THE TWINS: The Twins began their final homestand with a three-game series win over the Tigers this week...today the Twins will welcome in the White Sox for four over the weekend...two games today, a night game tomorrow and an afternoon game Sunday to complete the 2018 season.

TWINS WIN PENULTIMATE SERIES OF 2018: The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 9-3, winning the three-game series...Gabriel Moya was the Opener and Stephen Gonsalves was the Primary...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Jorge Polanco, who hit his 18th double...Willians Astudillo set a career-high with four RBI...the offense also went 6-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 16th of 19 games this season...the Twins are 8-7 vs. the Sox this season, 3-3 at Target Field and 5-4 at Chicago...the Twins have won 11 of their last 18 over the Sox...today's first game marks a make-up from the weekend games of April 13-15 when the Twin Cities experienced cold temps and approximately 16 inches of snow accumulation over the 3-4 day period.

☞ The Twins are 481-432 all-time against CWS, their most wins vs. any opponent (DET next - 444).
☞ Ehire Adrianza is hitting .381 (16-for-42) with five doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in 12 games vs. the Sox this season...he's hit safely in eight straight vs. CWS.
☞ Jorge Polanco has seven home runs and 16 RBI in his last 11 games vs. the Sox...his 28 career RBI and nine career home runs are his most vs. any opponent.

MAUER AND SOX: Joe Mauer is hitting .295 (229-for-777) with 52 doubles, 18 home runs, 104 RBI, 107 walks, 121 runs scored and a .382 on-base percentage in 208 career games against the Sox...below are his ranks among actives vs. CWS:

A LITTLE EXTRA JOE: Joe Mauer recorded his 600th career extra-base hit last night and is now one of four Twins on the all-time list with 600 XBH (since 1961):

LIVE, IN FRONT OF ASTUDILLO AUDIENCE: Willians Astudillo is hitting .397 (23-for-58) with three doubles, two home runs and 15 RBI in 16 games this month...among AL rookies this month, he ranks first in batting average and tied for second in RBI and tied for third in hits.

MINNESOTA, NICE: The Twins have gone 45-32 at home this season, compared to 29-52 on the road...45 home wins are their most since winning 46 in 2015...two wins today would give them their most since winning 53 in 2010...they have gone 26-12 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the fifth best home winning percentage in baseball (.684), trailing Boston (.762), Oakland (.732), Colorado (.714), and Tampa Bay (.711).

HBD, ROSIE!: Eddie Rosario is celebrating his 27th birthday today...the outfielder will miss the rest of the season due to a tight right quad.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/SOX HISTORY: In 2008, The White Sox beat Cleveland, 5-1, snapping a five-game losing streak to stay alive in the AL Central...the Sox's win forced a make-up game the next day against Detroit, which they won by a score of 8-2...this Sox win forced a game 163 in which Chicago beat the Twins by a score of 1-0 on a Jim Thome home run off Nick Blackburn.

LOOKING FORWARD: Minnesota will open the 2019 season at home against Cleveland on March 28 in their 10th season at Target Field...the Interleague schedule includes series' against Milwaukee and the NL East...the 2019 schedule features three home games in the month of March, 12 in April, 13 in May, 12 in June, 12 in July, 16 in August and 13 in September... additionally, during the months of April, May (prior to Memorial Day) and September, the Twins have moved weekday (Monday-Thursday) night games to a 6:40 pm start.

☞ Ehire Adrianza has hit safely in a career-high eight straight games (with an at-bat), hitting .364 (12-for-33) with seven doubles and six RBI in that span.
☞ Robbie Grossman is hitting .317 (26-for-82) with nine doubles, 17 walks and a .430 OBP this month...17 walks are tied for second in AL.

LAST START: Berrios did not factor into the decision in his last start at Oakland on September 21 after allowing five runs in four hits and three walks with eight strikeouts over 5.2 innings... left the game in the sixth with a runner on first, next batter hit a home run to score the runner... first start with more than 100 pitches since August 4...finishes the year against the AL West 1-5 with a 5.77 ERA (39.0 IP, 25 ER).

