NATIONALS NEWS

WELCOME BACK, JOE!

Joe Ross takes the hill tonight in his return from July 2017 "Tommy John" ligament-replacement surgery... Ross is 17-13 with a 3.95 ERA in 48 career Major League games (45 starts)...He made six rehab starts in 2018, going 2-1 with a 2.39 ERA between the GCL, Potomac, Harrisburg and Syracuse.

- Ross will become the 53rd player used by the Nationals in 2018... The 53 players are the third-most in the National League and the fourth-most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...The 2006 Nationals used 57 players, while the 2009 and 2005 Nationals each used 55.

DOING JUAN SOTO THINGS

Juan Soto has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 games, hitting .375 (18-for-48) with three doubles, one homer, nine RBI, 10 walks and six runs scored during this stretch.

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 400 PA) in on-base percentage (.419) and OPS (.929).
- He leads all National League rookies (min. 400 PA) in slugging percentage (.510) and batting average (.300).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies in walks (1st, 69), runs (2nd, 64), RBI (2nd, 54), home runs (3rd, 16), doubles (3rd, 21) and hits (3rd, 101).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in walks (3rd, 69), OBP (3rd, .419), runs (5th, 64) and OPS (6th, .929).
- Among all NL hitters (min. 400 PA), he ranks in OBP (2nd, .419), OPS (6th, .929), AVG (8th, .300) and SLG (12th, .510).

ON-BASE MACHINE

Bryce Harper has reached base safely in 15 of his last 25 plate appearances dating to Sept. 1 vs. Milwaukee (8th inn.)...During this stretch, he has nine walks, six hits (3 singles, 2 doubles, homer) and five RBI.

- Harper has reached base safely in 12 straight games dating to Aug. 25...He has a .469 OBP (9 H, 14 BB) and just nine strikeouts.
- Since the All-Star break, Harper ranks in the National League in doubles (T1st, 14), RBI (2nd, 35), on-base percentage (4th, .429), runs (T4th, 32), and OPS (8th, 1.002).
- On the season, he ranks in the NL in homers (T4th, 31), RBI (7th, 89) and OBP (8th, .385).

ARMS OF NOTE

Some notes on a few members of Washington's bullpen that have been offering strong relief as of late:

- Koda Glover** has tossed scoreless relief in six straight outings dating to Aug. 26...During this stretch, he has allowed just one hit and issued one walk while striking out three batters in 5.1 innings...Opposing batters are 1-for-17 (.059) against him.
- Since Aug. 22, **Matt Grace** has struck out seven batters without issuing a walk in seven straight scoreless outings (5.0 IP)...Opposing batters are hitting .167 (3-for-18) against him during this stretch.
- Greg Holland** has pitched to a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) with 14 strikeouts and a .119 (5-for-42) opp. AVG since joining the Nationals on Aug. 7.

TURNING THE HITS

Trea Turner has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games dating to Aug. 21...During this stretch, he is 21-for-67 (.313) with two doubles, two homers, seven RBI, eight walks, three stolen bases and 11 runs scored...Turner has not been held hitless in back-to-back games since Aug. 4-5.

- Turner leads the Nationals with 40 multi-hit games this season and his career-high 156 hits are tied for seventh in the National League.

BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in OPS (1st, .790), on-base percentage (1st, .345), batting average (1st, .271), doubles (1st, 90), runs (T1st, 236), walks (2nd, 162), slugging percentage (3rd, .445), stolen bases (3rd, 29).

NATIONALS HISTORY

September 7 (4-6 on this date)

2016 - Tied at 3-3 heading into extra innings, the Atlanta Braves plated a run in the top of the 10th to take the 4-3 lead. In the bottom of the 10th, **Danny Espinosa** scored the game-tying run on an infield single by **Anthony Rendon**. In the 11th, the Nationals loaded the bases thanks to a walk by **Jayson Werth**, a double by **Daniel Murphy** and an intentional walk by **Bryce Harper**. Catcher **Wilson Ramos** laced a single to center, scoring **Jayson Werth**, giving the Nationals the 5-4 win.

Nationals manager, **Dave Martinez** served as the Cubs bench coach from 2015-2017 where he played an integral role in three Postseason appearances, including Chicago's 2016 World Series Championship...Martinez also made his Major League debut with the Cubs in 1986 and went on to play four seasons with the Cubs (1986-88, 2000)...Bullpen coach **Henry Blanco** served as Chicago's quality assurance coach from 2015-2017.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

This is Juan Soto's 56th consecutive start and he has shown no signs of fatigue. A roped double down the right-field line has the go-ahead run on third in the bottom of the eighth. I know Soto is 19, and should have a lot of energy, but it's still something to see.

