CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

MIKE MONTGOMERY has pitched at least 5.0 innings in all eight of his starts this season ... has walked two or fewer batters in six of his eight starts ... has a 2.76 ERA (14 ER/45.2 IP) in those starts.

WILLSON CONTRERAS (2-for-4, 2B, R) has a career-high four-straight multi-hit games ... has hit safely in five-straight games, going 10-for-18 with two doubles, one triple, one homer and three walks during that span.

ANTHONY RIZZO (2-for-4) is batting .429 (12-for-28) in his last seven games.

NOTES: The Cubs had their six-game winning streak snapped.

- © The Cubs lost their first home game since June 19, snapping a season-high seven game winning streak at Wrigley Field.
- © Carl Edwards Jr. made his first appearance since May 29 ... missed 33 games on the disabled list with right shoulder inflammation.
- © Ian Happ (1-for-1, BB) has 32 walks in his last 40 games.
- © Albert Almora Jr. (1-for-4, RBI) is 11-for-24 with six RBI in his last six starts.
- © Kyle Schwarber (1-for-3, BB) has hit safely in five-straight games (.438/7-for-16).
- © Javier Báez (1-for-4, R) has scored 12 runs in his last nine games.

CINCINNATI REDS NOTES

TYLER MAHLE pitched a career-high 6.2 innings ... extended his winning streak to four games, the longest streak by a Reds pitcher this season ... leads the team with seven wins and seven quality starts.

© Has gone 2-1 with a 2.41 ERA (5 ER/18.2 IP) in three starts vs. the Cubs this season.

JOSE PERAZA (2-for-5, SB) has reached base in 10-straight games, batting .366 (15-for-41) with four walks during that stretch.

JOEY VOTTO (1-for-4, R, HBP) has 103 hits in his career at Wrigley Field, most among active visiting players (Ryan Braun second with 102).

BILLY HAMILTON (3-for-3, R, BB) tied a season-high with three hits (also, June 17 at Pittsburgh) ... has hit safely in five-straight games vs. the Cubs (.438/7-for-16).

NOTES: The Reds have won five-straight games against the Cubs for the first time since June 25-July 9, 2014 (five-straight games).

- © Cincinnati is 14-4 in its last 18 games.
- © Adam Duvall (1-for-4, RBI) has eight RBI in his last six games.
- © Eugenio Suárez (1-for-3, HBP) extended his hitting streak to nine games (.343/12-for-35) with a seventh inning single.
- © Raisel Iglesias recorded his seventh four-out save this season.
