Beckham** has hit safely in all 5 games he has appeared this spring, batting .636 (7x11) with 3 runs scored 1 double, 1 home run, 1 RBI, 1 walk and 1 HBP...he currently ranks T3rd in the Cactus League along with teammate **Kyle Seager** with 7 hits.

SPEAKING OF GETTING HOT...3B **Kyle Seager** has hit safely in each of the first 4 games he has appeared this spring, batting .636 (7x11) with 2 runs scored, 1 double and 1 RBI...INF **Andrew Romine** (.500/6x12, 2 R, 2B, HR, 4 RBI, SB), OF **Braden Bishop** (.429/3x7, R, 2B, RBI, BB, SF) and CF **Dee Gordon** (.364/4x11, 3 R, 2B, HR, 3 RBI) have each hit safely in 4 of 5 games they have appeared and all are batting over .350.

ON BASE...the Mariners have unveiled a new initiative designed to make baseball and softball more accessible to young players called **On BASE - Baseball & Softball Everywhere**...in late January, the Mariners hosted the first **On BASE** event; **Mike Zunino**, **Mitch Haniger**, **Dee Gordon** and **Ryon Healy** shared tips on pitching, fielding, base running and hitting to more than 120 Seattle area kids at the Athletic Form in SODO...additional **On BASE** programs will be ongoing throughout the season.

SINGLE-GAME TICKETS ON SALE...single-game tickets for Opening Night and all Mariners home games are available at Mariners.com/Tickets, the Safeco Field Box Office and any Mariners Team Store...the Mariners will open the regular season at Safeco Field for the first time since 2015 - and just the second time in the last 10 years...the Mariners will host the Cleveland Indians on Thursday, March 29 at 7:10 p.m.

HEY KEVIN, AS YOU KNOW...Seattle hit .286 (197x690) during Interleague play, the 3rd-highest average in the Major Leagues in 2017...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that **Robinson Canó** (.367/29x79, 12 R, 7 2B, 5 HR, 16 RBI, 5 BB), **Kyle Seager** (.359/28x78, 11 R, 9 2B, 3 HR, 19 RBI, 9 BB), **Guillermo Heredia** (.351/13x37, 4 R, HR, 3 RBI, 4 BB) and **Ben Gamel** (.339/20x59, 13 R, 3 2B, 2 3B, HR, 7 RBI, 6 BB) each hit over .330 for the Mariners during Interleague play last season?...also INF **Ryon Healy** (.381/24x63, 7 R, 4 2B, 5 HR, 16 RBI, BB) and CF **Dee Gordon** (.329/26x79, 16 R, 5 2B, 3B, HR, 7 RBI, 5 BB) also had batting averages above .320 during Interleague play in 2017...Healy's .381 average was 7th-best in the Major Leagues.

2018 Spring Training - 0-0, 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 2.0 IP) in 1 GS...allowed 1 BB and struck out 4 in 2.0 hitless inning in Spring Training debut on 2/25 vs. LAD.

- **Last Season** - Went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) in 11 games, including 8 starts with St. Louis (1 G) and Seattle (10 G, 8 GS).
- **September Surge** - In 5 games, including 2 starts, in September, went 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER, 16.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts.
- **Mariners Debut** - Made Mariners debut on Aug. 6 at KC, getting a ND despite leaving with a 7-2 lead but did not complete 5.0 innings.
- **The Trade** - Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor leaguer Tyler O'Neill (OF) on July 21, 2017.
- **Tacome Time** - Made 2 starts with AAA Tacoma, going 2-0 with 4.50 ERA (6 ER, 12.0 IP) while striking out 9.
- **AAA Recap** - Combined with AAA Memphis (11 GS) and AAA Tacoma (2 GS), was 8-4 with a 3.14 ERA (28 ER, 80.1 IP) with 66 strikeouts in 13 combined starts.
- **Memphis Man** - In 11 starts with AAA Memphis (St. Louis), went 6-4 with 2.90 ERA (22 ER, 68.1 IP) with 57 strikeouts.
- **Career** - In parts of 3 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, '17) and Seattle ('17), is 5-3 with a 5.47 ERA (47 ER, 77.1 IP) with 64 strikeouts and 33 walks in 22 games (14 starts)...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.

2018 Spring Training: 0-0-1, 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 2.0 IP) in 2 G...has struck out 5 of 6 BF in 2 G...struck out the side in the 9th inning to earn SV#1 in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD...struck out 2 in 1.0 IP on 2/26 at CHI.

