LHP Sean Newcomb has pitched to a 2-0 record with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER/30.1 IP) over his last five starts dating to April 8 at Colorado...He allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in his season debut.

Since his start on April 8, his 2.37 ERA is the lowest by a qualifying left-handed pitcher in the National League and the fourth lowest by a lefty in the majors.

His opponent tonight, Tampa Bay lefty Blake Snell, ranks second among qualifying left-handers with a 1.89 ERA in that same span.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Tampa Bay open a two-game set tonight with the first game of the Braves' third road trip of the season...This is the first meeting between the clubs since 2015 when the Braves dropped three of four games to the Rays...The teams will meet again in Atlanta, August 28-29.

A The Braves have lost three of their last four games in St. Petersburg, scoring a total of 10 runs over this skid...They opened with 10 wins in their first 13 games here, outscoring the Rays 71-42.

A LHP Sean Newcomb is set for his second career interleague start...He dropped a 16-4 decision to Houston at SunTrust Park on July 4 of last season.

A LHP Blake Snell is scheduled to make his first career start against Atlanta...He is 3-1 with a 2.48 ERA (11 ER/40.0 IP) in seven games, all starts, against the N.L.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled LHP Luiz Gohara from Triple-A Gwinnett and outrighted RHP Luke Jackson to the Stripers...Gohara will be available out of the bullpen tonight and wear No. 53.

A Gohara began the season on the 10-day disabled list with a left ankle sprain and missed 25 games before he was reinstated and optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett on April 27.

A The left-hander went 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) in four games, all starts, in the minors...He appeared in one game with Double-A Mississippi during his rehabilitation assignment...The other three appearances came with Gwinnett.

SWEPT: The Braves were swept by San Francisco in a three-game set in Atlanta last weekend, the club's longest losing streak this season...Prior to this current skid, the Braves had lost consecutive games just twice this season: April 9-10 at Washington and April 23-24 at Cincinnati.

A The Braves starting staff allowed 18 runs and 28 hits while taking the loss in all three games against the Giants...In the club's 25 games prior to this current skid, dating to April 4, the starters went 12-2 with a 2.41 ERA (38 ER/142.0 IP).

A The sweep handed the Braves their first home series loss of the season...Overall they are 7-2-2 in series play this season.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves begin their first interleague series of the season tonight...They went 9-11 against the American League last season and have not finished with a winning record in interleague play since 2013, when they went 11-9...Atlanta's .375 (30-50) interleague winning percentage over the previous four seasons was the third worst in baseball.

A Braves designated hitters have hit 16 home runs in interleague play, tied for the second fewest among N.L. teams...They hit none last season.

FIRST INNING: The Braves led 1-0 after the first inning Sunday and have scored in the first inning in four straight games...They have scored a MLB-high 36 runs in the first inning this season.

A They also have the most hits (54) and doubles (15) and are third with 10 home runs.

A The club also has a .360 batting average and a .687 slugging percentage in the first inning, both tops in the majors.

A The Braves led after one in each game of the Giants series and are now 10-5 when taking a lead to the second inning.

A 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .485 (16-for-33) with 12 runs and five home runs in the opening inning this season...His 16 hits and 12 runs are the most in the majors, while his five home runs are tied with Bryce Harper for the most in baseball.

VS. LEFTY STARTERS: The Braves are set to face another left-handed starter today, LHP Blake Snell, after losing to LHP Ty Blach and LHP Andrew Suárez the last two games...Prior to this stretch the Braves had faced four left-handed starters all season.

A The Braves are hitting .296 against all lefties, the only team in the majors with a mark above .276... Tampa Bay is second...Atlanta also has the best on-base percentage (.353) and slugging percentage (.478)...The next closest slugging percentage is Pittsburgh at .461.

A 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .471 (16-for-34) against all left-handers, the third best mark in baseball among qualifiers...His 1.000 slugging percentage is second to San Diego's Christian Villanueva (1.114)... Albies has fanned just three times against lefties this season.

THE OFFENSE: The Braves offense leads all of baseball in batting average (.274) and on-base percentage (.342), while its 325 hits are two off the lead...The club leads the N.L. in runs (181), doubles (77), slugging percentage (.446) and extra-base hits (121).

A The Braves have struck out 259 times, the fewest times in the N.L.