- Joe Ross returns to the hill after undergoing "Tommy John" ligament-replacement surgery in July 2017.
- Max Scherzer (7.0 IP, 3 H, BB, 11 SO) and Cole Hamels (7.0 IP, H, ER, BB, 9 SO) matched up Aug. 12 at Wrigley Field...The Cubs topped the Nationals, 4-3.
- Mike Montgomery will toe the rubber for his first career start against the Washington Nationals...He's made two relief appearances (8/6/17 and 8/11/18).

#41 - JOE ROSS - RHP

Tall, athletic right-handed pitcher with smooth mechanics and a downhill delivery that deceives hitters, especially righties...Uses a power sinking two-seam fastball and a sharp slider to get batters out...Commands the strike zone, having issued just 70 walks and posting a 3.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio during his first three big league seasons...Displays composure and mound presence beyond his years...Burst on the Major League scene in 2015 after being acquired as part of a three-team deal, that also yielded infielder **Trea Turner** in December of 2014

AGAINST THE CUBS: Is 0-2 with a 3.44 ERA n three career starts against the Cubs...Has 20 strikeouts against just five walks in 18.1 IP...Made his MLB debut against the Cubs on June 6 at Nationals Park (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 4 SO).

LAST START: This marks his first Major League start of the 2018 season.

2018 NOTES

- Made six rehab starts, going 2-1 with a 2.39 ERA between the Gulf Coast League, Single-A Potomac, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Syracuse.

2017 NOTES

- Had his third season in Washington cut short after undergoing "Tommy John" ligament-replacement surgery in July.
- Made his final start of the season on July 9 vs. ATL...In previous four starts, was 2-1 with a 2.36 ERA (7 ER/26.2 IP), 22 strikeouts and eight walks.
- Struck out a career-high 12 batters on June 8 vs. BAL.
- Matched a career-high with 8.0 innings on May 23 vs. SEA (8.0 IP, 5 H, ER, 6 SO).
- Opened the season by receiving 62 runs of support, the most in MLB history through a pitcher's first four starts of the season, per *Elias*...His 10.14 average run support would have been first in MLB, if qualified.
- Opened the season with Triple-A Syracuse, but was recalled on April 19...Was optioned to Triple-A Syracuse on May 1 before being recalled on May 23.

2016 NOTES

- Began the season in Washington's rotation before being placed on the disabled list on July 3...Missed 66 games with right shoulder inflammation.
- Posted a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts against just three walks in three games after reinstatement on Sept. 18.
- Posted a 19.2 scoreless innings streak from April 10 to April 30, the longest of any Washington pitcher and 13th-longest in the NL in 2016.
- Struck out 28 batters against just four walks (7.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio) over his five starts prior to his DL stint.
- Surrendered a home run to Nick Castellanos on May 10 vs. DET, the first home run he had allowed in 160 at bats, a streak that dated to August, 2015...He entered that game as the only qualified (3.09 batters faced/ team game) starting pitcher in MLB to not allow a home run to that point in 2016, and, via the *Elias Sports Bureau*, his 160 at-bat streak was the third longest in MLB at that time behind only CIN's **Blake Wood** (174 at-bats) and BOS's RHP Carson Smith (172 at-bats).
- Made his first Postseason appearance, starting Game 4 of the NLDS at Los Angeles.

2015 NOTES

- In his first season in Washington's system, started at Double-A Harrisburg before having his contract selected on June 6 and made his MLB debut that day vs. CHI (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 4 SO).
- Solidified his spot in the rotation with his next two starts, June 13 at MIL (8.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 8 SO) and June 19 vs. PIT (7.1 IP, 6 H, R, ER, BB, 11 SO)...With that 11 strikeout effort, Ross became just the third rookie to strike out at least 10 batters in a game in Nationals history joining **Stephen Strasburg** (14 - 6/8/10; 10 - 6/18/10) and **John Lannan** (11 - 4/7/08).
- Allowed three or fewer earned runs in his first seven career starts, tying **Micah Bowie** (7 GS, 5/20-6/22/2007) for the second-longest such streak by a starting pitcher to begin a career in Nationals history (2005-present).
- Ranked among National League rookie starting pitchers (min. 13 GS) in opp. OBP (2nd, .280), WHIP (3rd, 1.11), fewest walks (4th, 21), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 3.29) and strikeouts per nine innings (8th, 8.10).
- Set a Nationals record (2005-present) by starting his career facing 51 consecutive batters before issuing his first walk (June 13 at MIL, **Adam Lind**)
- Prior to **Yasiel Puig's** home run on August 11 at LAD, Ross faced 100 right-handed batters before surrendering an extra base hit.

Elite athlete with electric, game-changing speed has emerged as one of the top young offensive threats in Major League Baseball.
