LAST TIME OUT: The Padres fell 7-2 last night to the Cincinnati Reds in Game 3 of the four-game set...starter **Robbie Erlin** was saddled with the loss, allowing seven runs (all earned) and eight hits in 3.0 innings of work, including a grand slam in the second inning...**Robert Stock** and **Luis Perdomo** compiled for 3.0 innings of no-hit, no-run ball, and at the plate, **Eric Hosmer** hit his 15th homer of the season, a two-run shot in the fourth.

STORMIN IN CINCY: Yesterday's game went into a delay after the top of the seventh, and it was called after sustaining a 1 hour and 13 minute delay...the game lasted just 1:44, and before yesterday, the last Padres game that lasted less than nine innings was on June 22, 2011 @ BOS (was called due to rain after the top of the eighth inning in the Padres' 5-1 win).

YOU JUST GOT NIXED: Starter **Jacob Nix** is set to make the sixth start of his career and his first appearance opposite the Cincinnati Reds...he's relied on four pitches in his rookie campaign: four-seamer (64.5%), curve (19.3%), changeup (13.4%) and slider (2.8%).

HIS NAME IS HEDGES, AND HE'S HITTING: **Austin Hedges** has tied his career high hit streak of seven games (done once before from Aug. 4-12, 2018), batting .320 (8-for-25 with 3 2b and 2 3b) since Aug. 29...a hit in his next appearance will set his career high.

FIRST DOWN FOR THE GOOD GUYS: Since the All-Star break, the Padres bullpen has fanned 222 batters, the most in the NL and second-most in the majors (TB's 238)...in the second half of the season, the SD bullpen has the best opponent clip in the NL and the third-best in the ML (.225).

SEEING RED: This season, the Padres bats have slashed .276/.314/.448 vs. Cincinnati, clubbing eight HR and walking 12 times in six games.

CAN'T WAIT TO BE ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Since Aug. 1, the Padres have hit .268/.314/.461 on the road and .225/.286/.386 at Petco Park...the Friars have hit 29 homers in grey uniforms since the beginning of August, which are the second-most among all NL teams (behind STL's 36)...they hit just 19 at home in that time.

THIS ROADTRIP: In five games played since the beginning of their current roadtrip on Sept. 3 (@ ARI and @ CIN), the Padres pitching staff has the fourth-best SO/9 ip of any NL club with 10.13.

PADRES ON DECK *POSTSEASON ADDITION: Both Padres' affiliates won last night in post-season play to tie their best-of-five series at 2-2 and force two winner-take-all games Sunday...El Paso (AAA) got only six hits at Fresno, but five hits came consecutively in a four-run, seven-inning rally as the Chihuahuas bested Fresno 4-2 to tie the PCL's Pacific Conference Championship Series...RHP **Colin Rea** allowed a run on four hits and a walk with four strikeouts, and LHP **Brad Wieck** allowed a hit with two strikeouts in 1.2 innings to get the win...the decisive fifth game will be played in Fresno Sunday night...meanwhile, San Antonio (AA) scored two wins Saturday over Corpus Christi to force a decisive fifth game Sunday (in Corpus Christi) in the best-of-five Texas League's Southern Division Championship Series...**Buddy Reed** scored on a **Josh Naylor** grounder with one out in the 11th to give San Antonio a 9-8 win, and in the regular game that followed, LHP **Nick Margevicius** allowed one run on four hits with eight strikeouts in 7.0 innings...SS **Owen Miller** homered, and DH **Webster Rivas** hit a tie-breaking two-run double for the win...the decisive fifth game will be played in Corpus Christi Sunday afternoon.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#63 RHP Jacob Nix (2-3, 4.85)

YOU'RE ABOUT TO BE NIXED: 22-year-old RHP **Jacob Nix** is set to make his sixth-career start and first against the Cincinnati Reds here at Great American Ball Park today.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last start on 9/2 vs. COL, Nix allowed a career-high-tying five runs on five hits across 6.0 IP in SD's 7-3 defeat.