LEADING OFF: Braves hitters leading off an inning have a .339 on-base percentage, the best mark in the N.L...They have 72 hits and 28 walks, and have struck out just 56 times, the lowest total in the N.L.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves have gone 11-7 away from SunTrust Park this season, while compiling the eighth-best road ERA in the majors at 3.38 (61 ER/162.2 IP)... Only Colorado (23) and Pittsburgh (20) have played more road games in the N.L. than the Braves

A The Braves have not finished with a winning road record since 2012, when they went 46-35 away from Turner Field.

Tonight's Game

- A* Set for his seventh start of the season and the 26th of his career.
- A* Has pitched to a 2-0 record with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER/30.1 IP) over his last five starts dating to 4/8 at COL...Allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in his season debut.
 - A* Since his start on 4/8, his 2.37 ERA is the lowest by a left-handed pitcher in the National League and the fourth lowest by a southpaw in the majors... His opponent tonight, Tampa Bay lefty Blake Snell, ranks second among left-handers with a 1.89 ERA in that same span.
- A* Has fanned 42 batters in 34.2 innings pitched on the season, good for a rate of 10.90 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...His 10.90 strikeouts are fifth most in the National League.
 - A* For reference, the highest rate of strikeouts per 9.0 innings by a qualified starter in Atlanta franchise history is 9.79, set by John Smoltz in 1996 (276 strikeouts/253.2 innings).
- A* Makes his fifth start on the road, and is 2-0 with a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) over his first four turns...Is 0-1 with a 6.10 ERA in two starts at SunTrust Park.
- A* Has never faced Tampa Bay...Tonight's start will be just the second Interleague turn of his career.
 - A* Faced the Houston Astros on 7/4 of last season and allowed career highs in hits (10) and runs (7) in a career-low 3.1 innings of work.

2018 Recap

- A* Tossed a career-most 7.0 innings in his last start, 5/2 at NYM, and held the Mets to just two hits and one walk while fanning eight...The outing was his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings in his last five appearances after entering the season with just one such start in his career.
 - A* Completed 6.0 innings for the third consecutive start, his first time doing so since opening his career with four consecutive "quality" starts, 6/10-27/17.
- A* Went 6.0 innings, 4/26 at CIN, and held the Reds to five hits and four runs while striking out seven...All four runs he allowed came in the fifth inning, including three on a home run by Joey Votto.
- A* Limited the Mets to six hits and three runs, two earned, 4/20 at SunTrust Park... Walked three and struck out five in a 5-3 Atlanta loss.
 - A* Has 27 strikeouts in 22.2 career innings against New York (10.72 SO/9.0 IP)... Among qualified pitchers over the last two seasons, only Yu Darvish (11.93) and Max Scherzer (11.57) have fanned more Mets per 9.0 innings than Newcomb.
- A* Went 5.1 innings, 4/14 at CHI, and held the Cubs to six hits and three runs, two earned...Has allowed three or fewer earned runs in 14 of his last 17 starts dating to 7/23/17.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career...Pitched into the seventh for the third time in his career after facing two batters to open the inning.
 - A* Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).
 - A* Matched his career high with nine strikeouts, tied for most by a Braves starter this season...Eight of his nine strikeouts were swinging.
- A* Went 4.1 innings in his season debut, 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed five hits, six runs (five earned) and four walks to take the loss...Struck out six.
 - A* Failed to complete 6.0 innings for the eighth consecutive start, dating to 8/20 of last season...Over that stretch went 3-3 with a 4.73 ERA (21 ER/40.0 IP) and 24 walks.

2017 Recap

- A* In his second season in the Atlanta organization, made his major league debut after beginning the season with Triple-A Gwinnett.
- A* Went a season-best 6.1 innings in his MLB debut on 6/10 vs. NYM in the first game of a doubleheader, allowing one unearned run, four hits and two walks while striking out seven...He became just the second pitcher in Atlanta franchise history to go as long in his MLB debut and not allow an earned run...Larry McWilliams did so on July 17, 1978, also against the Mets, also in the first game of a doubleheader and also in Atlanta.
- A* Finished with 108 strikeouts in 100.0 major league innings...His 9.72 K/9 was the second highest mark by a rookie starter in Atlanta franchise history (minimum 75.0 innings)...Only Brandon Beachy's 10.74 rate in 2011 was higher.

