RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue a seven-day, six-game homestand tonight (SD-3 & CHI-3)...the Cardinals rode three home runs in last night's homestand opener for a 5-2 win...St. Louis began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 2.5 games back of the 1st place Cubs...the Redbirds are 6-4 in their last 10 games and 11-9 over their previous 20.

THE GYORK STORE CALLED: Former Padre (2013-15) **Jedd Gyorko** has thrived against his former team since 2016, compiling a .442 (23-for-52) batting mark with 9 HR (5 in 8 games Busch Std.) & 18 RBI in 15 games, hitting safely in 12 of the 14 when he's taken an at-bat and collecting a HR and/or RBI in 11 of the games. In 59 plate appearances against the Friars since 2016, Gyorko leads all MLB players in BA and SLG (1.019), is 2nd in OBP (.508), & T4th in home runs.

CAFECITO CALIENTE: **José Martínez**, who ranks among MLB leaders in June in average (.531, 1st), HR (5, T2nd), RBI (11, T2nd) and hits (17, T2nd), tallied his NL-leading 10th three-hit game of the season last night while extending his hitting streak to nine games (17-32, .531). Since 1964, Martínez is only the 7th Cardinal to tally 10 or more three-hit games in St. Louis' first 64 games to begin a season, joining **Rafael Furcal** (11, 2012), **Vince Coleman** (10, 1988), **Tony Scott** (12, 1979), **Gary Templeton** (10, 1979 & 1977), **Curt Flood** (10, 1966). **Taylor Douthit** has the franchise record with 16 from 1928. (*Orf*).

READY FOR PRIME TIME: For the only time this season, all six Cardinals games this homestand will be played at night, due to Saturday's (FOX) and Sunday's (ESPN) games being picked up by a national telecast and changed to evening first pitches. The last Cardinals homestand consisting of at least six night games without a matinee was June 17-23, 2013 vs. Chicago Cubs (3-1) and Texas (0-3). The Cardinals last road trip of at least six night games without a day game was June 7-12, 2016 at Cincinnati (2-1) and at Pittsburgh (3-0), which was sandwiched between three home night games, totaling a stretch of 12 consecutive games under the lights (June 3-17, 2016). **DAY BALL:** St. Louis leads the NL with 31 day games this season, trailing only the White Sox (32) and Tigers (32).

CHICKS (AND CARDS) DIG THE LONG BALL: The Cardinals have homered in 45 of their first 64 games, going 33-12 (.733 win pct.) in those games (3-15 when not homering)...among NL clubs, only Milwaukee (33-9; .804) has a better winning pct. when going yard...St. Louis' 80 home runs are 3rd-most in the NL, behind the Brewers (83) and Dodgers (82).

HOMERS AT HOME: The Cardinals are 18-4 in games they homer in at Busch Stadium this season...their .818 win pct. is tops in the National League.

BIG MAC FLASHBACK (HR #31): June 12, 1998: **Mark McGwire** moves halfway to breaking **Roger Maris'** single-season home run record after launching a grand slam off Diamondbacks starter (and former teammate) **Andy Benes** in the 3rd inning. The 438-foot blast was Big Mac's 11th career grand slam, his first career HR at the new Bank One Ballpark (now Chase Field) in downtown Phoenix and the 30th different stadium homered in for his career. Mark's four-bagger also extended his homer streak to 11-straight series and increased his RBI total to 80 through 59 games played.

The 2018 season marks the 20th anniversary of the 1998 Home Run Race that ultimately concluded with Mark McGwire belting 70 homers while establishing a new MLB single-season home run record. Cardinals.com/McGwire

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** played parts of three seasons with the Padres (2013-15)...originally selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2010 MLB Draft...traded by the Padres with cash to St. Louis for outfielder **Jon Jay** (December 8, 2015).

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** pitched five seasons (2009-2013) with San Diego...acquired by San Diego from St. Louis as the player to be named, to complete the December 4, 2008 trade of pitcher **Mark Worrell** in exchange for infielder **Khalil Greene** (March 23, 2009).

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** pitched parts of two seasons with San Diego (2012-13) and made his MLB debut on May 5, 2012 vs. Miami...originally selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB Draft...later traded to the Pirates with infielder **Jaff Decker** in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013).

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and pitcher **Jordan Lyles** were once traded for one another (December 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler and a player to be named to the Astros in exchange for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played part of the 2008 season for San Diego (26 games)...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for infielder **David Freese** (December 14, 2007).