A LITTLE SOMETHING WE CALL EFFICIENCY: On Aug. 28 vs. SEA, Nix tossed 8.1 IP of one-run ball on eight hits with no strikeouts and no walks, tossing just 79 pitches.

- He became the second Padres pitcher in club history to work 8.1-or-more innings and not fan a single batter or allow a walk (first being **Randy Jones** on May 30, 1976 when he worked 10.0 innings in a complete game win vs. SF).
- Became the sixth pitcher since 2000 to work at least 8.0 innings without recording a strikeout or a walk (also: Porcello, Lohse, Hunter, Verlander and Pineiro).

STATCASTED: Has relied on four pitches: four seamer (64.5%), curve (19.3%), changeup (13.4%) and slider (2.8%)...his fastball averages at 93.1 mph, and opposing bats are hitting just .067 against his changeup.

DOESN'T NEED MUCH: Nix has received two-or-more runs of support in three of his five career starts...when he gets them, he is 2-1 with a 2.66 ERA (6 er, 20.1 ip).

SPLIT IT UP: In his five starts, lefties have gone 14-for-52 (.269) against Nix, while righties have hit .265 (13-for-49).

PUT THE NAIL IN THE COFFIN: When Nix has two strikes on a batter, opposing hitters have a .167 clip (ML average in such scenarios is .173).

GET THE FIRST GUY: When facing the first batter of an inning, opposing batters are hitting .179 (5-for-28) with two doubles and five strikeouts.

FEW FREE PASSES: Among rookies who have made at least five starts, Nix's 2.42 walks per nine innings is the seventh-best mark this year.

THIRD TIME THROUGH: Is limiting the opposition to a .174 average (4-for-23) on his third way through a lineup.

HAVE A DEBUT: Nix had his contract selected from El Paso (AAA) on August 10 vs. PHI, becoming the 13th Padre to make their ML Debut this season and the fifth to do so as a starting pitcher.

- Became the first Padre to toss 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in his debut since **Odrisamer Despaigne** on June 23, 2014 @ SF (7.0 innings).

TEXAS LEAGUE GRADUATE: Has spent the bulwark of this season with San Antonio (AA), going 2-3 with a 2.05 ERA (12 ER, 52.2 IP) with 41 strikeouts against nine walks across his nine outings (all starts).

- Allowed three earned runs or less in all nine of his Double-A outings, including two earned runs or less in seven outings and one or less in six...also ranked second in the Texas League in ERA (2.05) and fifth in opponent average (.211), minimum nine games started.

QUICK STINT: Promoted to El Paso on August 4 vs. Round Rock, tossing 6.0-shutout IP of five-hit ball, striking out three and walking none...he lowered his ERA to 1.84 on the season across his 10 combined starts...the only time his ERA sat above 2.00 was prior to his final Double-A start, when it was 2.05.

A TASTE OF THE POSTSEASON: Made one start during the 2017 postseason for both San Antonio (AA) and El Paso (AAA)...made his first career postseason start and tossed 7.0 IP of three-run ball (two earned) in the Missions' 4-1 loss on Sept. 10 vs. Midland in Game 5 of the Texas League semifinals...was promoted to El Paso on Sept. 16 vs. Memphis and started Game 4 of the PCL championship series that same day, earning the win to force Game 5 behind 6.2 IP of one-run ball in El Paso's 5-1 victory.

TUESDAY'S STARTER — #50 RHP Bryan Mitchell (1-3, 6.58)

MITCHELL MONDAY: RHP **Bryan Mitchell** earned his first win as a Padre and his first since 4/2/17 while with NYY his last time out on 9/3 at ARI...tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball, allowing just two hits in the Padres' 6-2 victory.

- Is set to make his 14th appearance (ninth start) of the season in what will be his first career start and appearance vs. the Mariners on Tuesday.
- Was reinstated from the DL on Sept. 1, having been placed on the 10-day DL on June 20 (retro June 17) with a right elbow impingement.
- Made six rehab appearances (all starts) with Lake Elsinore (A) from 8/2-27...tossed a season-high 7.0 IP in his last outing on 8/27 at Lancaster, allowing five runs (four earned) with five strikeouts and two walks.