- **Totals** - Went 1-1, 4.24 ERA (22 ER, 46.2 IP) & 52 K's in 41 G w/ Seattle.
- **Up & Down** - Had 5 stints with Seattle: April 3-21, May 14-July 3, Aug. 22-27 & Sept. 1-end of year.
- **Strong Finish** - In his final 16 MLB appearances (June 24-end of season), he posted a 1.74 ERA (4 ER, 20.2 IP) with 19 strikeouts.
- **Tacoma Time** - 2-0-6, 1.54 ERA (4 ER, 23.1 IP) in 20 G w/AAA Tacoma.
- **Career** - Is 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA (23 ER, 59.0 IP) with 62 strikeouts and 21 walks in 56 career appearances over 2 seasons with Seattle (2016-17).
- **Drafted** - Selected by Seattle in the 5th round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mercyhurst College.

#43 — Shawn Armstrong (RHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 3.38 ERA (1 ER, 2.2 IP) in 2 G...allowed 1 R on 2 H and K'd 3 in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD...allowed 1 H and 1 K in 1.2 Sho IP on 2/26 at CHI.

- **Welcome to Seattle** - Acquired by Seattle from Cleveland in exchange for international slot money on Dec. 13, 2017.
- **The Totals** - Went 1-0, 4.38 ERA (12 ER, 24.2 IP) in 21 G with Cleveland.
- **Minor Totals** - In 28 games with AAA Columbus, went 1-1 with 10 saves and 3.07 ERA (10 ER, 29.1 IP).
- **Career** - In parts of 3 seasons with Cleveland (2015-17), is 1-0 with a 3.53 ERA (17 ER, 43.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts and 17 walks in 39 games.
- **Drafted** - Selected by Cleveland in the 18th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft from East Carolina University.

#49 — Johendi Jiminian (RHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 6.75 ERA (2 ER, 2.2 IP) in 2 G...allowed 1 H & 1 K in scoreless 7th inning on 3/24 vs. CWS...allowed 2 R in 1.2 IP on 2/27 vs. SD (1.2,2.2,2.1,0,HR).

- **Welcome to Seattle** - Signed with the Mariners as a minor league free agent on Dec. 5, 2017.

- **Last Season** - Split the season with AAA Albuquerque and AA Hartford (Colorado)...went 1-5 with a 5.40 ERA (38 ER, 63.1 IP) & 41 K's in 36 G.

- **Career** - Originally signed with Colorado as a non-drafted international free agent in 2010...prior to signing with Seattle, had spent his entire 8-year professional career with the Rockies.

#47 — James Pazos (LHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 16.20 ERA (3 ER, 1.2 IP) in 2 G...tossed a scoreless 5th inning (1 BB, 1 K) in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD...allowed 3 R on 3 H (1 BB, 1 HR) in 0.2 IP on 2/27 vs. SD.

- **Last Season** - Went 4-5 with a 3.86 ERA (23 ER, 53.2 IP) with 65 strikeouts and 24 walks in 59 relief appearances.

- **Bullpen Marks** - Among Seattle relievers was 2nd in strikeouts (65), T2nd in wins (4), 3rd in innings (53.2), 4th in games (59) and ERA (3.86) and 5th in opponent batting average (.248).

- **Career** - Has appeared in 77 G over parts of 3 seasons with the Yankees (2015-16) and Mariners (2017)...selected and signed by New York-AL out of the 13th round of the 2012 MLB Draft out of the University of San Diego.

#25 — Marc Rzepczynski (LHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 1.0 IP) in 1 G...tossed 1-2-3 3rd inning with 2 K's in Cactus League debut on 2/27 vs. SD.

- **Last Season** - Went 2-2 with 1 save and a 4.02 ERA (14 ER, 31.1 IP) with 25 strikeouts in 64 relief appearances with the Mariners.

- **Stranded** - Stranded 85% (44 of 52) of inherited base runners; best mark in MLB (min. 50 inherited runners).

- **In a Holding Pattern** - His 20 holds ranked T12th in the American League.
- **Durable** - Since 2011, has 458 relief appearances, 3rd-most among left-handed pitchers, behind Tony Watson (474) and Mike Dunn (473).

- **Career** - Enters his 10th Major League season in 2018...has compiled a career record of 14-26 with 2 saves and a 3.82 ERA (180 ER, 424.1 IP)
