PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (78-75) vs ATLANTA BRAVES (86-68)

Saturday, September 22, 2018 – 1:05p.m. EDT – SunTrust Park – Game 154 – Road 76
RHP Jake Arrieta (10-9, 3.77 ERA) vs RHP Mike Foltynewicz (11-10, 2.90 ERA)

- **LAST NIGHT'S RECAP:** The Phillies fell to the Atlanta Braves, 6-5, at SunTrust Park in Atlanta ... Starter Nick Pivetta (ND) went 5.0 innings and allowed 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts ... Philadelphia had a 4-1 lead heading into the home half of the 7th inning when Atlanta rallied for 5 runs ... Seranthony Dominguez (1.0 IP), Edubray Ramos (0.1 IP) and Hector Neris (1.0 IP) all made scoreless appearances in relief of Pivetta.
- **SWING AND A MISS:** Philadelphia's pitching staff enters tonight's game with 1,384 strikeouts, **one shy of a franchise record 1,385 set in 2012** ... The Phillies, currently averaging 9.09 SO/9.0 IP, are on pace to obliterate their previous franchise record of 8.59, also set in 2012.
- **WHAT IF TOLD YOU...:** Today, **Jake Arrieta** will join **Aaron Nola** (31 GS) and **Nick Pivetta** (31 GS) in the 30-start club for the Phillies in 2018 ... With **Vince Velasquez** currently at 29 starts, the Phillies could have four starters reach the 30-start plateau this year ... It would mark only the sixth time in franchise history that has occurred (others: 2008, 2003, 1987, 1982 & 1968) ... In 2008, Cole Hamels and Jamie Moyer each started 33 games and Kyle Kendrick and Brett Myers both started 30.
- **SUNTRUST THE PROCESS:** Over the last five games against the Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia's starting pitchers have posted a 1.73 ERA (5 ER, 26.0 IP) with 30 strikeouts to 7 walks ... When scoring at least four runs against the Braves this season, the Phillies are 4-2 and have won four of their last five games in which they have done so (3/30-current).
- **NOTHING BUT RHYS-PECT:** Wednesday night, **Rhys Hoskins** connected on his 50th career home run in his 192nd major league game ... In doing so, Hoskins became the seventh-fastest player in the history of Major League Baseball to reach his 50th home run, trailing only Ryan Howard (182 G), Aaron Judge (174 G), Ryan Braun (171 G), Gary Sanchez (161 G), Mark McGwire (161 G) and Rudy York (153 G) ... Since he burst onto the scene August 10, 2017, **Hoskins'** 50 home runs rank T-4th in MLB with **CLE's Francisco Lindor**, trailing only **NY Yankees' Giancarlo Stanton** (56 HR), **OAK's Khris Davis** (57 HR) and **BOS' J.D. Martinez** (64 HR) for the major league lead in that stretch ... Lastly, Hoskins currently sports a .247/.354/.496 slash line ... Over the last 10 years, only three Phillies have finished a season with a slash line of at least .250/.350/.500: Chase Utley in 2009, Jayson Werth in 2009 & 2010 and Ryan Howard in 2009 & 2010.
- **YOUTH GROUP:** The Phillies began the season with the youngest roster in MLB ... With under two weeks remaining in the season, the Phillies have collected 932.2 innings from pitchers aged 26 or younger, the second-highest total of any team in the majors (most: PIT, 1050.2 IP) ... Of note, per FanGraphs, Philadelphia has totaled 16.5 WAR from hurlers 26 or younger this season which leads the majors (next: COL, 11.5) ... Further, every Phillies pitcher, not named Jake Arrieta, who has made a start this season has been 26 or younger ... Philadelphia's 124 games started by pitchers 26 or younger lead the majors (next: STL, 117 GS) ... Offensively, Philly's 3,725 plate appearances by players 26 or younger rank 2nd in the majors to only the Cubs (3,794) and their 123 home runs are most (next: TEX, 120 HR).
- **HATS OFF FOR HECTOR:** Right-hander **Hector Neris** is averaging 14.40 SO/9.0 IP this season which ranks 2nd in the National League, trailing only MIL's Josh Hader (15.90) ... Neris has at least one strikeout in 21 consecutive appearances which is the longest streak by a Phillies reliever since at least 1908 (previous: Ryan Madson, 19 in 2010) ... Since being recalled from Lehigh Valley (AAA) on 8/14, Neris has struck out 31 of the 60 batters he has faced (51.7%).
- **DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME:** With nine games left in the 2018 season, the Phillies enter play today 7.5 games back of the Atlanta Braves for first place in the National League East and 6.5 games back of the second wild card, trailing St. Louis ... Of Philadelphia's nine remaining games, six will be on the road (2 G at ATL & 4 G at COL) and three at CBP (3 G vs ATL) ... **Five of their final nine games this season will come against the Braves.**
- **MR. NO DAYS OFF:** Starting with Thursday night's game in Atlanta, the Phillies will play consecutive four-game series away from home for the first time since July 2010 (at CHI & at STL) ... The Phils are in the midst of 17 consecutive games without an off day to finish their season ... This marks the longest stretch this year for the club without an off day ... Per Elias, this is the first time the Phillies have finished a season with at least 17 straight games and no days off since the year 2000 when they also finished with 17 straight from September 15-October 1.
- **CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH:** Prior to Tuesday night's game, the Phillies reinstated **LHP Aaron Loup** off the 10-day DL ... The Phillies are currently the only team in Major League Baseball without a player on the DL ... As it stands now, this would be the first time since at least 1994, or as far as Phillies internal records go back, that Philadelphia finished a season without a single player on the disabled list.
- **PROGRESS IN THE PROCESS:** Thus far, through 153 games, the Phils are three games above .500 at 78-75 and in regards to the .500 mark, have improved by 34 games from this point last year when they were 31 games under .500 at 61-92 ... As for run differential, the Phillies have improved by 89 runs from this time last year when they carried a -102 mark through 153 games ... The Phils, who matched last year's win total of 66 on August 15, didn't notch their 66th win last year until the final day of the season, October 1 against the Mets, a difference of 47 days on the calendar.