YES WAY JOSÉ!: Starting pitcher José Berrios was named to the AL All-Star team, the first of his career...Berrios came in for the fifth inning and faced four batters, allowing one walk on 13 pitches, five of which were strikes...it marked the second consecutive season that the Twins have sent a starting pitcher to the All-Star Game (Ervin Santana)...below is a list of Twins starting pitchers to make the ASG:

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Berrios is making his ninth career start and fifth of the year against Chicago-AL...all-time, he is 6-1 with a 2.24 ERA (52.1 IP, 13 ER) with 12 walks and 58 strikeouts...his ERA against the White Sox is his second lowest against an AL team (Toronto: 0.71)... last start against the White Sox was August 21, allowed one run on four hits and two walks with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings...his last win against Chicago-AL was June 7, threw a complete game and allowed two runs on six hits with 10 strikeouts...he is 4-0 with a 1.16 ERA (31.0 IP, 4 ER) with 40 strikeouts all-time against Chicago-AL at Target Field.

COMMANDING THE CENTRAL: In 13 starts this year vs. AL Central opponents, Berrios is 7-1 with a 2.57 ERA (84.0 IP, 24 ER) with 22 walks and 88 strikeouts...his seven wins are third most against the AL Central while his 88 strikeouts are fifth most in baseball...Berrios owns a 0.98 WHIP and is holding divisional opponents to a .200 average, sixth and seventh best among pitchers with at least five starts vs. the AL Central...also owns nine quality starts vs. the Central... lost first divisional game since August 24, 2017 in his start on September 8 vs. Kansas City.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Since the beginning of 2017, Berrios is 17-5 with a 2.85 ERA (167.1 IP, 53 ER) in 27 games (26 starts) in home games...his 2.85 ERA at home is sixth best in the AL since the beginning of last season...his 0.96 WHIP at home is 10th best in the AL over that stretch...Berrios is 8-4 with a 3.15 ERA (100.0 IP, 35 ER) in 16 home starts in 2018...is tied-eighth in the AL in strikeouts at home with 109 and 10th in ERA...all six of his 10+ strikeout games in his career have come at Target Field.

TALE OF TWO SEASONS: Has gone 3-6, 4.92 ERA (82.1 IP, 45 ER) with 37 walks and 84 strikeouts in his last 15 starts, dating back to his start at the Cubs June 29...prior to that start he went 8-5, 3.15 ERA (103.0 IP, 36 ER) with 20 walks and 109 strikeouts in 16 starts...since the beginning of August, Berrios has gone 1-3 with a 5.05 ERA (56.1 IP, 26 ER) with 24 walks and 51 strikeouts.

DAY 'N' NIGHT: Berrios has made 18 starts in night games this year and is among the best in baseball, going 8-4 with a 3.25 ERA (110.2 IP, 40 ER) with 30 walks and 121 strikeouts...his ERA is eighth best in the AL while his 1.00 WHIP in night games is fourth best in the AL and ninth in baseball and his 4.03 strikeout-to-walk ratio is 11th in the AL...in day games, Berrios is 3-7 with a 4.94 ERA (74.2 IP, 41 ER) with 27 walks and 72 strikeouts...however, both of his complete games this year have come in day games.

WIZARD OF WHIFF: With his outing on June 7 vs. Chicago-AL, Berrios has now thrown the four most recent 10+ K, 0 run games in Twins history (April 12 vs. Chicago-AL, August 30, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL, May 18, 2017 vs. Colorado)...the last to do it before Berrios was Ervin Santana on August 30, 2015 vs. Houston...now with four games of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks, he follows Johan Santana (8) and Bert Blyleven (6) for most such performances in Twins history...Berrios is 11th in the AL with 9.37 strikeouts per nine innings...four 10+ strikeout starts in 2018 and six in his career...looking for 200 strikeouts for the first time in his career.

GAME 2 STARTER - CHASE DE JONG (SEASON: 0-1, 3.68 ERA ; CAREER: 0-4, 5.80 ERA)

De Jong made his second start of the season on September 15 vs. Kansas City, suffered the loss after allowing five runs (3 earned) on eight hits with four strikeouts over 3.1 innings... making his third career appearance and second career start against Oakland...in two career appearances, is 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts...only start against Oakland was May 16, 2017, allowed four runs on seven hits and three walks with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings but did not factor into the decision.

- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins second best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins system by *Baseball America*.
- Named 20th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com entering 2016.
- Started for the World Team in the SiriusXM Futures Games in consecutive seasons, 2014 at Target Field and 2015 at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati.
- Led all of minor league baseball in strikeouts (175) in 2015.
- Named Southern Pitcher of the Week May 18, 2015, making one start vs. Birmingham, pitching 9.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits and eight strikeouts.
- Named Midseason All-Star in each of the last three minor league seasons: 2015 with Chattanooga, 2014 with Ft. Myers and 2013 with Cedar Rapids.
