MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners are 38-14 (.731) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, which is the highest winning percentage in the Majors.
- The Mariners earned their 25th comeback win of the season.
- The Mariners are 42-11 when they score 4 or more runs.
- Ryon Healy (2x4, R, 2B, HR, 5 RBI) tied his career-high with 5 RBI (also: 6/5/17 vs TOR, w/OAK).
 - Recorded his 12th multi-RBI game of the season... has hit a home run in 9 of his 12 multi-RBI games.
 - Tallied his 5th game-winning RBI with his home run in the 6th inning.
 - Recorded multiple extra-base hits for the 4th time this season (last: 6/12 vs. LAA).
- Edwin Diaz recorded his MLB-best 35th save of the season... his 35 saves rank 2nd all-time behind Francisco Rodriguez (38 in 2008 w/LAA) for most saves prior to the All-Star Break.
 - o The Mariners are 43-0 when he enters with a lead this season.
 - Has struck out the side in back-to-back saves.
- Kyle Seager (1x3, R, RBI) is batting .366 (15x41) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBI and 4 walks in 12 games since 6/26.
 - Is batting .375 (9x24) with 3 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI, and 2 walks so far in July... has a career .302 (191x632) batting average in July, his best in any month.
- Wade LeBlanc is 8-0 with a 3.64 ERA (47 ER, 116.0 IP) in 21 career starts for the Mariners... His streak of 21 starts without a loss is the 3rd-longest in MLB history by any pitcher starting their tenure with a team.
 - The Mariners are 10-4 in his starts this season.
- Denard Span (1x2, 3B, 2 BB) hit his first triple as a Mariner to lead off the 4th inning... ranks 3rd in the Majors with 67 triples since his debut in 2008.
- Dee Gordon (2x4, R, 2B) is batting .333 (25x75) when leading off a game this season.
 - Recorded his 24th multi-hit game of the season.
 - Is batting .305 (32x105) with 13 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, and 6 RBI in his last 25 games.
- Mitch Haniger (0x3, R, HBP) had reached base safely in 6 consecutive at bats prior to his strikeout in the 3rd inning.

ROCKIES NOTES:

- The Rockies allowed more than 2 runs for the first time since July 2... The 5 game streak without allowing more than 2 runs fell 1 game shy of tying the Franchise record of 6 consecutive games.
- The Rockies had their 5-game winning streak snapped, are 8-2 in their last 10 games.
- Trevor Story (2x4, R, HR, 2 RBI) ranks 2nd in the NL with 62 RBI this season.
 - Is batting .343 (47x134) since June 1, ranked 3rd in the NL prior to today's game.
 - Recorded his 28th multi-hit game of the season.
- **Carlos Gonzáles** (1x3, R, HR, RBI) extended his hitting streak to 6 games.
 - o Hit his 8th home run of the season to lead off the 5th inning.
- Antonio Senzatela made his 2nd start of the season and tossed 6.0 innings while allowing 6 runs on 5 hits with 2 strikeouts and 3 walks.
 - Has gone 1-2 with a 7.20 ERA (12 ER, 15.0 IP) on the road this season compared to 2-0 with a 3.52 ERA (6 ER, 15.1 IP) at home.
 - His 6 earned runs snapped an 8 game streak of Rockies starters allowing 2 runs or fewer... the streak was tied for the longest in club history (also: 9/16-23/2014).
- Charlie Blackmon (1x4, R, HR, RBI) has hit 3 home runs in his last 5 games.
 - Is batting .333 (9x27) with 6 runs, 3 home runs, and 5 RBI in July.



ROCKIES MANAGER BUD BLACK:

On if Dee Gordon's speed had anything to do with Senzatela's struggles in the first inning:

"I don't know in total. You've got to keep an eye on Gordon, but I would say no to that.

On if they said anything to Senzatela after the 1st inning.

"Well we coached. We said some things, sure. We talk to our players, and we talked to Antonio after the 1st inning. You can probably ask him. It was a baseball related conversation."

On if taking 2 out of 3 against the Mariners was step forward for the Rockies:

"I think so. We played well. I think all series our guys played hard. LeBlanc sort of had us handcuffed a little bit, and then we got a couple big swings. We fought back from a couple deficits today and took the lead, but overall I thought we played well. We've been playing well for a couple weeks now, so we've got to continue."