Pitcher **Bud Norris** signed as a free agent with San Diego (August 11, 2015)...pitched in 20 games during the 2015 season.

Infielder **Greg Garcia** was born in El Cajon, Calif...graduated from Valhalla (Calif.) High School...currently resides in Santee, Calif.

Outfielder **Tommy Pham's** first MLB hit (double) was July 4, 2015 vs. San Diego...hit his first MLB home run the following day off **Ian Kennedy** and had all three RBI in the team's 3-1 win.

Outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** was a teammate of pitcher **Brand Hand** (2013-15) and catcher **A.J. Ellis** (2017) while in Miami.

Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** pitched parts of two seasons with San Diego (1991-92)...signed with the Padres as a free agent (March 31, 1991)...later traded by San Diego to the Mets for pitchers **Mike Freitas** and **Roger Mason** (December 17, 1992).

Hitting Coach **John Mabry** played part of the 2000 season with the Padres...originally traded by Seattle with pitcher **Tom Davey** to San Diego for outfielder **Al Martin** (July 31, 2000).

Future Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for pitcher **Woody Williams** (August 2, 2001).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with the Padres (1978-81)...later traded by San Diego with pitchers **Al Olmsted** and **Steve Mura** to St. Louis for pitcher **Luis DeLeon**, outfielder **Sixto Lezcano** and shortstop **Garry Templeton** (December 10, 1981).

Padres bench coach and Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** played in parts of five seasons for St. Louis (1997-2001)...broke Roger Maris' single-season home record with 70 in 1998...made three NL All-Star teams (1998-2000)...later served as St. Louis' hitting coach for three seasons (2010-12), where he was a member of the coaching staff that won 2011 World Series...originally traded by Oakland to St. Louis for pitchers **Eric Ludwick**, **T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein** (July 31, 1997).

Padres First Base Coach **Skip Schumaker** played eight years in St. Louis (2005-12)...member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals...originally selected by St. Louis in the 5th round of the 2001 MLB Draft...later traded by St. Louis to the Dodgers for infielder **Jake Lemmerman** (Dec. 12, 2012).

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** appeared in 17 games for St. Louis in 2000.

- Makes his 50th career appearance (23rd start) tonight in his 13th start of the season.
- Leads all National League pitchers in fewest walks/9 IP (1.02) and ranks in the Top 10 in wins (7, T3rd), winning pct. (.875, 2nd), ERA (2.27, 4th), WHIP (0.96, 2nd), strikeout/walk ratio (6.44, 2nd), and baserunners/9 IP (8.96, 3rd) and HR/9 IP (0.68)
- Leads the National League with a 1.28 ERA in six home starts (6 ER/42.1 IP), 3rd-lowest home ERA in MLB behind TB's Blake Snell (0.96) and CLE's Corey Kluber (1.28).
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in six starts (T4th in NL and at least 6.0 innings in 10-of-his-12 starts this season (T5th in the NL).

LAST TIME OUT

- The Jupiter, Fla. native allowed one unearned run over 7.0 innings for a win in last Thursday's homestand finale against Miami, lowering his ERA to 2.27 (4th in NL).
- Did not issue a non-intentional walk for the 6th time in 12 starts this season; is one of just three NL hurlers to issue fewer walks (nine) than games started this season, and the only pitcher in the big leagues with at least 10 games started and fewer than 10 unintentional walks.

- Is one of 14 pitchers in MLB and five in the National League with a shutout this season.
- Limited opposition to two runs or less in seven straight starts (4/14-5/21).
- Has scoreless streaks of 14.2 (5/16-27) and 14.0 (4/27-5/10), the 2nd and 3rd longest scoreless streaks by a Cardinals pitcher this season.
- Had the 4th-longest win streak (6) in the National League this season.
- Leads all National League pitchers with the fewest pitches per inning (14.4).
- Ranks T2nd in the National League with five starts without issuing a walk (Nova, PIT - 6).
- Received 50 runs of support in 12 starts, ranking 10th in the N.L. in Run Support Average (5.67), but seven in his last three games.
- Threw his first career shutout firing a four-hit gem with nine strikeouts vs. KC (5/21). Set career highs in innings pitched (9.0) and strikeouts (9). Retired 15 straight from the 4th to the 9th inning and 16-of-17 to finish game.
- Did not walk a batter over three starts (4/22-5/4) totaling 21.0 IP, 4th longest streak in MLB behind Corey Kluber (33.1), Ivan Nova (27.2) and Mike Leake (27.0) in 2018.