LAST START: 9/17 vs NYM: ND, 5.0 IP, 9 H, 4 R, 4 ER, BB, 6 SO ... Arrieta vs Wheeler ... J.P. Crawford went 1-for-3 at the plate with a three-run triple in the 5th inning.

TODAY'S START:

- Milestone Watch:** Arrieta needs just 2 wins to reach 100 for his career ... **He would become the 24th active player to reach 100 career wins (most: Bartolo Colon, 247)**
- Be Brave:** Three of Arrieta's last four starts against the Braves have been scoreless, dating back to July of 2015 ... In those four starts, he is 4-0 with a 0.68 ERA (2 ER, 26.2 IP), 27 SO, 0 HR allowed and a .186 OPP AVG ... **Arrieta is looking to become just the third pitcher since 2008 to win at least 5 straight starts against the Braves (others: Max Scherzer and Stephen Strasburg, 5)** ... His 2.29 career ERA against Atlanta is his second-lowest against any team (min. 5 starts), trailing his 2.23 mark against the Arizona Diamondbacks
- K-Counter:** Arrieta is averaging 8.56 SO/9.0 IP (72 SO, 75.2 IP) since 7/7 after averaging 6.17 (61 SO, 89.0 IP) from the beginning of the season to that point
- Beast of the East:** Is making his fifth consecutive start against an NL East club ... Has a 3.68 ERA (20 ER, 56.0 IP) against NL East teams this season, allowing 1 run or none in 5 of his 12 starts against the division
- Give Him a Break:** Over the past 4 seasons, Arrieta has taken his game to another level following the All-Star break ... **From 2015-18, he has posted a 3.19 ERA before the break, and a 2.60 ERA following the Midsummer Classic**
- Double or Nothing:** Has induced 22 ground ball double plays this season, 5 more than his previous career high set in 2016 ... **Since 2004, the only Phillies pitcher to induce more ground ball double plays was Roy Halladay in 2010 (25)**
- vs NL East:** 16-9, 3.45 ERA (98 ER, 255.1 IP) in 43 career starts

- 2018:** 6-6, 3.90 ERA (36 ER, 83.0 IP) in 14 starts
- Career:** 54-36, 3.73 ERA (281 ER, 678.0 IP) in 117 games (113 starts)
- Hit the Road, Jake:** Has a 3.04 ERA (16 ER, 47.1 IP) in his last 7 road starts (since 7/7 at PIT)

2018 SEASON:

- His 11 strikeouts on 9/4 at MIA were his most in a game since 6/17/16 vs PIT
- Went 4-0 with a 2.80 ERA (11 ER, 35.1 IP) and 2 HR allowed in 6 July starts ... Became the first Phillies pitcher ever to go 4-0 or better in a month after going 0-4 or worse the previous month
- Posted a 0.90 ERA (3 ER, 30.0 IP) in his 5 starts during May, becoming 1 of just 7 Phillies ever to make 5+ starts in a month with a sub-1.00 ERA (last: Cliff Lee, Aug. 2011)
- Per Elias, was the first Phillies pitcher to allow 1 or 0 home runs in consecutive months in which he made 5 or more starts since 2001 (Brandon Duckworth, Aug.-Sep.)
- Had an 18.2-inning scoreless streak (longest by a Phillie in 2018), 5/23-6/3 and 13.1-inning scoreless streak, 5/6-5/18
- Did not allow a homer in 28.1 straight IP in parts of 6 starts, 4/8-5/6
- Had a stretch of 18 straight starts allowing 3 ER or fewer from 7/2/17-4/25/18, the second-longest such streak of his career
- Struck out 10 batters on 4/19 vs PIT, his 14th career double-digit strikeout game and first start of 10+ SO, 1 H or fewer by a Phillie starter since Cole Hamels' no-hitter in his final start as a Phillie, 7/25/15 at CHI
- Pitched in his 200th career game on 4/19 vs PIT and made his 200th start on 5/23 vs ATL

CAREER:

- Was the 2015 National League Cy Young Award Winner (5th in CHI history), and in 2016 earned his first career All-Star selection and Silver Slugger Award
- Has tossed two career no-hitters: 8/30/15 at LAD and 4/21/16 at CIN
 - Became the 8th pitcher in MLB history to throw a no-hitter in consecutive seasons ... His second came in his 10th start after tossing his first, the third-shortest time between no-hitters in MLB history
- Recorded a career and CHI franchise-best 20 consecutive wins from 8/4/15-5/25/16, which tied for the third-longest streak in MLB history (since 1913)
- In 9 career postseason starts, is 5-3, 3.08 ERA (18 ER, 52.2 IP), 66 SO (most in CHI postseason history), .189 OPP AVG and hit a HR as a batter ... Allowed just 3 ER in 11.1 IP (2.38 ERA) in two starts during the 2016 World Series
- Signed by PHI as a free agent on 3/12/18 ... Originally selected by BAL in the 5th round of the June 2007 draft