Career Recap

- A* Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with SS Erick Aybar, RHP Chris Ellis and cash considerations, from the Los Angeles of Anaheim in exchange for SS Andreton Simmons and C Jose Briceno on 11/12/15.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 7/5 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/3

- Right-handed batters have just two hits, both singles, in 22 at-bats (.091) against him...Lefties are hitting .455/.538/.909 with five hits, two walks, two doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/17, for his first appearance on an active roster.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 15/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Returned to action 5/5 vs. SF and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Threw two pitches and left with numbness in his right index finger and thumb in his last outing, 5/1 at NYM.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .150 (6-for-40) average...Lefties are hitting .273 (9-for-33).
- Converted his fifth hold of the season, 4/28 at PHI...Five holds pace the club and are tied for second most in the majors among rookie pitchers...No rookie has paced the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding batters to a .171 (6-for-35) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-25, .120) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .257 (9-for-35) with no one on base.
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH...Tossed 3.1 scoreless innings, while also stranding the bases loaded after entering the game in the third.
- Took the loss in his Braves debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed one run over 2.0 innings...The loss was his first major league decision.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 18/13 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 18/3

- Has not allowed a hit to a left-handed batter this season (0-for-17).
- Allowed just two hits and two walks over his last four appearances, totaling 4.2 scoreless innings...Prior to his current run, allowed two hits, eight walks and eight runs (six earned) over four games (2.1 IP) from 4/14-23.
- Ranks tied for fifth in the majors with 18 appearances this season...Has pitched in 55% of Atlanta's games...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited an N.L.-most (tied) 18 runners, and has stranded 15 (83%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 0/0 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett today for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA), combining to go 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts...Went 4.1 innings in his last start, 5/2 at Charlotte, and allowed eight hits and six runs.
- Made five starts with Atlanta last season, going 1-3 with a 4.91 ERA...Spent time at three different levels of the Braves farm system before making his major league debut last September...Became the first Braves starter since 2004 to begin the year in Single-A and make his MLB debut later that season.
- Ranked by Baseball America as Atlanta's No. 2 prospect, and by MLB.com as the Braves' No. 4 farmhand.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** 15/9 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/0

- Has allowed 15 baserunners over his last 7.1 innings (eight hits, seven walks)...Allowed just 15 total baserunners over 15.0 innings last season.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Allowed a career high-tying three hits and two runs, 4/24 at CIN...Had surrendered just four hits total entering play...Had not allowed three hits or two runs since 8/27/17 vs. COL, his second career appearance.
- Stranded the only runner he inherited, 4/16 vs. PHI...Inherited two runners vs. PHI on 3/30 and stranded them both in his season debut...Has stranded all seven runners he has inherited in his career.
- Fanned the side, 4/11 at WSH...Needed just 13 pitches to do so.
- Appeared in back-to-back games three times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.

Peter Moylan • RHP • 6-3 • 220 • 39 yrs • #30

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/5

- Allowed the first batter he has faced to reach base 56% percent of the time...Nine of 16 first batters have reached.
- Allowed at least one baserunner in 14 of his 16 outings this season, with his only two clean appearances lasting just 0.1 innings each...Opponents have 17 hits and eight walks over 11.2 innings of work (2.14 WHIP).
- Worked a season-most 1.1 inning, 4/29 at CIN, and has just seven outings of at least 1.0 full inning this season...Made 79 appearances with Kansas City last season, but just 34 of those games went 1.0 full frame...His 79 total appearances led the majors, but his 34 relief outings of at least 1.0 inning ranked tied for 142nd.
- Has limited right-handed batters to a .215 average (220-for-1024) for his career...Lefties are hitting .301 (135-for-449) against him.
- Has appeared in 193 games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors...Moylan's run, which is the second longest in MLB history, dates to 9/9/11...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) has had a longer streak.

Arodys Vizcaíno • RHP • 6-0 • 245 • 27 yrs • #38

Saves/Opp: 4/5 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 15/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Converted his fourth save, 4/1 at NYM, and three of his last four appearances have resulted in saves...Since assuming the primary closer role for Atlanta on 7/30/17, has converted 16-of-18 (89%) of save opportunities.
