TAMPA BAY RAYS (7-9-1) vs. PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (7-11)

 RHP Chris Archer (0-0, 5.68) vs RHP Drew Hutchison (1-0, 2.25)

YESTERDAY'S ACTION: In a game that featured 1 total hit through the first 5.0 innings, a 3-run 8th proved to be the difference maker in the Phillies' 3-0 shutout win over Atlanta in Orlando ... Starter Zach Eflin dazzled through 5.0 shutout innings, facing the minimum and allowing just 1 baserunner and striking out 2 ... The Phillies collected their first hit in the 8th inning on a J.P. Crawford double, and three batters later Mitch Walding struck for a 3-run home run, the only runs of the game.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER vs TB:

RHP Drew Hutchison ... 27 years old (8/22/90, Lakeland, FL) ... **How obtained:** Signed by Phillies as a minor league free agent, 2/15/18... **Spring 2018:** 1-0, 2.25 ERA (2 ER, 8.0 IP) in 3 games ... **2017:** Spent entire season with Indianapolis (AAA) ... Named an International League midseason All-Star ... Tied for the IL lead in starts (26) and innings (159.1) and finished 10th in ERA (3.56) ... Posted a 1.87 ERA (7 ER, 33.2 IP) in June and a 1.91 ERA (8 ER, 37.2 IP) in August ... Opposing hitters batted just .199 (31-156) against him with RISP ... Allowed 2 ER or fewer in 16 of 26 starts, and 1 or none in 9 of those starts ... In his final 19 games (17 GS), surrendered only 6 HR in 109.2 IP (0.49 HR/9.0 IP)... **Career:** 30-21, 4.93 ERA (229 ER, 417.2 IP) in 82 G (74 GS).

OTHER PROBABLE PITCHERS vs TB: RHP Tom Eshelman

WELCOME, JAKE! Yesterday evening, the Phillies announced the signing of free agent **RHP Jake Arrieta** to a multi-year contract ... Arrieta, 32, went 14-10 with a 3.53 ERA and held opposing hitters to a .235 AVG in 30 starts last year for the Cubs ... Over the past 3 seasons (2015-17), Arrieta leads all ML pitchers with 54 wins, ranks 2nd with a 2.71 ERA (Clayton Kershaw - 2.07) and has the 3rd-lowest OPP AVG (.203) ... He pitched two 9.0-inning no-hitters, both as a visiting player: 8/30/15 at LAD and 4/21/16 vs CIN ... Had a streak of 24 consecutive GS without a loss, going 20-0 with a 1.01 ERA from 7/30/15 -5/31/16 ... Won the 2015 NL Cy Young Award (22-6, 1.77 ERA) ... In 2016, in addition to helping CHI win the World Series, he was named to the NL All-Star team and won a Silver Slugger Award ... He has 5 home runs in the regular season and 1 in the postseason ... Arrieta is 88-56 (.611) in his career with a 3.57 ERA ... To make room on the 40-man roster, **1B Tommy Joseph** was designated for assignment

CAUGHT KNAPPING: **C Andrew Knapp** has thrown out 3 of 6 attempted basestealers this spring, more than any other Phillies catcher ... Only BAL's Austin Wynns (4 CS) has thrown out more attempted basestealers in the Grapefruit League and only 4 catchers have more CS in MLB.

KING ME: **2B Scott Kingery** is T-7th among ML players in stolen bases this spring (4) and has more home runs (3) than any other players with as many steals ... No 2B in the Grapefruit League has more steals than Kingery and the only 2B in the majors with more homers is the overall spring home run leader, Jason Kipnis ... He currently leads the Phillies in home runs, steals and is 2nd with a .391 AVG (Joseph - .429)

ABOUT SPRING TRAINING: 2018 marks the Phillies 72nd year in Clearwater, Florida, for spring training (since 1947)... Only the Detroit Tigers have trained at their current spring training home longer (Lakeland, FL - since 1934)... It is the Phillies' 15th spring at Spectrum Field (opened in 2004)... Other spring training parks for the Phillies in Clearwater have been Athletic Field (1947-54), and Jack Russell Memorial Stadium (1955-2003)... In 2017, the Phillies finished with a 14-17-5 (.452) spring training record ... The Phillies total spring attendance was 128,236 for 18 home games, an average of 7,124 per game.
